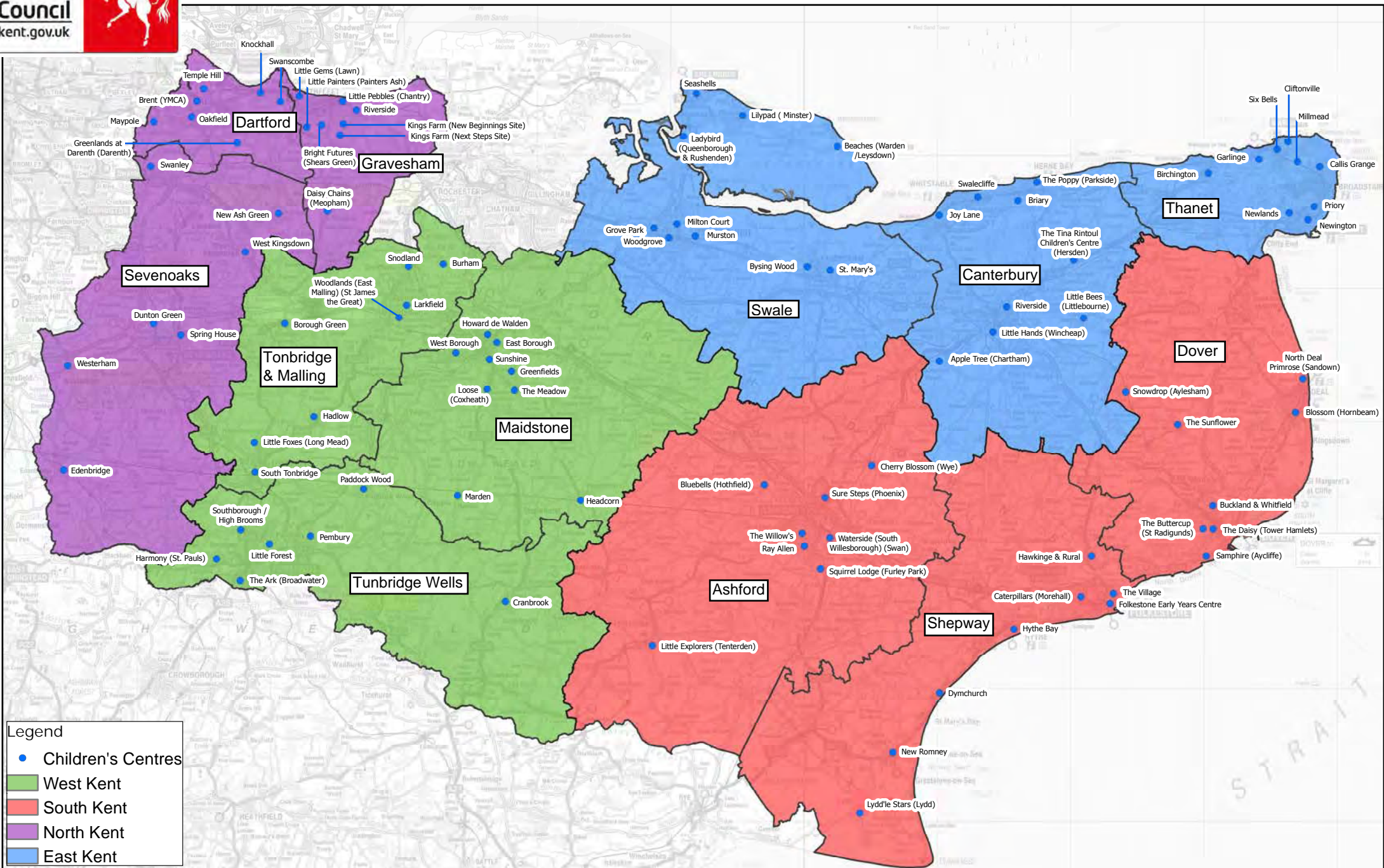

**Key Stage Two Attainment by