Power up to recycling challenge

Recycle batteries and receive a reward for your school

Introducing the latest 'Power Up To Recycling' challenge! We are asking Kent schools to encourage pupils, parents and staff to bring as many used batteries as possible into school for recycling. **This year you will receive a reward for your school based on the weight of batteries you collect!***

*Minimum 1kg of batteries required to receive a reward

What are the rewards?

The challenge is to fill your pink battery box* with used domestic batteries as many times as possible from **1st May 2017 – 1st December 2017**. Schools will be rewarded with a Kent County Supplies voucher provided by Valpak (who recycle batteries on behalf of Kent County Council), based on the weight of batteries your school collects, as follows:

1–15 kgs = £5

16–50 kgs = £10

51–100 kgs = £20

101–200 kgs = £50

201–300 kgs = £100

301+ kgs = £300
