





Key Stage One Trend by Area and District - 2014 to 2016







Key Stage Two Trend by Area and District - 2014 to 2016





Key Stage Four Attainment by Area and District 2016












Key Stage Four Attainment by Area and District 2016





Key Stage Four Trend by Area and District - 2014 to 2016










Post-16 Attainment by Area and District 2016










