## **Headline Commentary**

February's figures are continuing to stabilise, following the system being updated in the Autumn term with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges.

The percentage of not knowns has visably reduced due to the substantial work in matching the latest Census data and the latest NAS data to the Not Knowns list. The Not Known percentage dropped from last month by 0.9 percentage points.

The NEET population is currently at 3.3% compared 3.0% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 3.6%, down from 4.5% last month. This is higher than this time last year at 2.9% in February 2019. The Participation rate has improved again to 89.3%, up from 88.6% last month, this is down 1.2 percentage points compared with the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.2% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.3% In Thanet and Swale. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 2.5% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.3% in Thanet and Dartford.

The Department for Education (DfE) publishes an estimate each year of the proportion of young people not in education, employment or training (NEET). The performance of all Local Authorities is averaged in December, January and February. For these months, Management Information are able to include Postive Destinations created after the end of the month.

The percentage of Intended Destinations recorded for Year 11 Pupils is reported from this month. 55.0% of Year 11s have an Intended Destination recorded to the end of February. MI continue to engage with schools to follow up on those outstanding.
