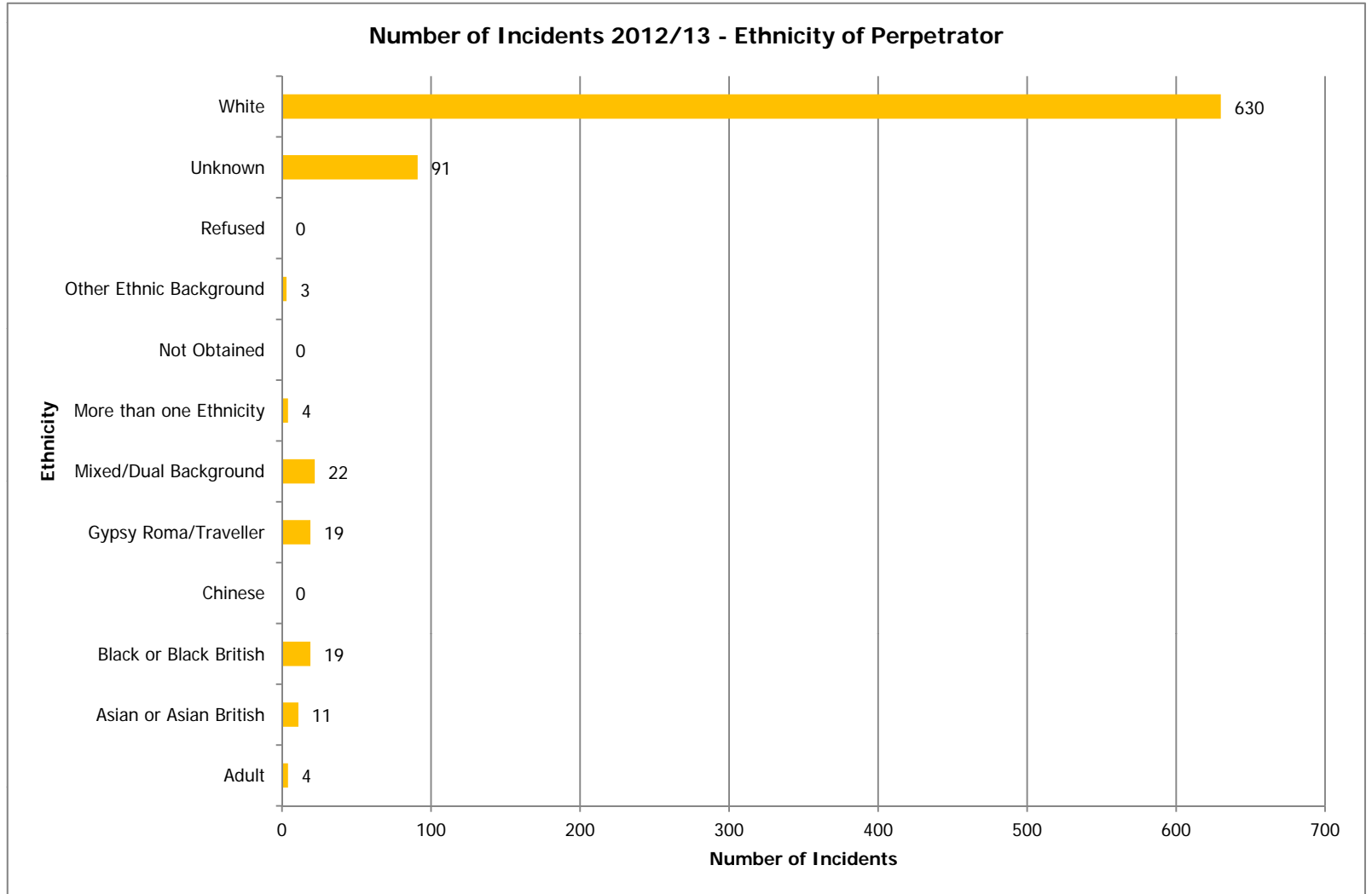

