Who is the course for?

This is a half day session for school staff and health professionals already using, or interested in using, eye gaze technology within a school or home environment.

What is it about?

Eye gaze is an access method which can be used to control a computer by using the eyes.

The workshop is mainly practical with some theoretical knowledge regarding the use of eye gaze for communication, leisure and for written recording.

What will I get out of this?

To explore and provide an increased awareness and knowledge about a range of eye gaze equipment, for example:

- What can you do with eye gaze?
- Who would benefit from using eye gaze?
- How can we teach children and young people to use eye gaze effectively?
- What are the issues arising from using eye gaze equipment?
- Which software is compatible with eye gaze?
- Which software can be made to work with eye gaze?

There will be plenty of opportunities to experience the use of eye gaze systems and different software in our experiential workshop.
