Headline Commentary

Figures for January tend to reflect, along with December and February, the most reliable reporting period in the academic year.

The NEET population remained at 2.7% this month (888 young people). This compares to a figure of 2.6% at the same time last year. The Not Known population fell significantly to 3.3% this month (1,066 young people), down from 4.6%, yet this did not convert into increased NEET figures. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 2.8%.

The NEET population of 861 young people comprises 277 in the year 12 age group and 584 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has increased slightly from last month, up to 90.7%, and is 0.9 percentage points lower than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.5% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.4% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.2% and 2.9%.

District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 2.3% in Tunbridge Wells to 3.9% in Folkestone & Hythe. All districts saw a decrease in their Not Known percentages in January.

35% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was 42%, so whilst there has been a slight rise in the NEET population, it has not been caused by, or led to, an increase in the long-term NEET population.

Work has recently taken place to review our processes and practice in order to ensure that they are as effective as possible. This will support both the accuracy and timeliness of data recording, and how it is used effectively to support and reduce the NEET population.

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs December 2018

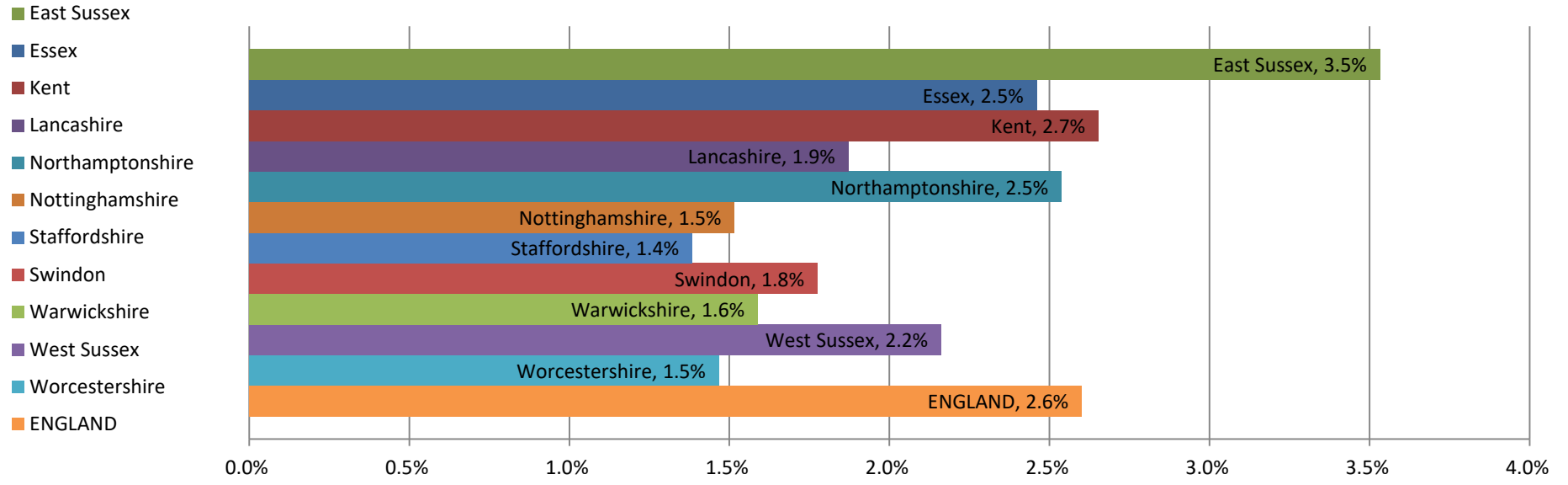


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns December 2018
