The figures include Yr12 & Yr13 (academic age 16 & 17) with a Kent County Council area postcode as their primary address.

Headline Commentary

The NEET population rose slightly to 3.1% this month (1,016 young people), up from 3.0% last month. This compares to a figure of 2.9% at the same time last year. The Not Known population also rose slightly to 3.2% this month (1,053 young people).

The NEET population of 1,016 young people comprises 360 in the year 12 age group and 656 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has dropped slightly from 90.5% in February to 89.9% in March. It is 1.7 percentage points lower than the same time last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.66% in Sevenoaks to 4.98% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 2.81% in Ashford to 4.09 % in Folkestone and Hythe.

Work has recently taken place to cross-reference the Not Knowns population with other sources of young people's information to increase the accuracy and volume of contact details in order to facilitate improved contact with that cohort.

37% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was 38%, so whilst there has been a slight rise in the NEET population, it has not been caused by, or led to, an increase in the long-term NEET population.

Work has recently taken place to review our processes and practice in order to ensure that they are as effective as possible. This will support both the accuracy and timeliness of data recording, and how it is used effectively to support and reduce the NEET population.

Yr12 & Yr13 NEET %

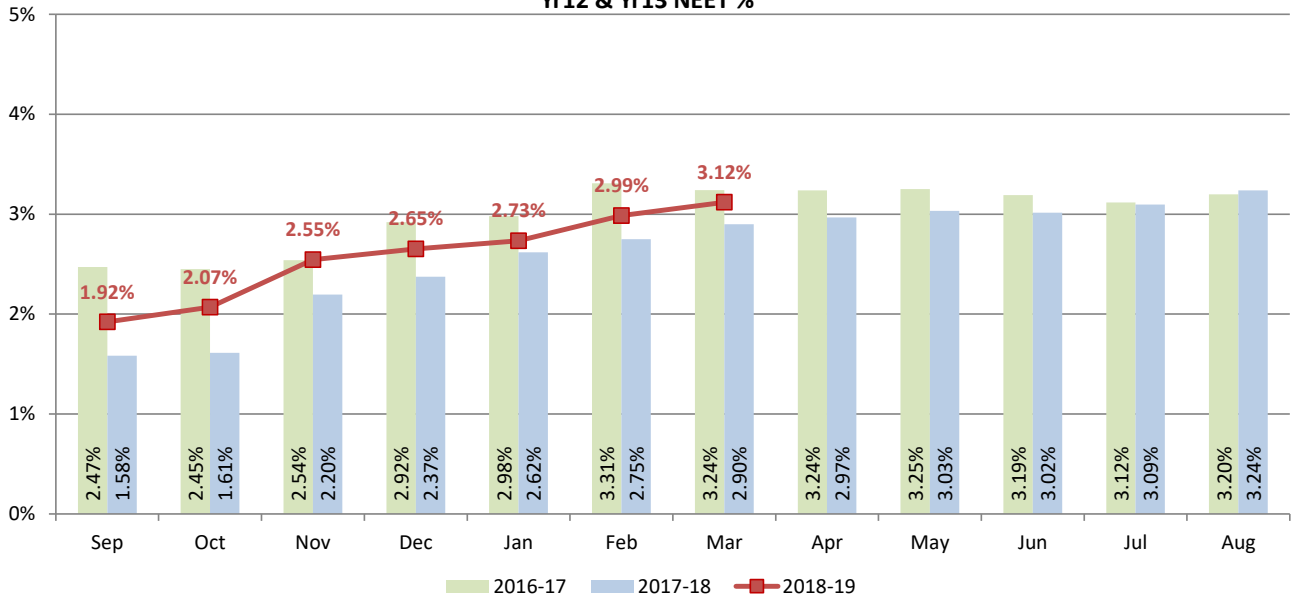

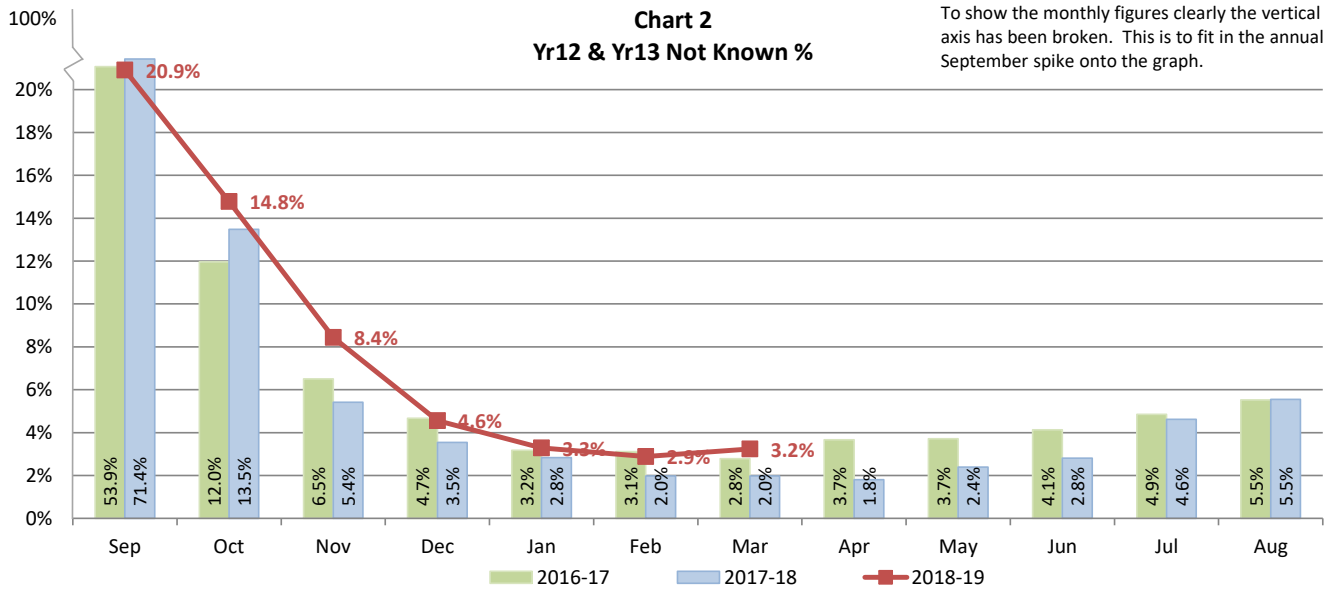
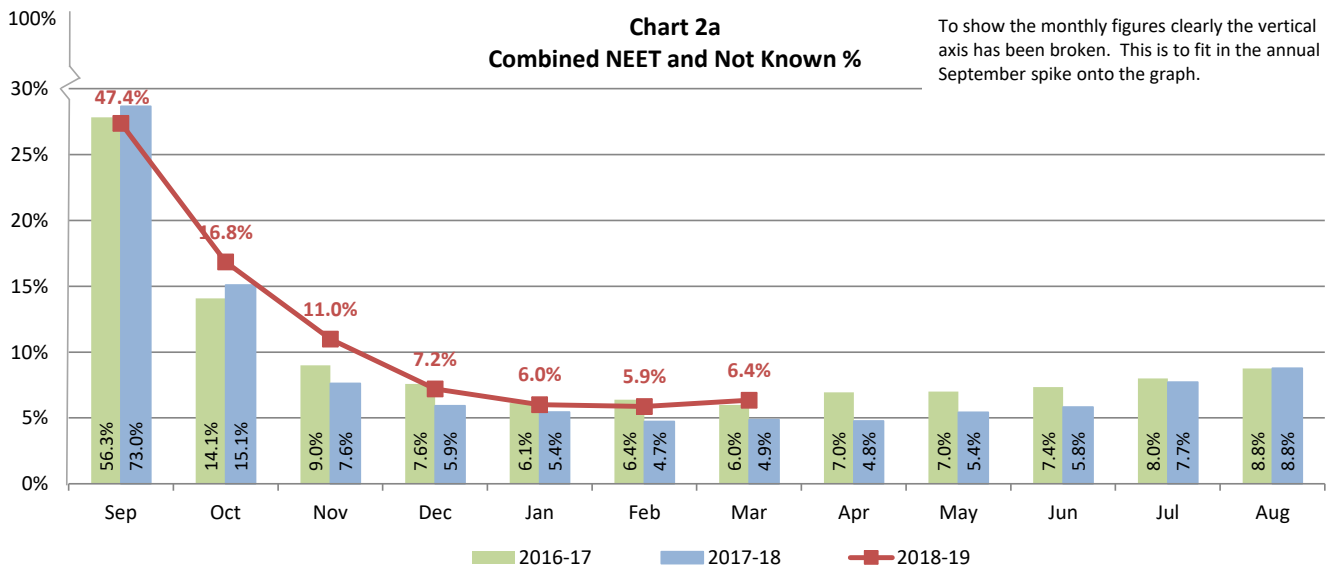

