GUIDANCE TO EARLY YEARS SETTINGS: REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO PRIVACY NOTICES UNDER THE DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998

The Department for Education (DfE) issues guidance in connection with Privacy Notices. This guidance applies to all Private, Voluntary, Independent providers and childminders (PVI Providers) who deliver the Free Early Education. All PVI Providers are required to take the following action:

- issue the Privacy Notice to the parent(s) (or the person(s) with parental responsibility) of all current 2, 3 and 4 year old children who receive the Free Early Education as soon as possible;
- issue the same notice to the parent(s) (or the person(s) with parental responsibility) of 2, 3 and 4 year old children new to the setting, ideally as part of the enrolment process

In addition to issuing the Notice directly to parents/carers, PVI Providers may also include this Notice in other communications with parents/carers (e.g. the Early Years Prospectus, Annual Report, Individual Child Report, etc). Providers may also choose to display the Notice on their website or in a prominent location in the setting.
