The figures include Yr12 & Yr13 (academic age 16 & 17) with a Kent County Council area postcode as their primary address.

Headline Commentary

Figures for April continue to show a stable position, and are in line with the figures seen last month.

The NEET population has remained at 3.1% this month (1,021 young people). This compares to a figure of 3.0% at the same time last year. The Not Known figure has reduced to 2.9% this month (956 young people). This is an improvement on last month, but significantly higher than the Not Known figure in the same month last year, which was 1.8%.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is at 6.1%, down from 6.4% last month. The figure for the same month last year was 4.8%, which was the lowest ever-recorded combined figure in Kent.

The NEET Interdependencies group has met again and is working to review and streamline processes to support a reduction in our figures, particularly the Not Known cohort, in order to ensure young people are offered the best support possible to move into a positive destination.

The NEET population of 1,021 young people comprises 381 in the year 12 age group and 640 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has remained the same as last month at 89.9%, and is 1.5 percentage points lower than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.6% in Sevenoaks to 5.4% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.0% and 3.0%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 2.1% in Maidstone to 4.0% in Swale.

The collection of Intended Destinations for Year 11 pupils is almost complete. Schools have submitted returns, and Intended Destinations are currently known for 82.4% of young people. Further work is taking place to ensure as complete a dataset as possible. Gaps are mostly caused by young people who are undecided and therefore do not yet have an intended destination, or where there are matching and data quality issues.

