Headline Commentary

The NEET population has risen slightly to 3.3% this month (1,094 young people), though the Not Knowns remaining at 3.7%. At the same point last year, the equivalent figures were 4.1% NEET and 4.3% Not Knowns, so significant improvement has been made in reducing both cohorts.

The NEET population of 1,094 young people comprises 407 in the year 12 age group and 687 in the year 13 age group. The Participation rate has decreased slightly from last month, down to 89.4%, but this is 1.8 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.0% in Sevenoaks to 4.9% In Thanet, though most districts are between 2.5% and 3.5%. Ashford, Canterbury, Dartford, Gravesham, Shepway, and Tunbridge Wells, all reduced their proportions of NEET young people in May from the previous month. NEET proportions rose in Dover, Maidstone, Swale, Thanet, and Tonbridge and Malling, whilst they remained the same in Sevenoaks.

District performance for Not Knowns is less varied, and ranges from 3.0% in Canterbury to 4.7% in Ashford. Seven districts (Ashford, Canterbury, Dartford, Dover, Shepway, Swale, and Tunbridge Wells) saw an increase in their Not Known percentages in April, which may reflect seasonal fluctuations due to course end dates.

66% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more, up from 63% last month. In the same month last year this figure was 72%, so there has been some progress in tackling the long-term NEET population.

Further analysis is taking place to gain detailed insight into specific vulnerable groups within the NEET and Not Known cohorts, in order to target their support in the most appropriate way possible, in particular those young people who are caring for their own child, and those with Special Educational Needs.


