The figures include Yr12 & Yr13 (academic age 16 & 17) with a Kent County Council area postcode as their primary address.

Headline Commentary

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

The NEET population is currently at 3.5% compared to 3.6% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 3.2%, compared to 2.9% at the same time last year.

The Participation rate is 90.7%, which is an improvement from the same point last year, 89.6%.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.7% in Sevenoaks to 4.4% in Gravesham. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 2.3% in Tonbridge & Malling to 4.7% in Swale.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 6.7% compared to last months figure of 6.9%. The same month last year was 6.5%.

The Department for Education (DfE) publishes an estimate each year of the proportion of young people not in education, employment or training (NEET). The performance of all Local Authorities is averaged in December, January and February. For these months, Management Information are able to include Positive Destinations created after the end of the month.

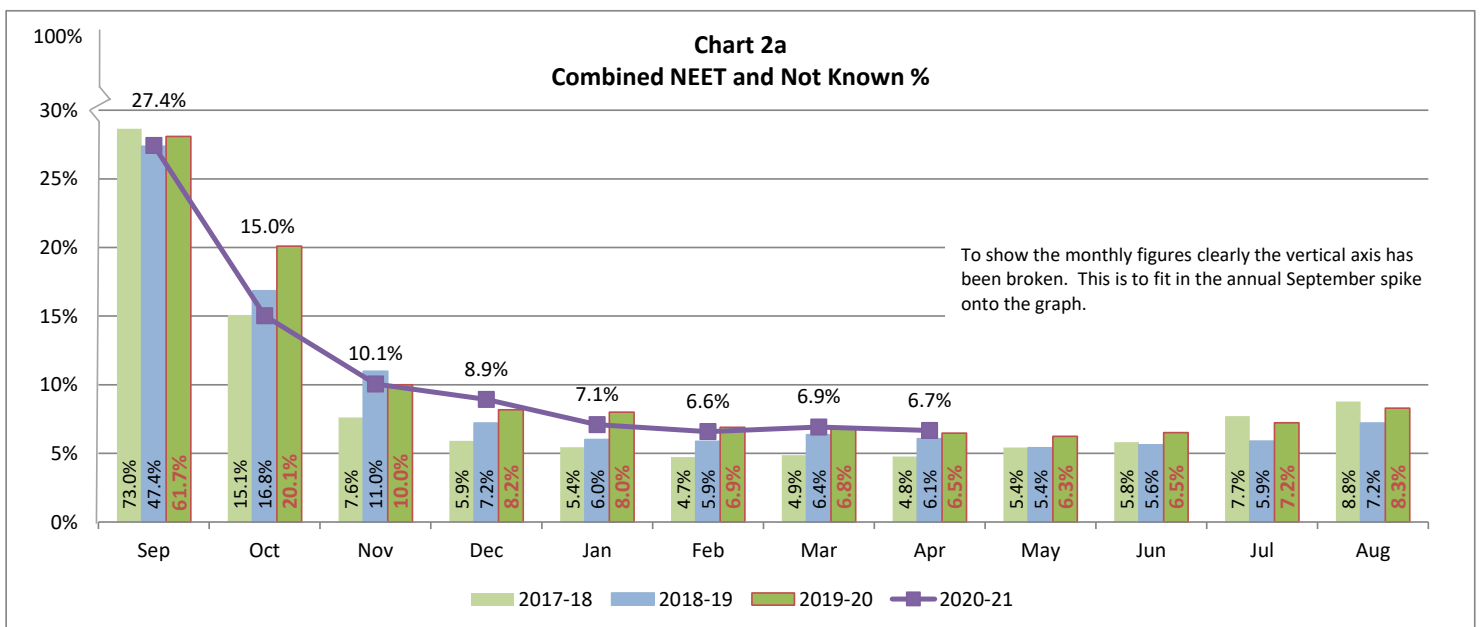
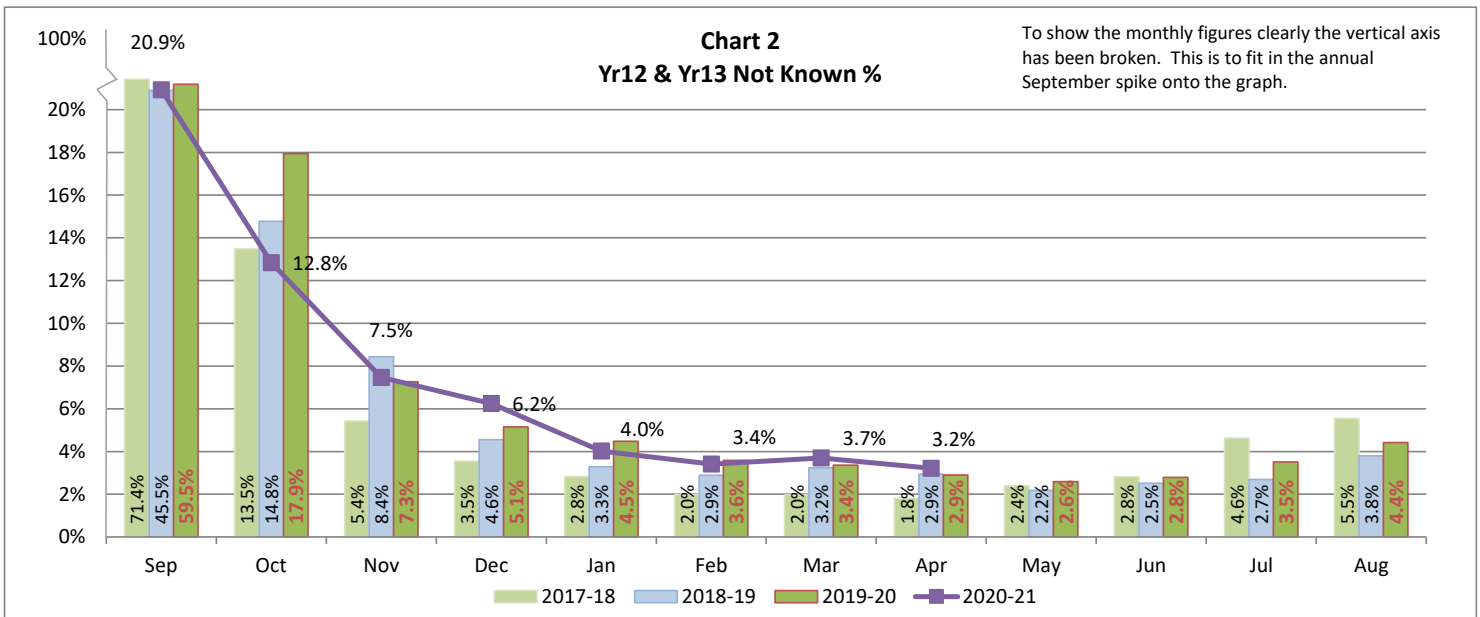
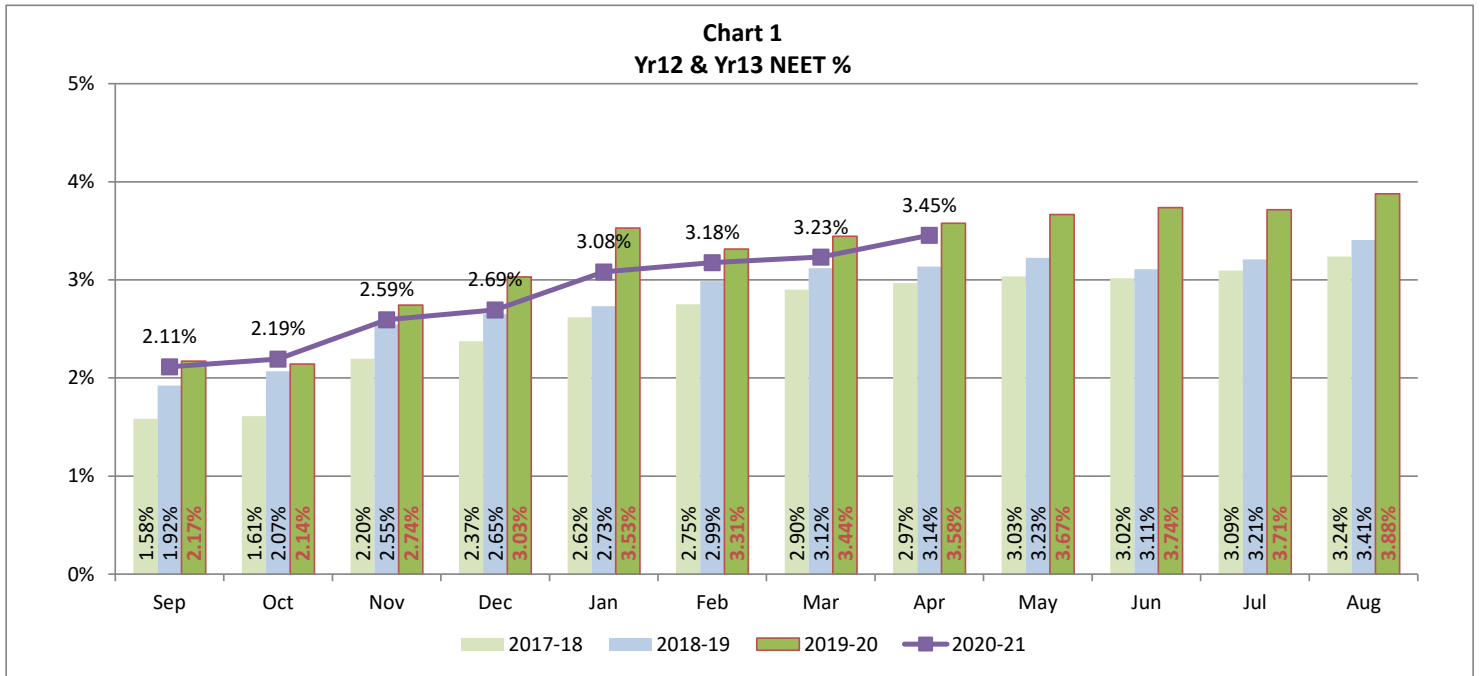