Yr12 & Yr13 NEET %

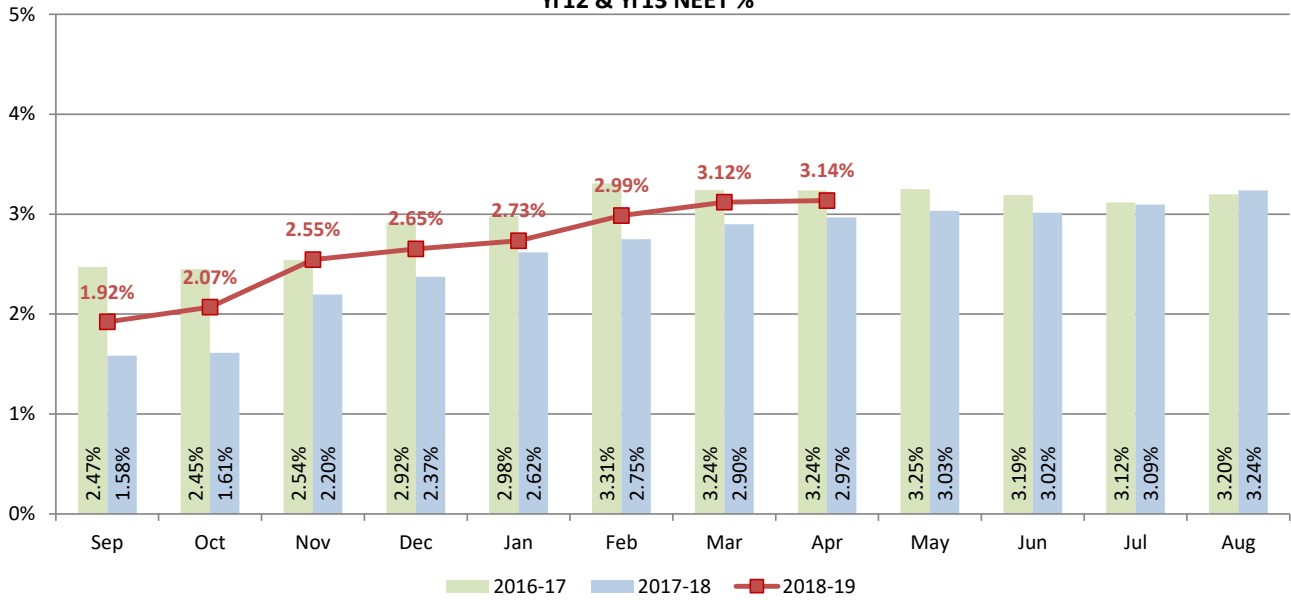

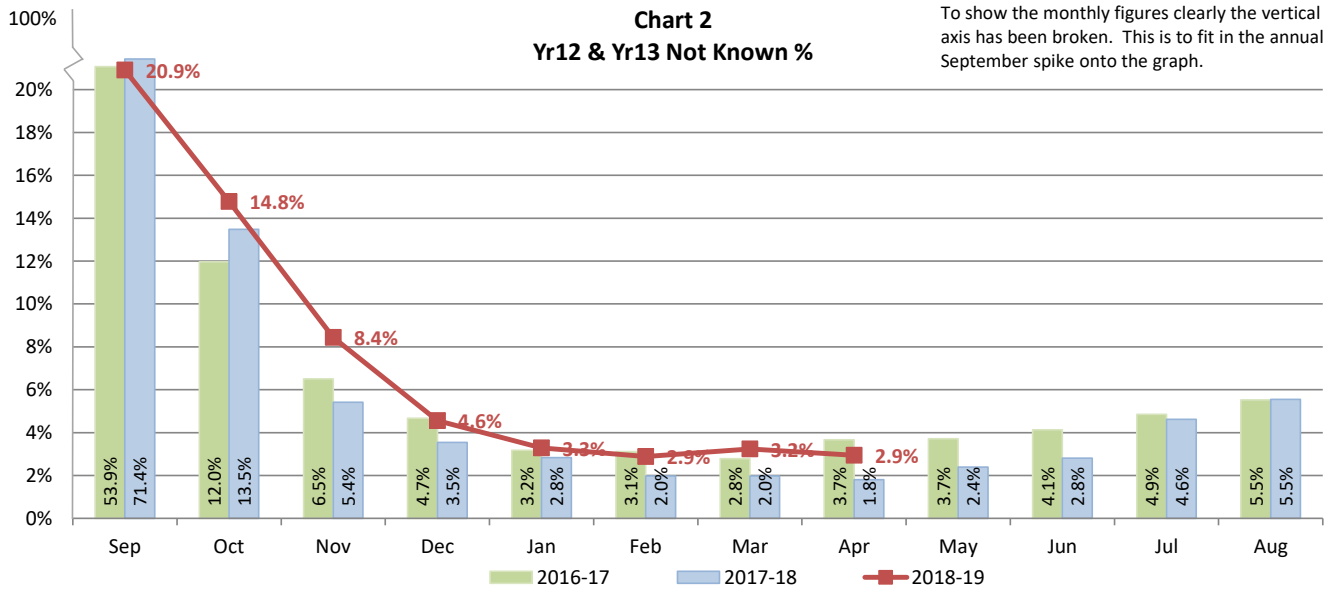
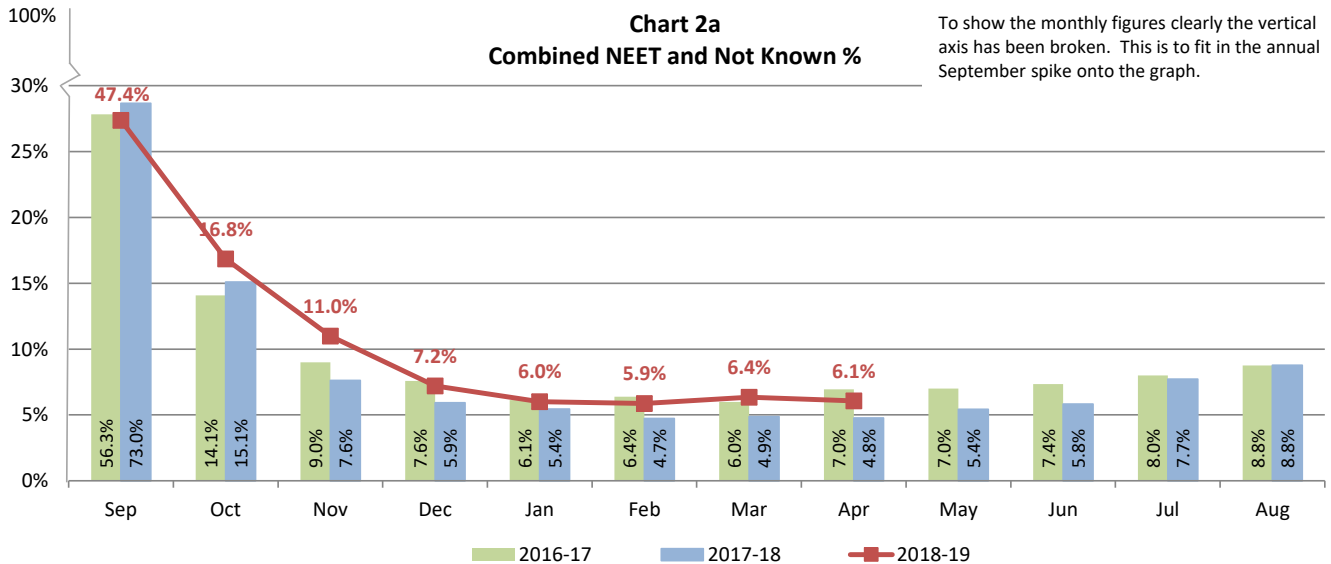