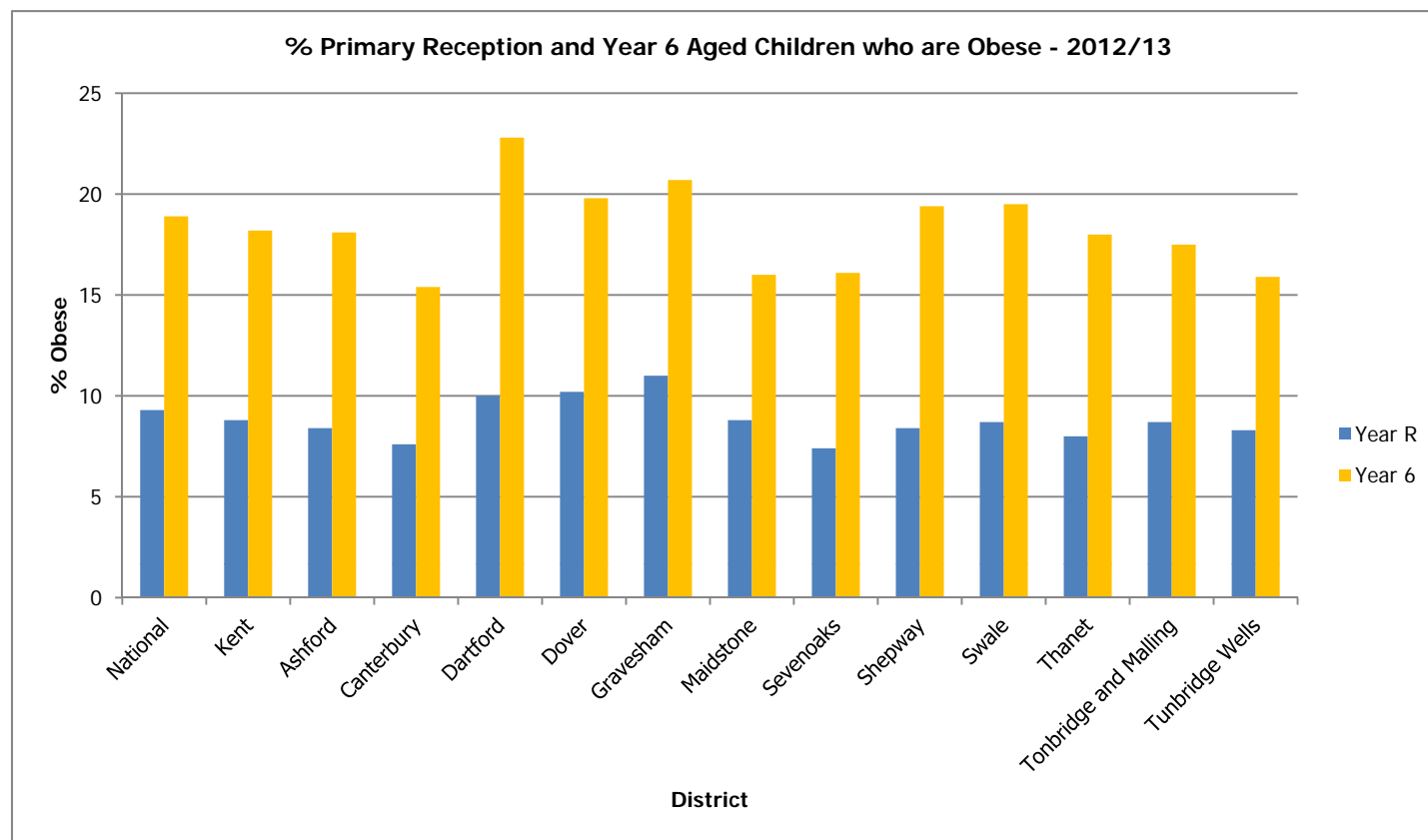

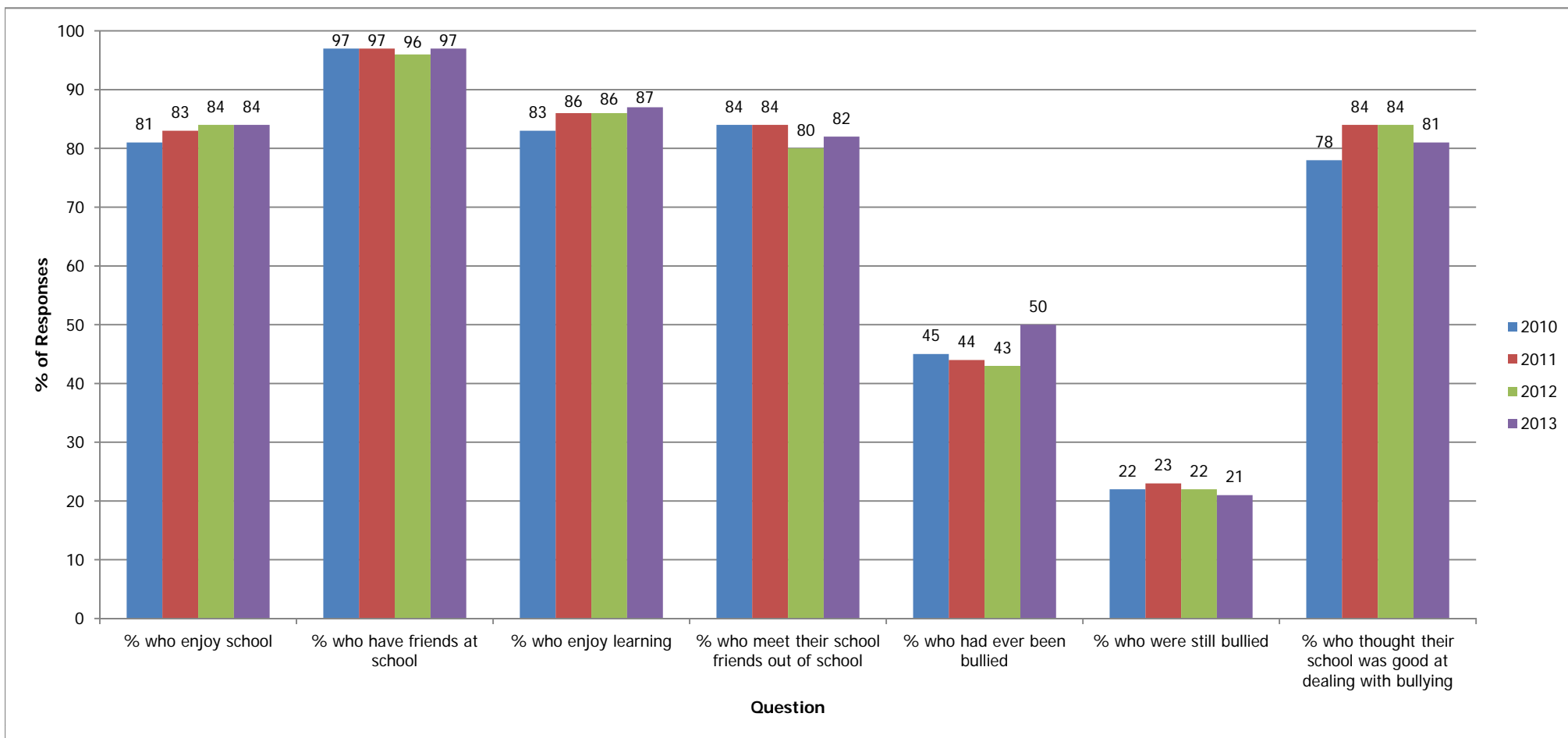

