Headline Commentary

Figures for March continue to show a stable position, and are in line with the positive figures seen last month.

The NEET population has increased slightly this month to 2.9% (957 young people), up from 2.8% last month. This compares to a figure of 3.2% at the same time last year. The Not Known remained at 2.0% this month (651 young people). Along with last month, this is the lowest ever-recorded level of Not Knowns in Kent. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 2.8%.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is at 4.9%, up slightly from 4.7% last month. The figure for the same month last year was 6.0%.

Our NEET figure is the same as national, and our Not Known figure is well below national, meaning that our combined NEET and Not Known figure is also below national, which reflects the significant progress that has been made over the last year.

The NEET population of 908 young people comprises 332 in the year 12 age group and 625 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has decreased slightly from last month, down from 91.8% to 91.6%, and is 1.1 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.9% in Sevenoaks to 4.9% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.4% and 3.2%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 0.6% in Tunbridge Wells to 2.7% in Thanet.

The collection of Intended Destinations for Year 11 pupils is continuing, with Intended Destinations currently known for 86.7% of young people. There are a small number of schools that still need to submit their returns, and some 'not obtained' gaps which are being investigated.

Y12 & Y13 NEET %

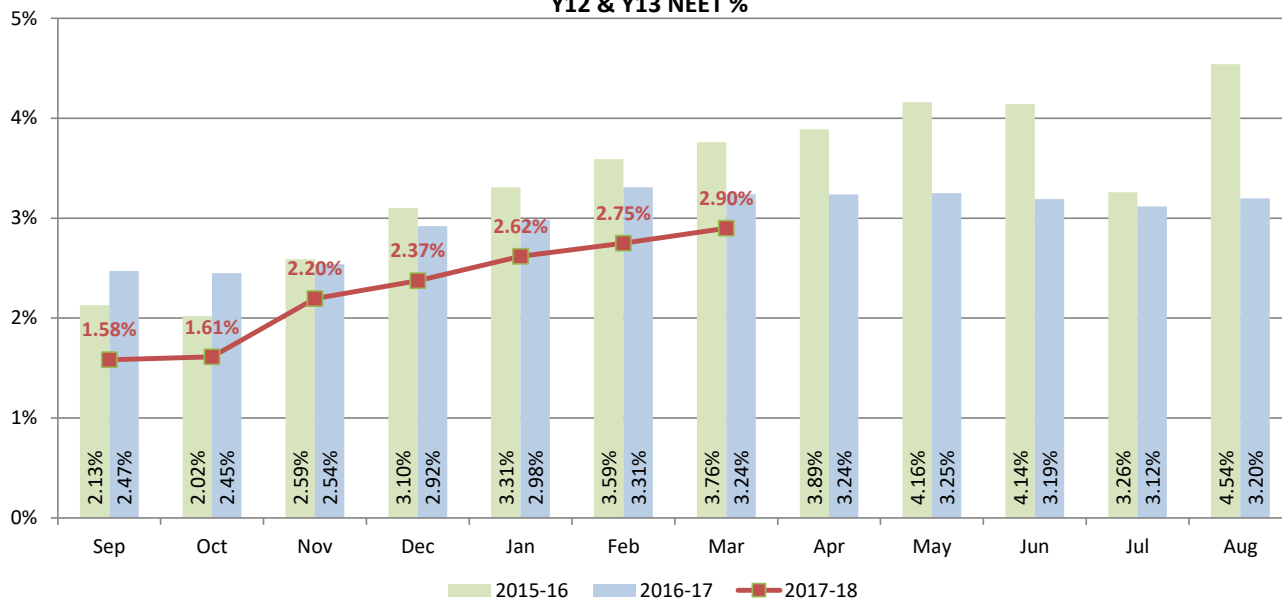

To show the monthly figures clearly the axis total has been reduced. This has resulted in the annual September spike being beyond the graph.