District 2012**



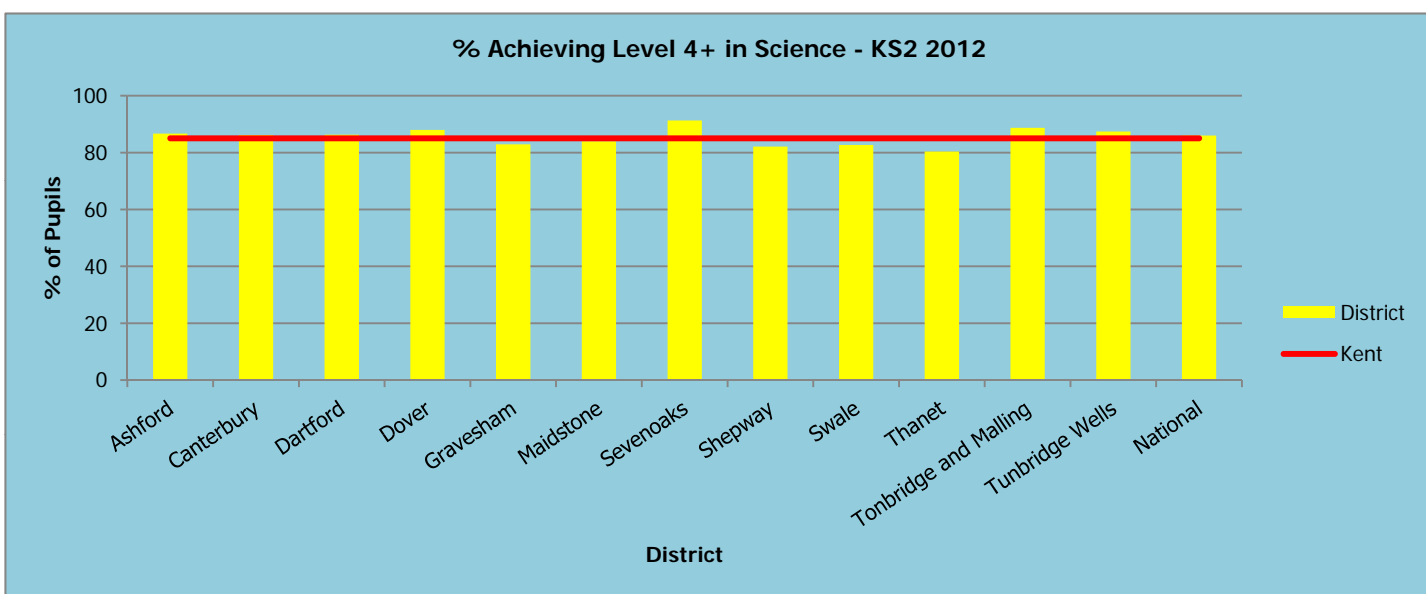
