## **Tracking Destinations of Young People**

Kent County Council Management Information (MI) and The Education People (TEP) continue to work together in partnership with schools to fulfil the statutory duty to track the destinations of young people up to the end of Year 13 or until the young person's 25<sup>th</sup> birthday if they have an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP). This letter outlines the data requirements of schools which are summarised in Appendix A (at the end of the letter).

Last year the Not Known figure for Kent fell to below the national average because of improved data returns from schools. The main contributory factors were the inclusion of contact details and timely submissions to the local authority. I would like to thank you for your support and look forward to furthering improvements this year.

Schools who are concerned about Year 11s who are at risk of becoming NEET should continue to work with The Education People's Engagement Officers to ensure they have an onward destination in September. Please email <u>Owen.Bartholomew@theeducationpeople.org</u>

MI will be gathering data via Perspective Lite using the templates available on KELSI to facilitate your returns: <u>https://www.kelsi.org.uk/school-management/data-and-reporting/management-information/coreplus-team-tracking-young-people</u>

- Post-16 enrolment 2023 return to be uploaded by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023 via Perspective Lite for all students
  of post statutory education age on main roll at your school. Please ensure the data is up to date and does not
  include students who have not returned to your school.
- In Year Leavers & Joiners returns to be uploaded on the last working day of each month from 29<sup>th</sup> September for all students from Year 9 age and above. Nil returns to be emailed to <u>MICorePlus@kent.gov.uk</u>
- September Guarantee offers 2024: return to be uploaded <u>no later than</u> 26<sup>th</sup> April 2024 for Year 11 either via Perspective Lite or KentChoices. For Year 12 students we will roll over your students (into Year 13) on your behalf. Please check the pupil list file once it is uploaded onto Perspective Lite and notify us of any leavers and joiners.

TEP will be gathering data via secure email and telephone for individual students throughout the year and at key times. See Appendix A for further details.