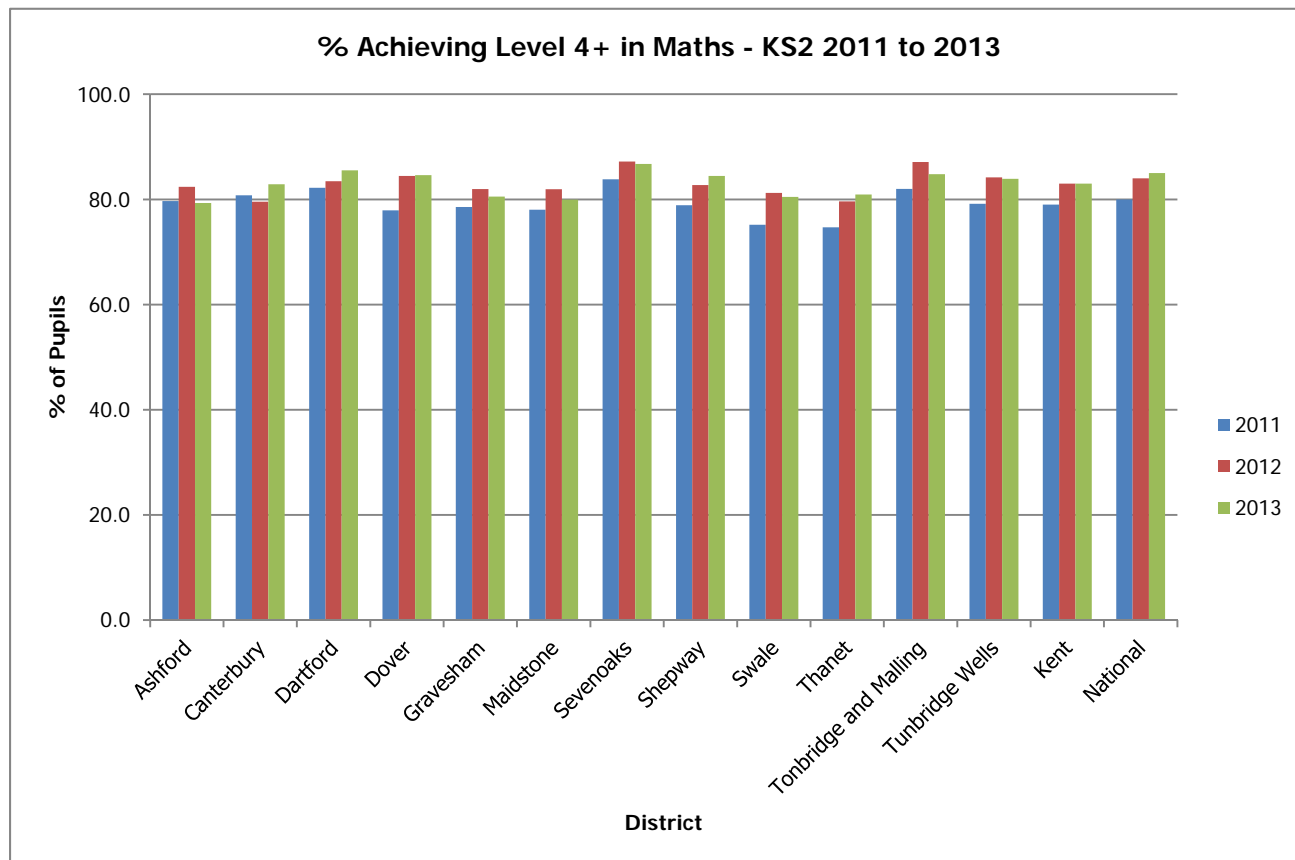

