What is 30 Hours of Free Childcare?

The Childcare Bill 2015 is delivering the Government's election manifesto commitment to giving families (where parents are working and eligible) an entitlement to 30 Hours of Free Childcare for their three and four year olds.

A child qualifies for the extended entitlement if both parents are working (or the sole parent in a lone parent family is working) and each parent earns, on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours (National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage) and less than £100k a year.

Provider Survey Update and Summary

The Provider Survey was sent out on the 7th December 2016 to all day nurseries, pre-schools, school run provisions and childminders in Kent who are registered to provide funded early education places.

The aim of the survey was to get an understanding of the current market and how Kent County Council can work with and support providers to ensure that the proposed increase to 30 Hours is sustainable and can be accessed by three and four year olds across the county.

The survey went out to 1,373 childcare providers, which consisted of 760 group provisions (including schools with maintained nurseries) and 609 childminders. Of these, 475 were returned. The overall response rate was 34%. The following table details the response rate by provider type:

It should also support your own childcare planning process as this will give you a clear idea of how many of your parents will look to take up the new offer.

We are still waiting for the final version of the Statutory Guidance and the model Provider Agreement. Once this is received we will notify all providers.

30 Hours of Free Childcare Funding Rate

Kent County Council is required to seek the views of Early Years providers on the supplements in the formula that are discretionary and also on the establishment of an SEN Inclusion Fund.

Capital Project Update

Unfortunately, Kent was not successful in securing capital from the DfE to support 30 Hours of Free Childcare. The DfE has stated that it is unable to provide feedback on reasons why. We are currently looking into other possible sources of capital funding.

Delivering 30 Hours of Free Childcare – Provider Seminars

In order to work with and support providers to ensure that the proposed increase to 30 Hours is sustainable and can be accessed by eligible three and four year olds across the county, Kent County Council is arranging twelve 30 Hours District Seminars during March 2017. These will run between <u>9 a.m. and 1 p.m.</u> In addition, and to support childminders who are not able to attend a district seminar we will be holding four Saturday area based seminars in March.