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs March 2019

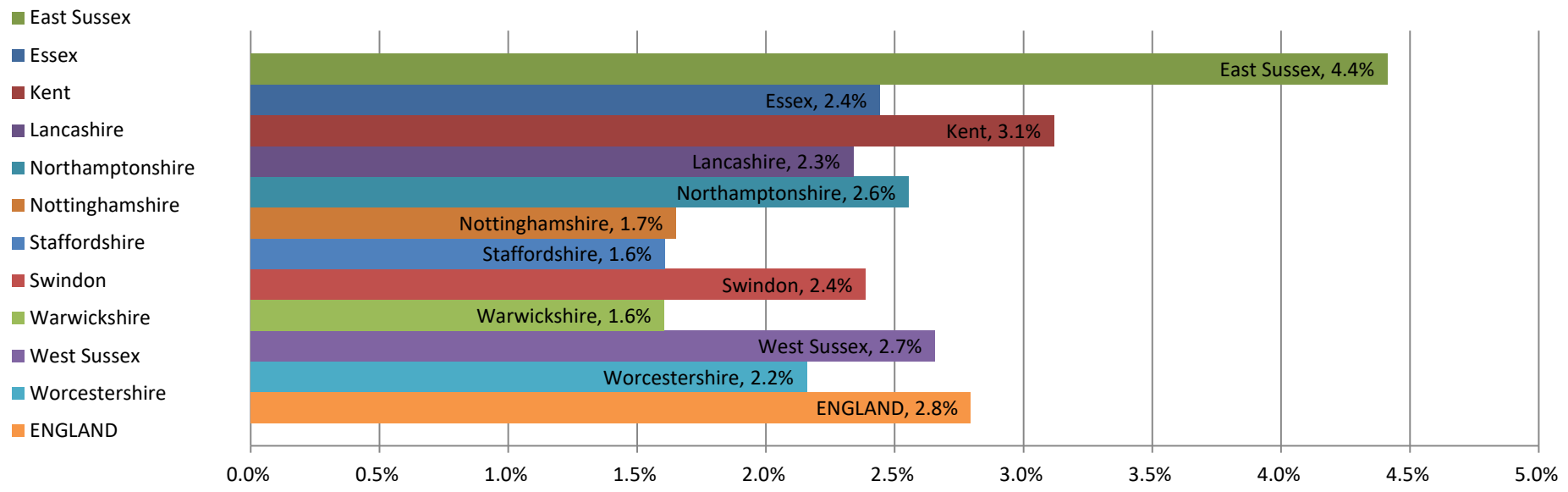
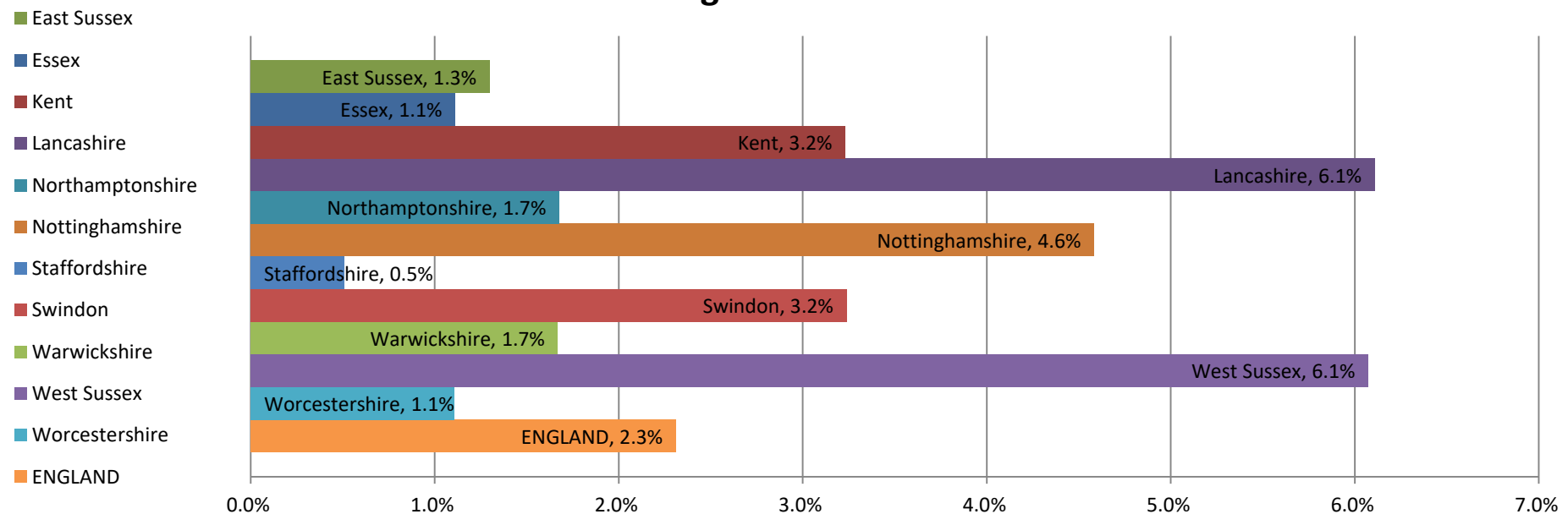


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns March 2019