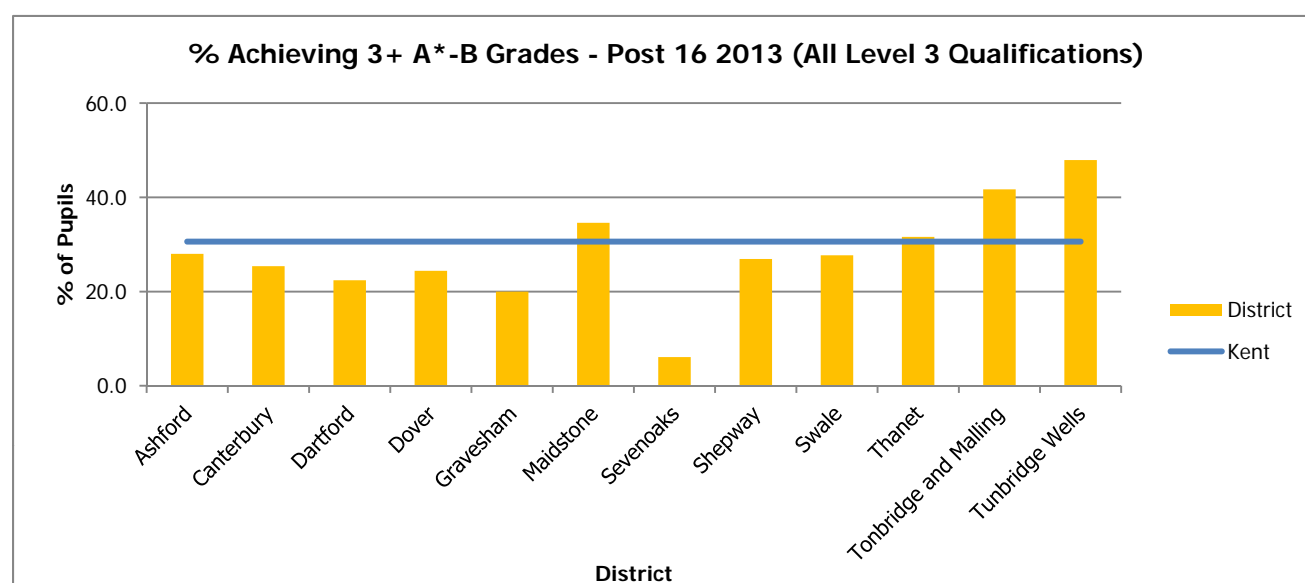
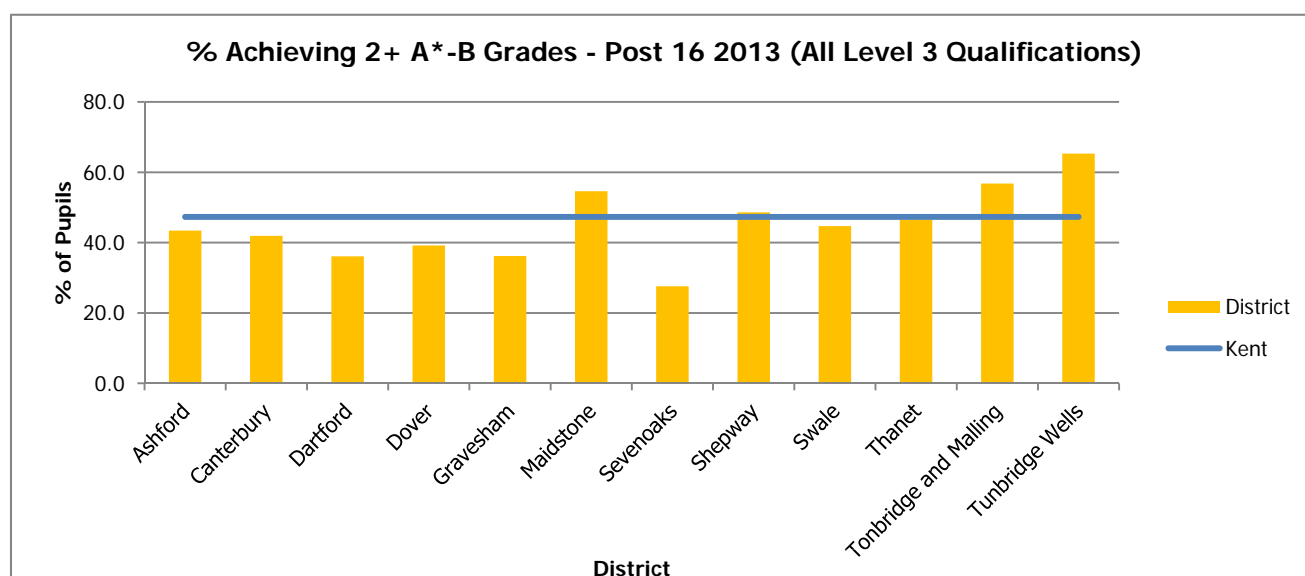
