Headline Commentary

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

The percentage of not knowns has continued to reduce this month as the Census and NAS data is matched to the Not Knowns list. The Not Known percentage dropped from last month by 0.2 percentage points.

The NEET population is currently at 3.4% compared 3.1% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 3.4%, down from 3.6% last month. This is slightly higher than this time last year at 3.2% in March 2019. The Participation rate has improved again to 89.4%, up from 89.3% last month, this is down 0.5 percentage points compared with the same point last year which is an improvement compared to last month's comparison.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.3% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.6% In Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 2.2% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.3% in Thanet.

The Department for Education (DfE) publishes each year the proportion of young people not in education, employment or training (NEET). The performance of all Local Authorities is averaged in December, January and February. For these months, Management Information were able to include Positive Destinations created after the end of the month.

The percentage of Intended Destinations recorded for Year 11 Pupils is reported from February. Last month the percentage of recorded Intended Destinations was 55.0%. March's percentage has increased by 16.0% to 71.0%. MI will continue to engage with schools to follow up on those outstanding where possible during these difficult times.

Yr12 & Yr13 NEET %

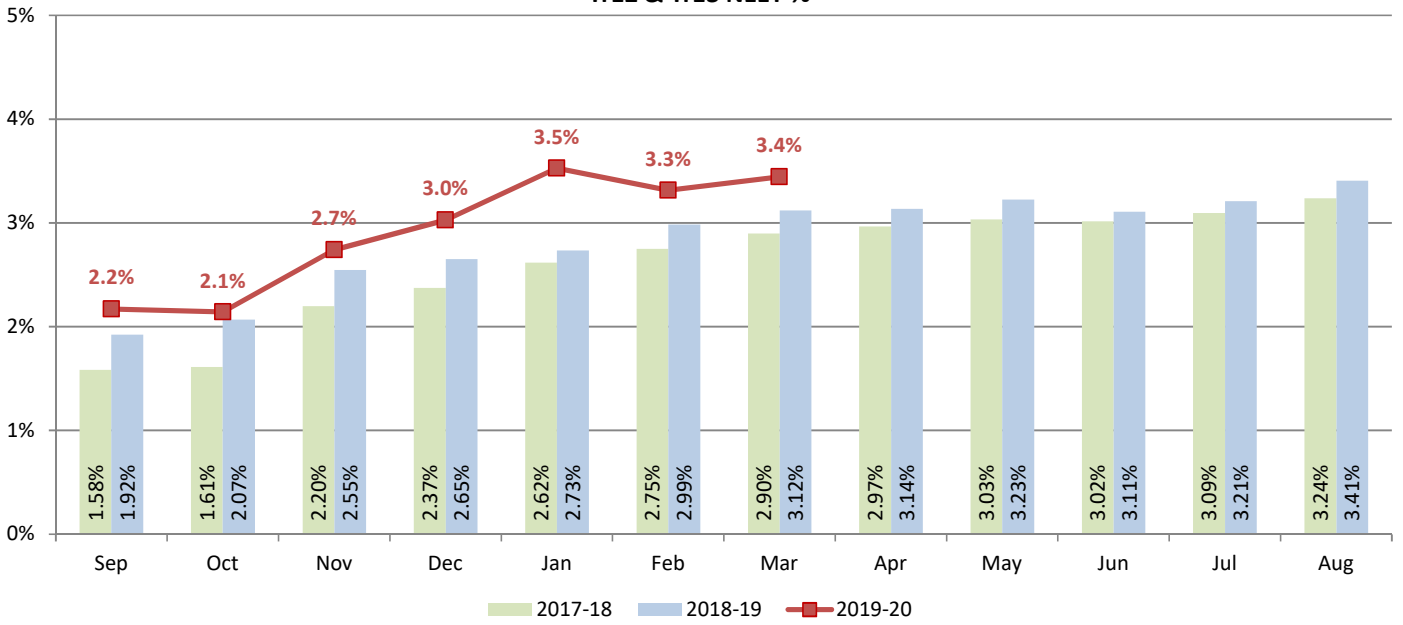
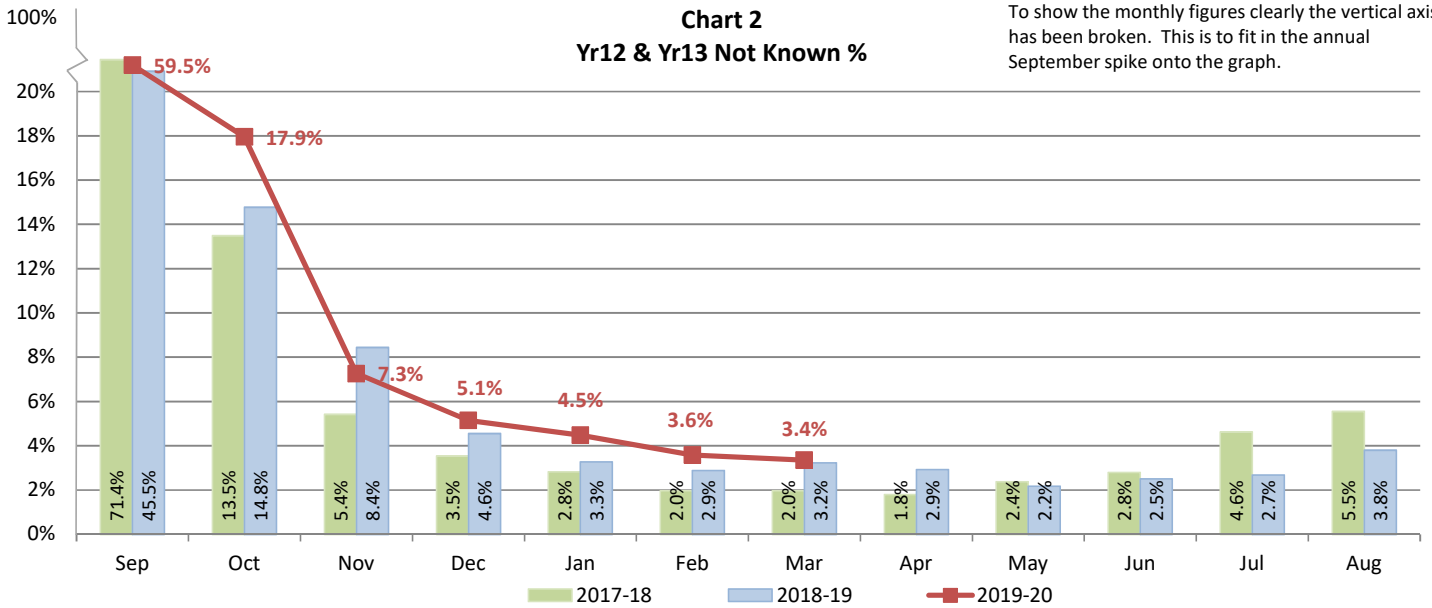
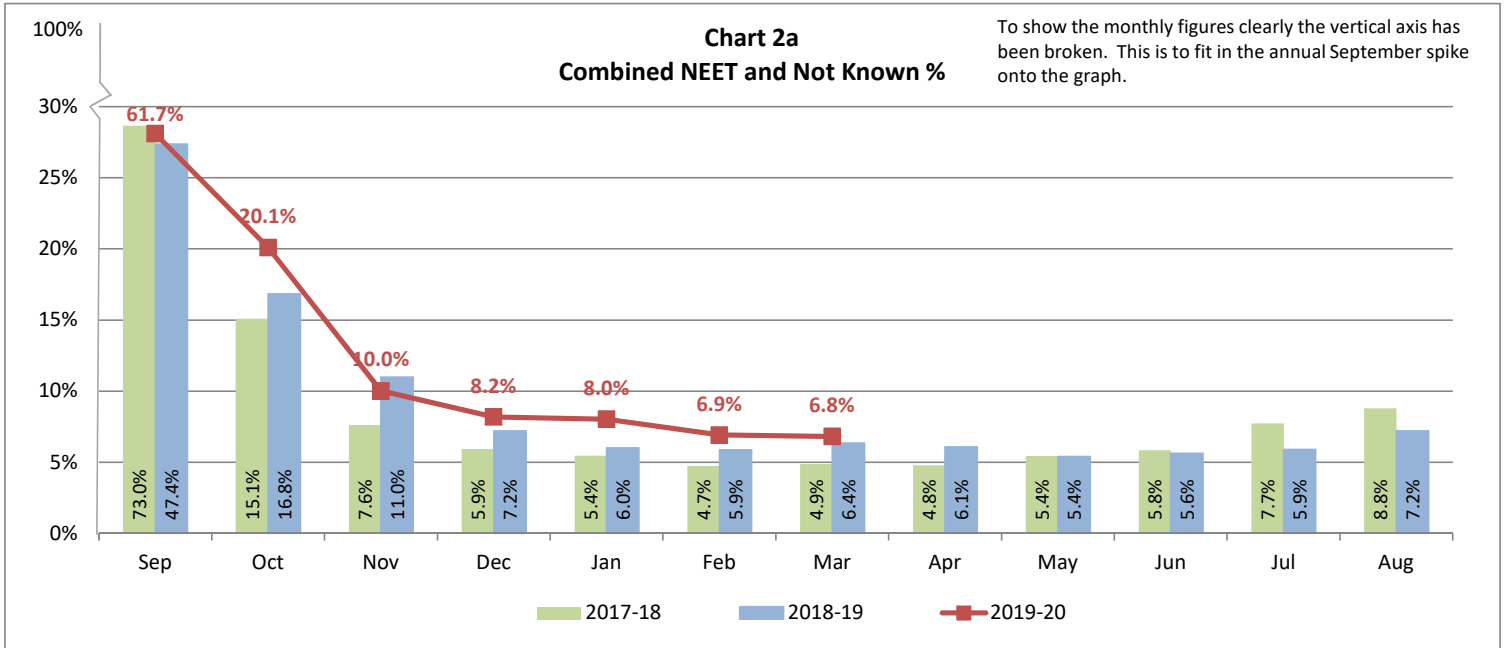

