Headline Commentary

The NEET population has remained at 3.2% this month (1,090 young people), though the Not Knowns have increased by 0.9% up to 3.7%.

The NEET population of 1,090 young people comprises 398 in the year 12 age group and 692 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has decreased slightly from last month, down to 89.6%, and is 1.4 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.0% in Sevenoaks to 4.8% In Thanet, though most districts are between 2.5% and 3.5%. Ashford, Gravesham, Maidstone, Swale, Thanet, and Tonbridge and Malling, all reduced their proportions of NEET young people in April from the previous month. NEET proportions rose in Dartford, Dover, Sevenoaks, Shepway and Tunbridge Wells, whilst they remained the same in Canterbury.

District performance for Not Knowns is less varied, and ranges from 2.8% in Canterbury to 4.5% in Sevenoaks. All districts saw an increase in their Not Known percentages in April, which may reflect seasonal fluctuations due to course end dates.

63% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was 71%, so there has been some progress in tackling the long-term NEET population.