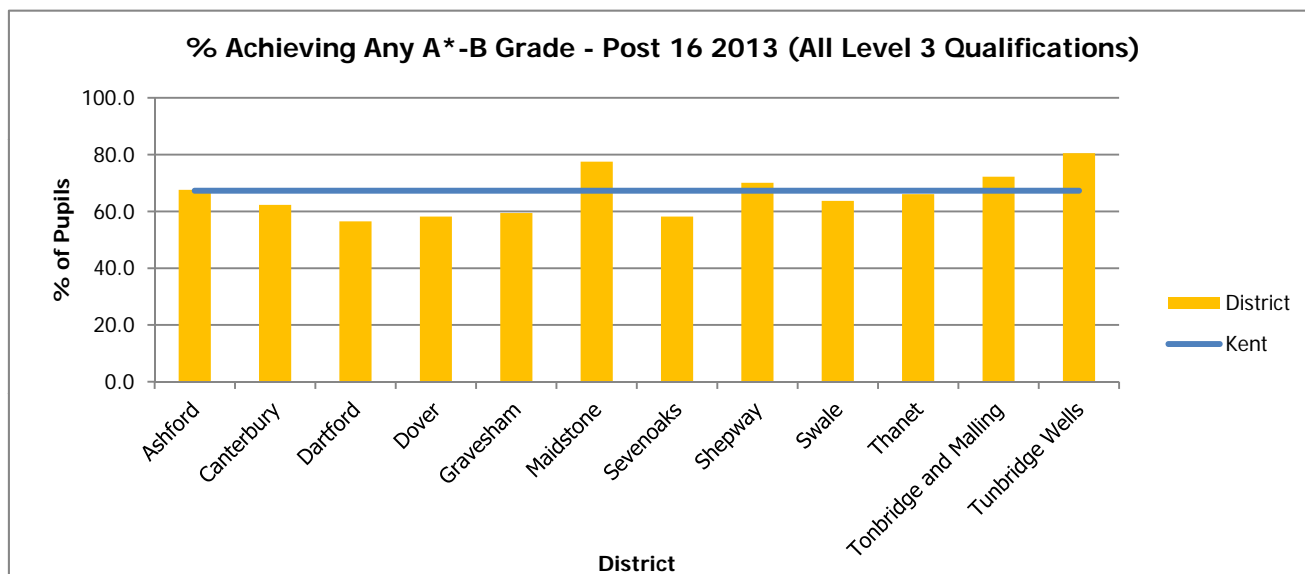
Post-16 Attainment by Area and District 2013

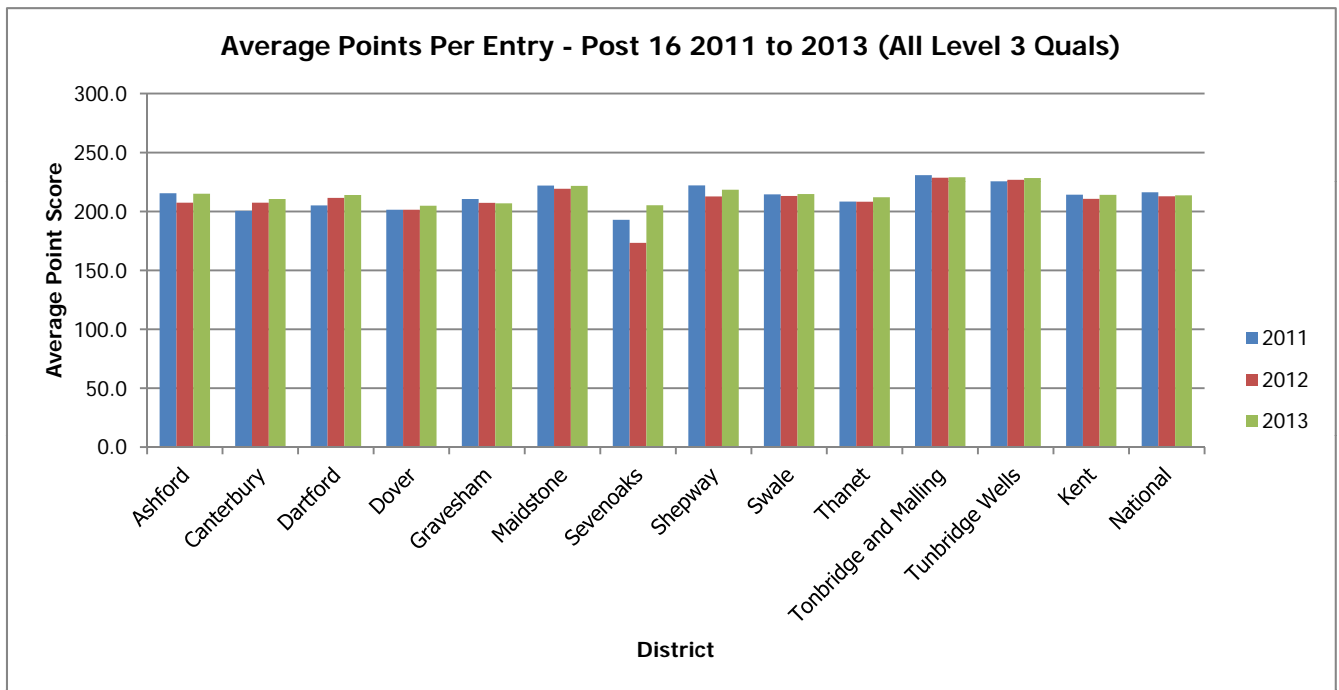