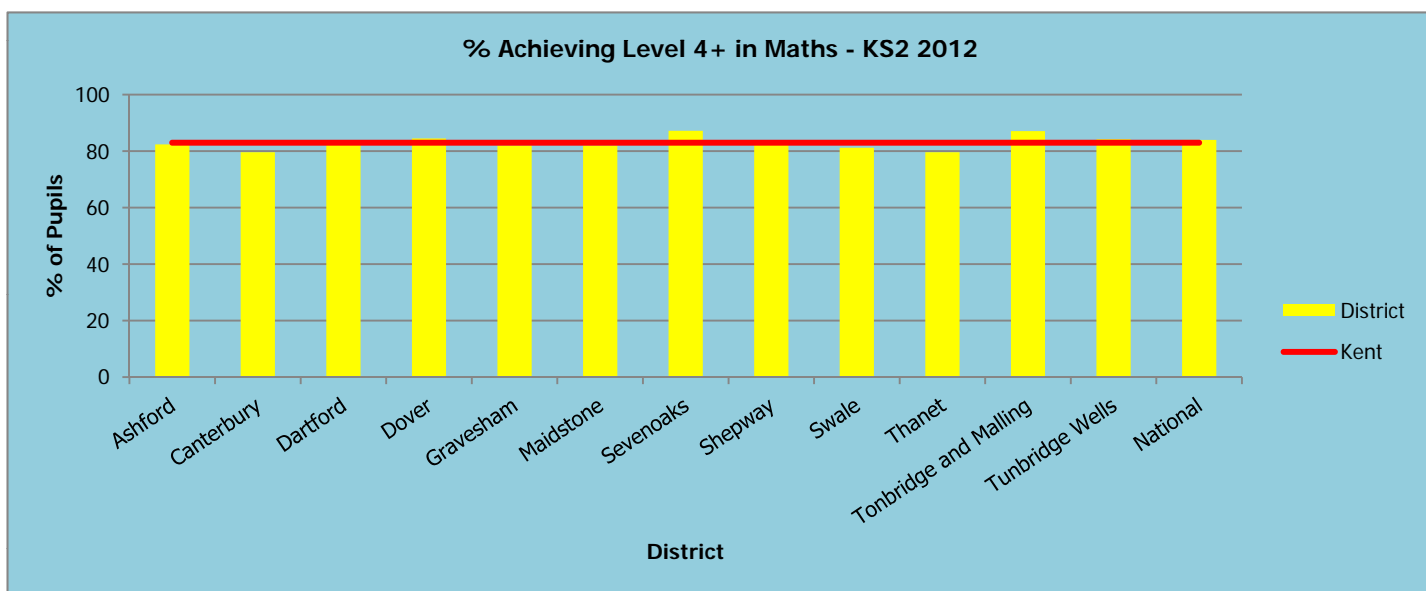
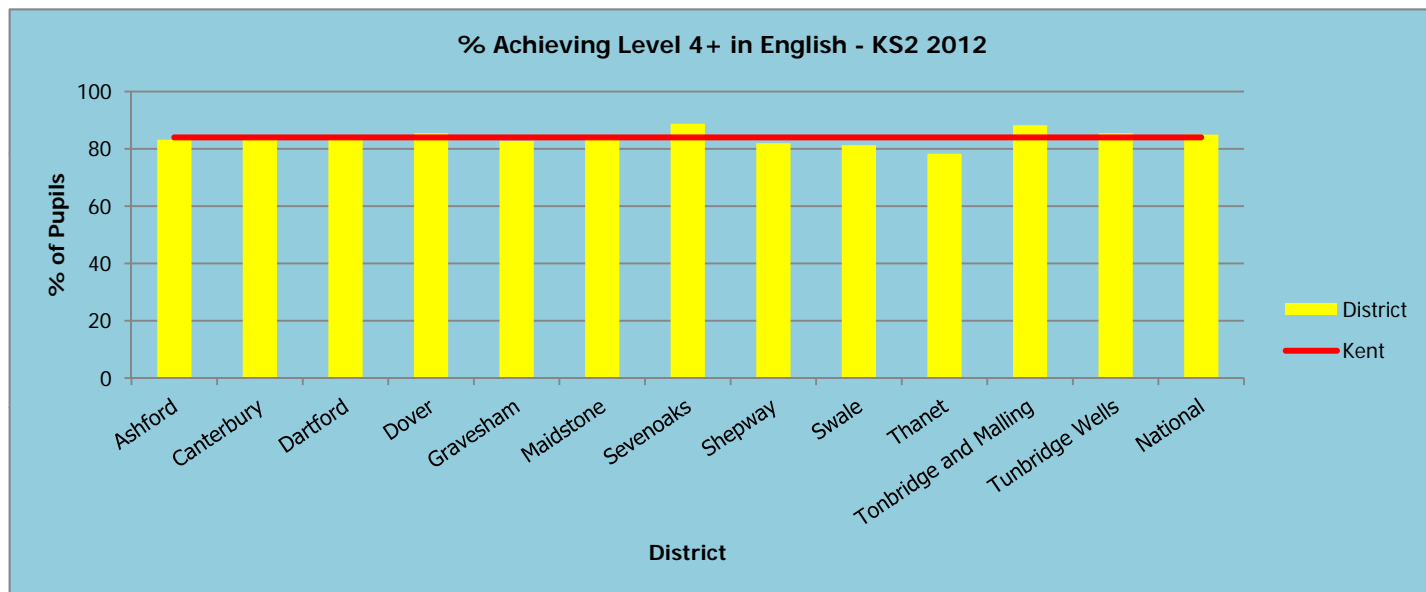
