
The NEET population is currently at 3.2% compared to 3.6% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 2.1%, compared to 3.1% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 91.1%, compared to 90.2% the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Sevenoaks to 5.1% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 1.1% in Tonbridge & Malling and Tunbridge Wells to 3.1% in Thanet.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

Please note the Statisical Neighbour report has been updated to reflect the new neighbours. Northamptonshire has been replaced by West Northamptonshire and West Sussex has been replaced by Suffolk.


Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown