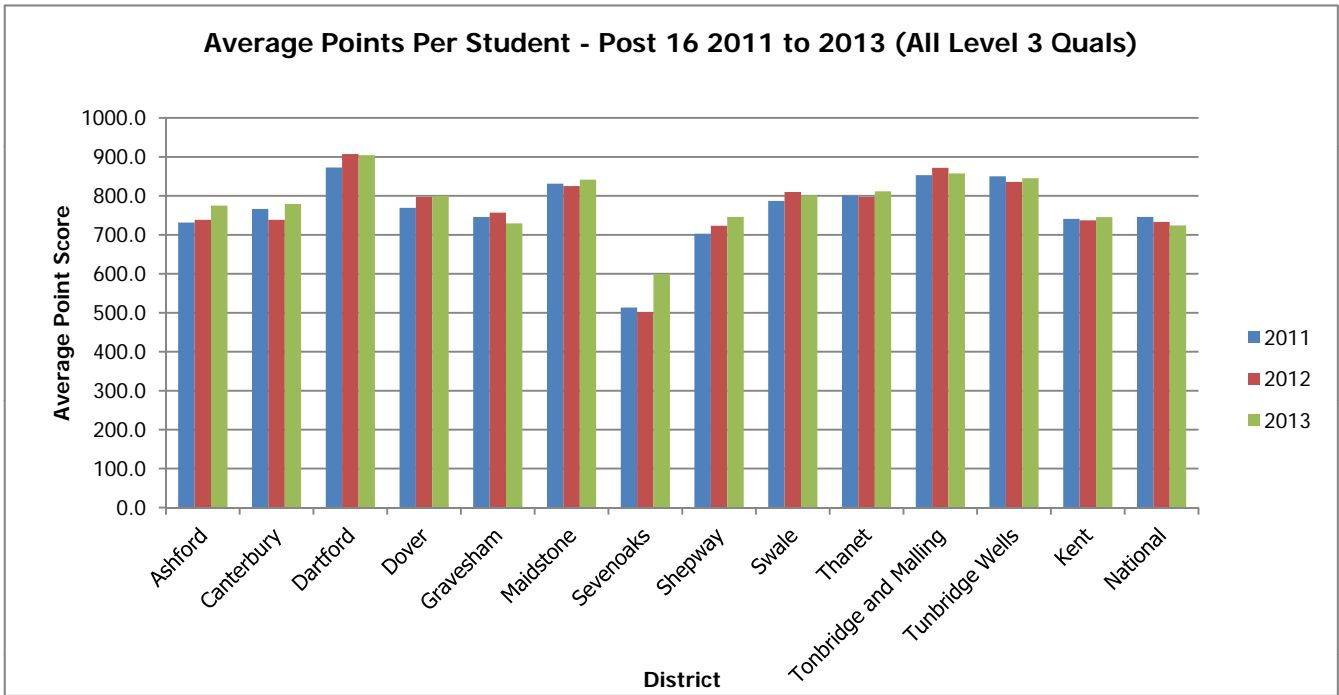
