# Headline Commentary

Figures for December tend to reflect, along with January and February, the most reliable reporting period in the academic year.

The NEET population has increased slightly this month to 2.7% (861 young people), up from 2.5% last month. This compares to a figure of 2.4% at the same time last year. This increase to 2.7% is small given the Not Known population fell to 4.6% this month (1479 young people), down from 8.4%, showing only a small proportion of these Not Knowns were found to be NEET. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 3.5%.

However, as both the NEET and Not Known figures are higher than at the same point last year, work is taking place to review our processes and practice in order to ensure that any improvements that are required can be actioned quickly.

The NEET population of 861 young people comprises 277 in the year 12 age group and 584 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has increased by 3.4 percentage points from last month, up to 89.8%, though this is 1.6 percentage points lower than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.4% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.4% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.2% and 2.9%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 2.8% in Tunbridge Wells to 5.9% in Thanet. All districts saw a decrease in their Not Known percentages in December.

28% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was also 28%, so whilst there has been a slight rise in the NEET population, it has not been caused by, or led to, an increase in the long-term NEET population.

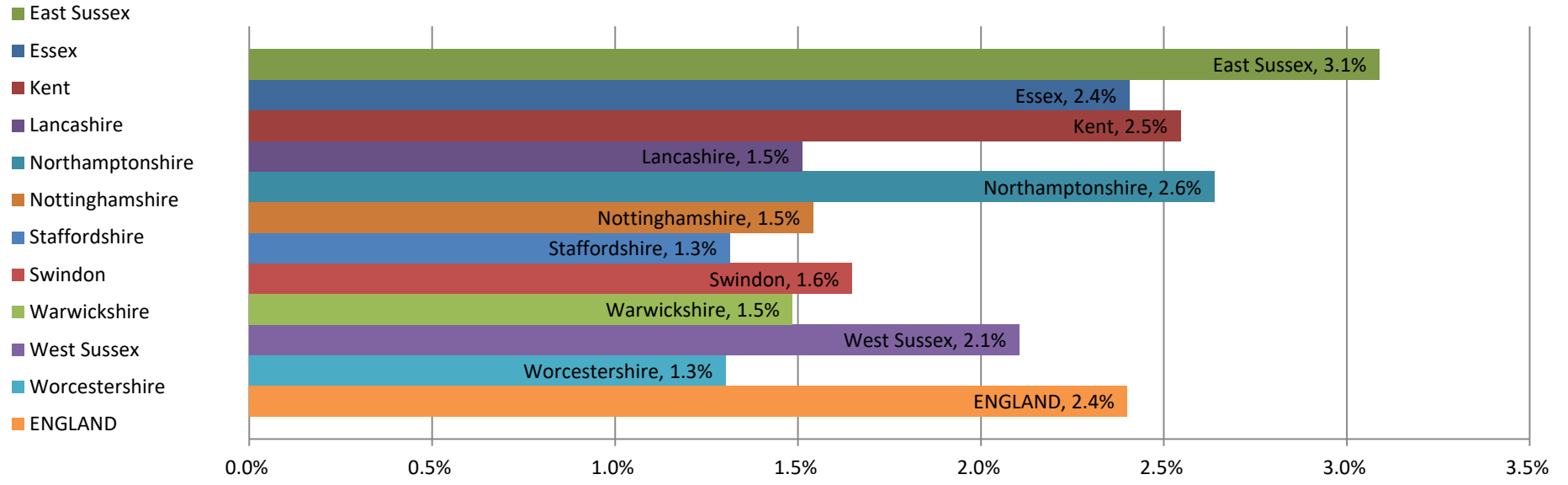