Yr12 & Yr13 Not Knowns subset CIC KCC responsibility

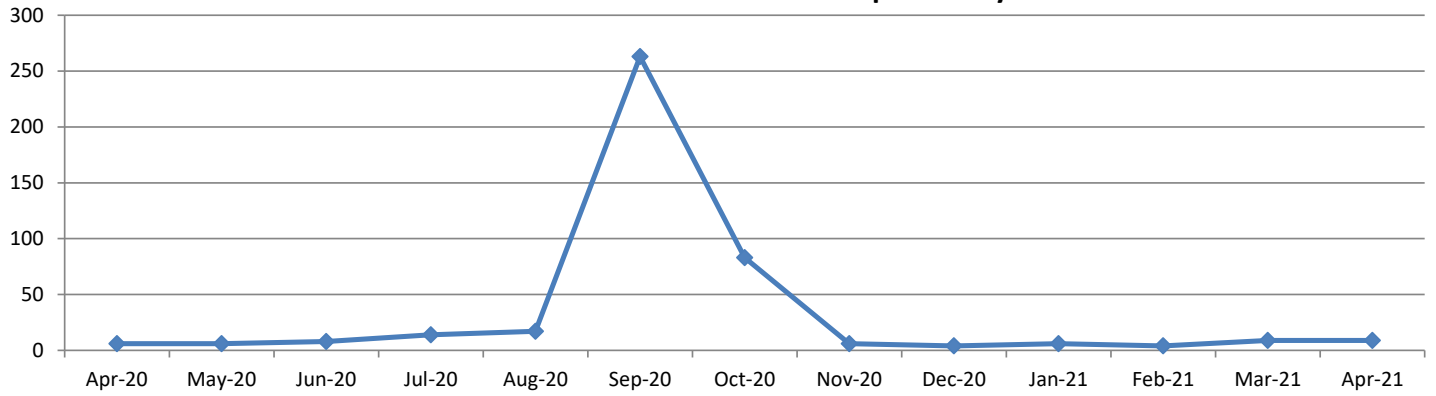

Yr12 & Yr13 Not Knowns Supervised by YOT

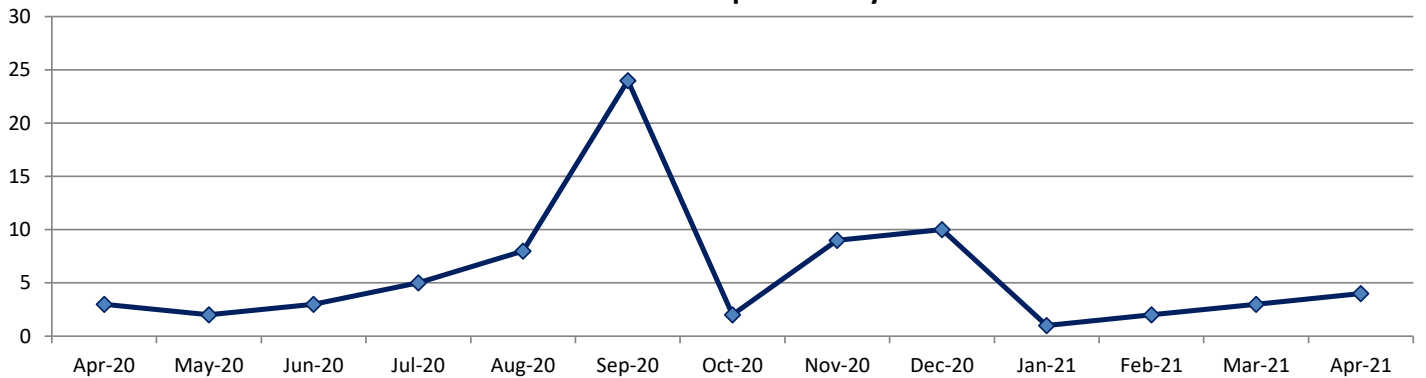
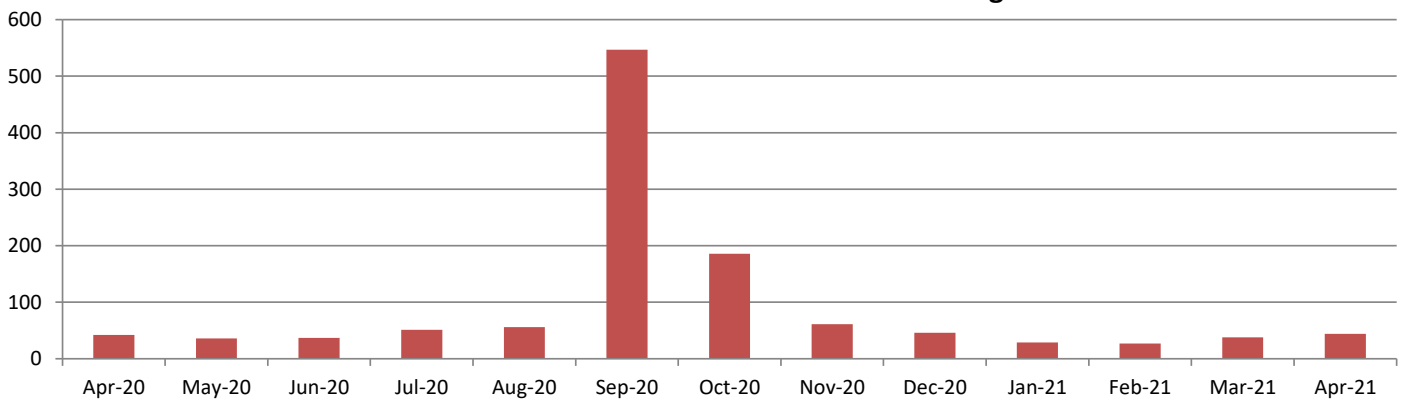


