Headline Commentary

Figures for November have largely stabilised, following the system being updated in September and October with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges, though some college data is still being imported into the system.

The NEET population is currently at 2.5% compared to 2.2% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 8.4%, down from 14.8% last month. This is up from 5.4% at the same time last year, but this is due to enrolment data not yet in the system for all college students.

The Participation rate has improved again to 86.4%, up from 81.1% last month, though this is down 3.9 percentage points compared with the same point last year.

District performance for NEET ranges from 1.5% in Sevenoaks up to 4.2% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 4.1% in Tunbridge Wells to 12.5% in Dover, indicating the districts where enrolment data is not yet on the system in full.

Work is taking place to ensure we have contact details for the full NEET and Not Known cohorts. It can be a challenge to maintain monitoring and support when young people's details can change regularly.