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs February 2020

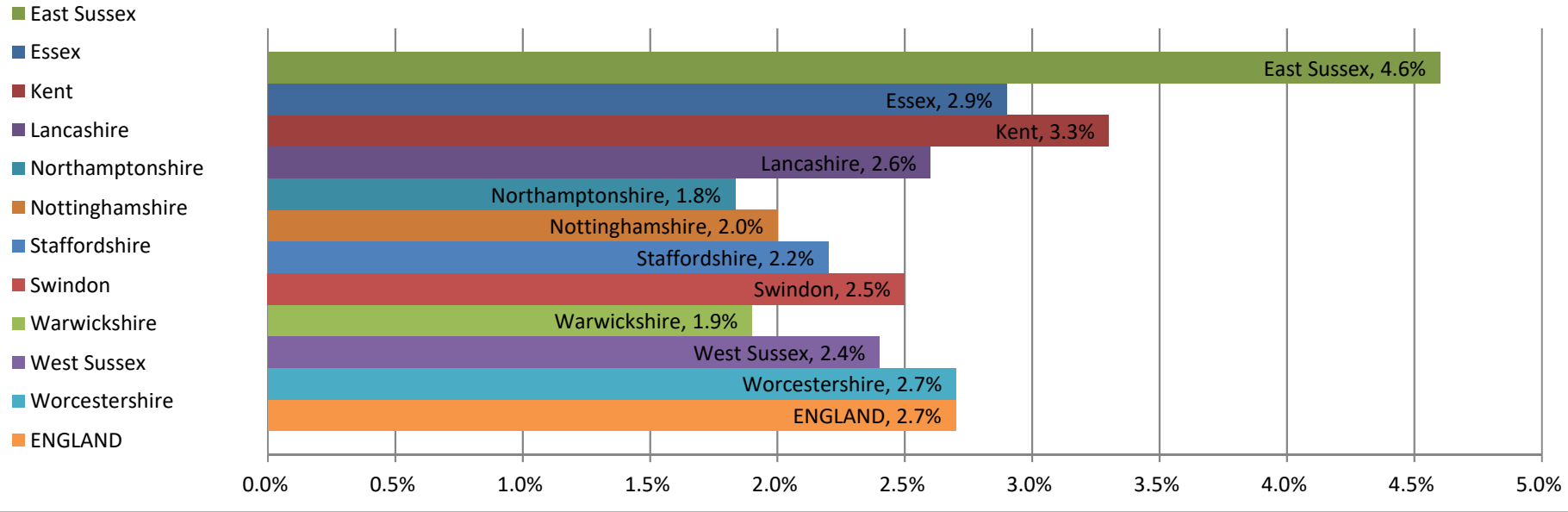
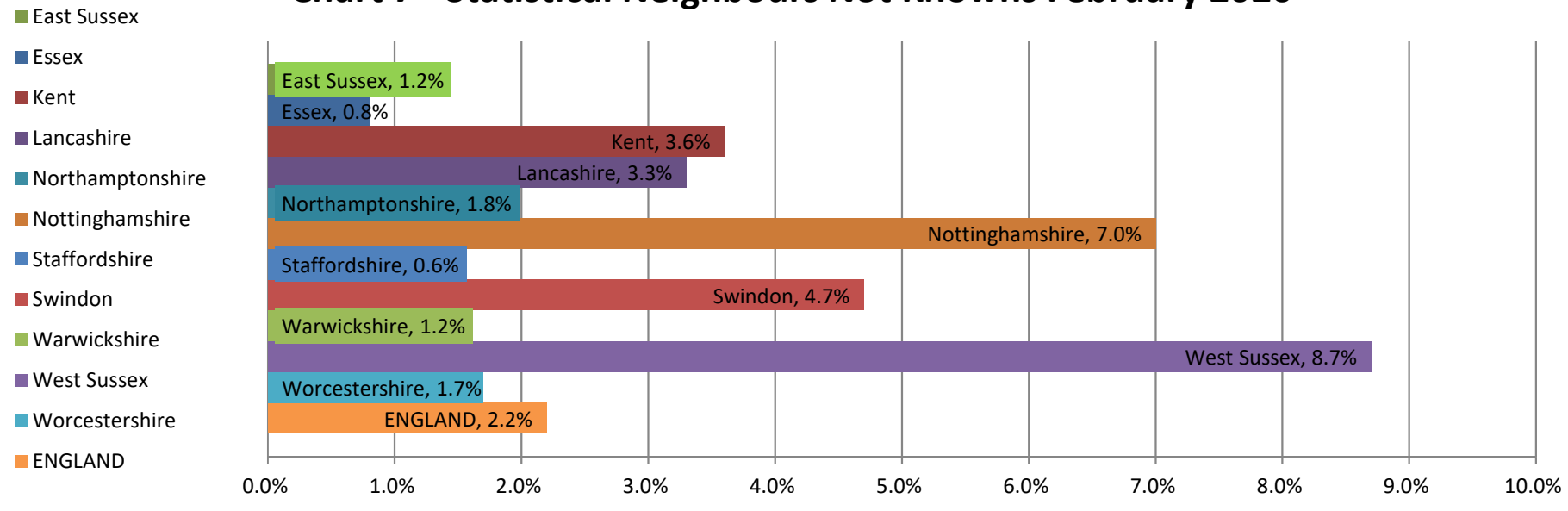


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns February 2020