Chart 5

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs March 2021

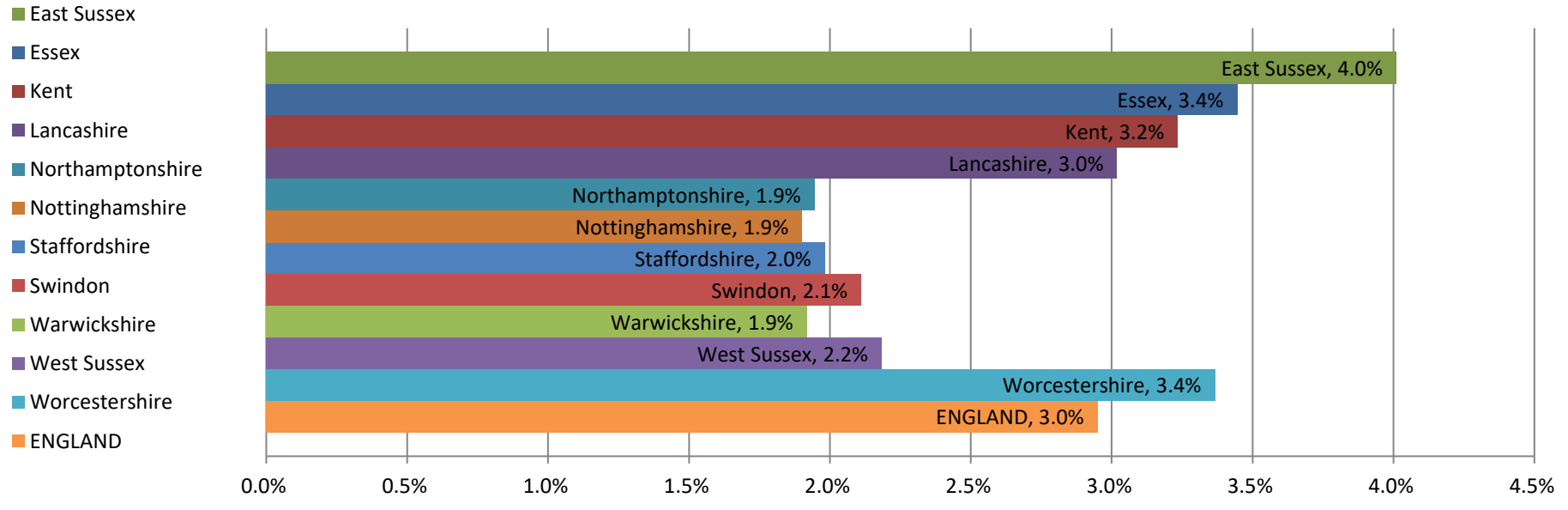


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns March 2021