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs February 2019

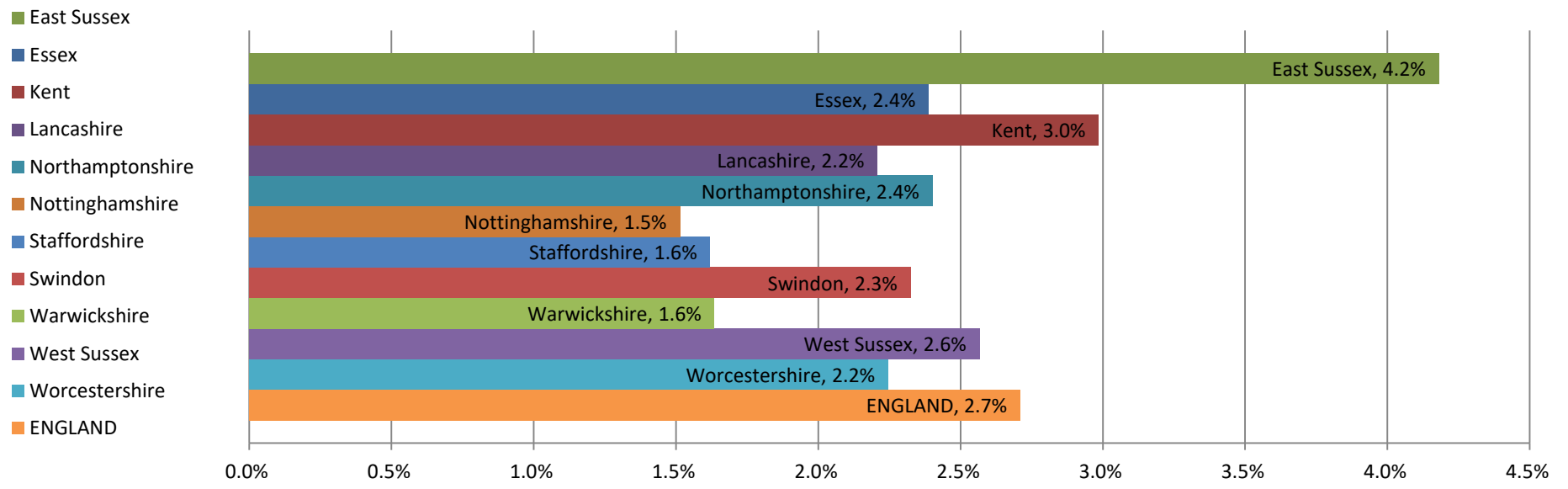
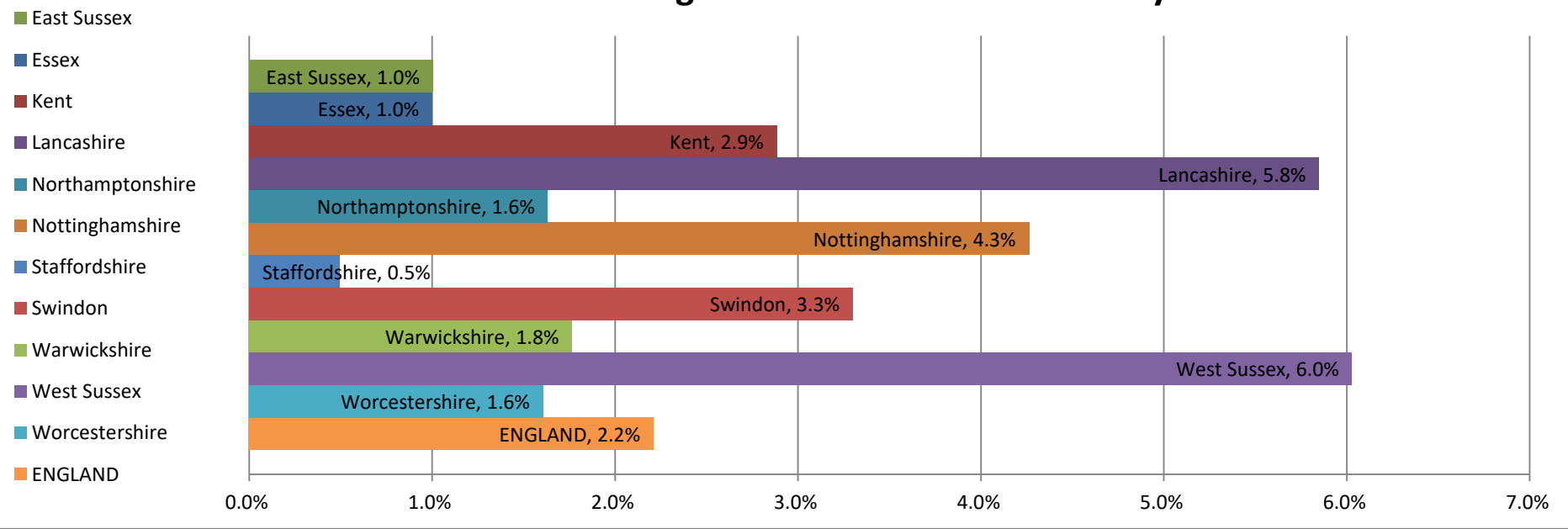


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns February 2019
