Headline Commentary

It is at the beginning of the academic year that the system is updated with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges, and given the size of Kent, this takes several weeks to complete.

A significant amount of work has been done to reduce the amount of Not Knowns since last month however, there is still some way to go to be in line with National figure you might expect for this time of year.

The NEET population at 2.1% this month (692 young people) has decreased by 8 young people compared to last month. This compares to a figure of 2.1% at the same time last year. District performance for NEET varies from 1.4% in Dover to 3.1% In Gravesham. East Kent are 3.8% whereas the other Areas are below 2.0%.

The Not Known figure has decreased to 17.9% this month (5,798 young people) which is a decrease of 13,399 young people. However this compares to 14.8% on the same month last year. Engagement officers are following up with Schools and Colleges in Kent for enrolment data not yet in the system for some students. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 10.1% in Tunbridge Wells to 25.0% in Ashford. The North and the West are 13.8% and 11.5% respectively with the South and East being 23.4% and 27.5%.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 20.1%, which compares to last months figure of 61.7%, which is a decrease of 41.6%. The same month last year was 16.8%.

The Participation rate has decreased when compared to the same month last year from 81.1% in October 2018 to 77.7% in October 2019.

The figures for September Guarantees Total Offers Made for Years 11 and 12 was 93.2% an improvement on last year which was 92.7%.

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs September 2019

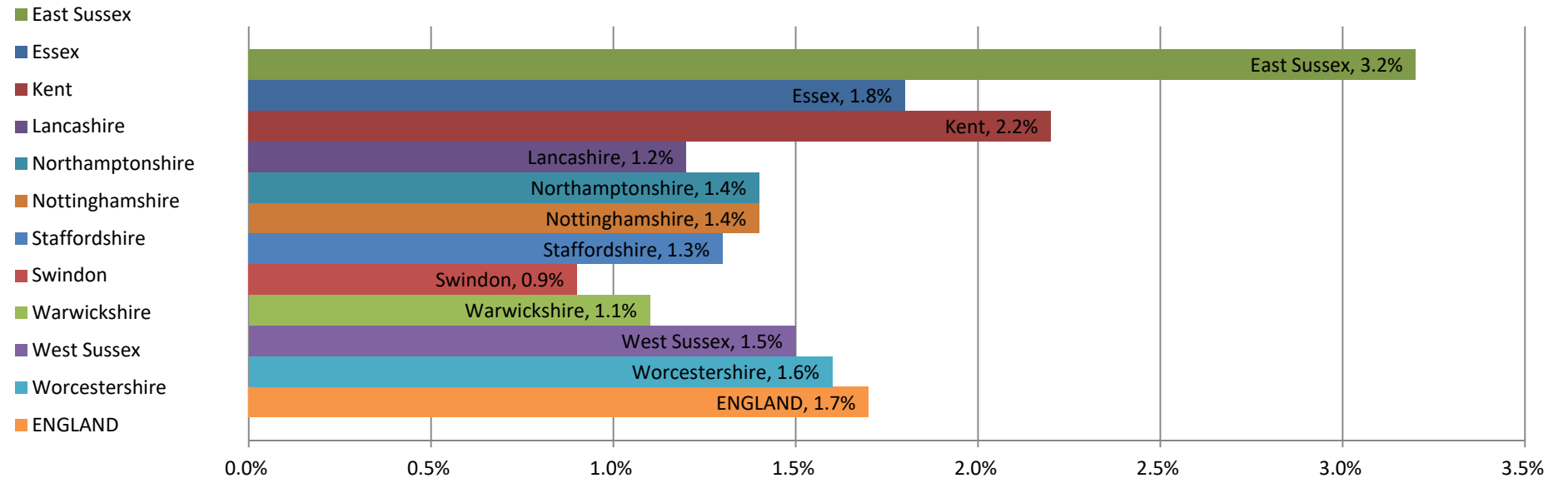


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns September 2019
