What are the benefits?

- Establishes an evidence-based strategy to reduce HBT bullying, and promote inclusion
- Supports readiness for statutory Relationships Education, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and Health Education

- Have not participated in any Government-funded anti-HBT bullying programmes in the past 3 years
- Currently have no strategies and policies in place for tackling HBT bullying
- Have an interest in creating an LGBT-inclusive school