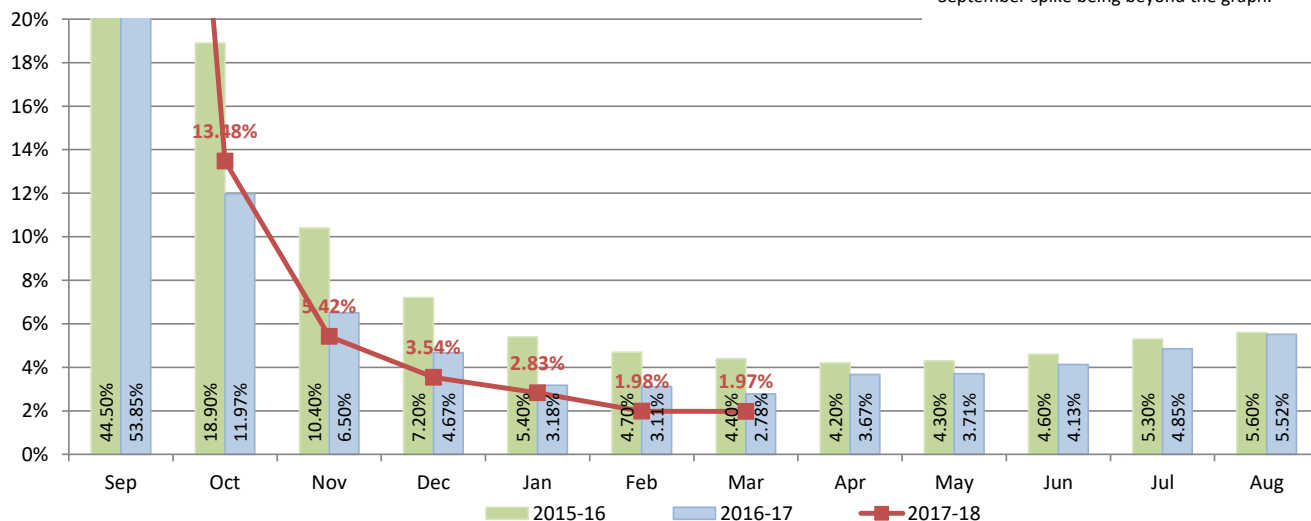
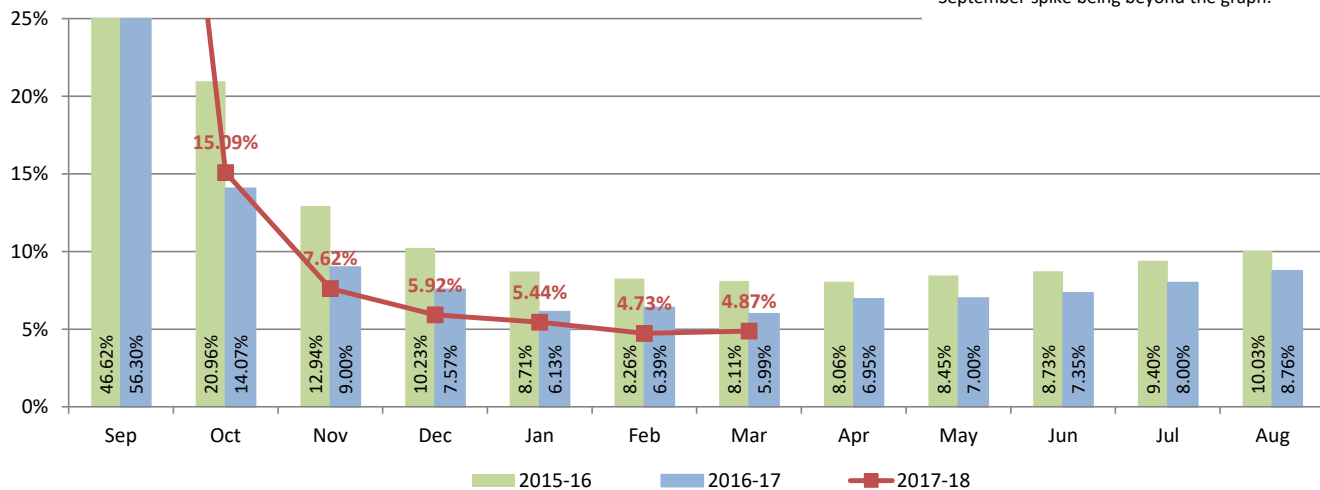

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs March 2018

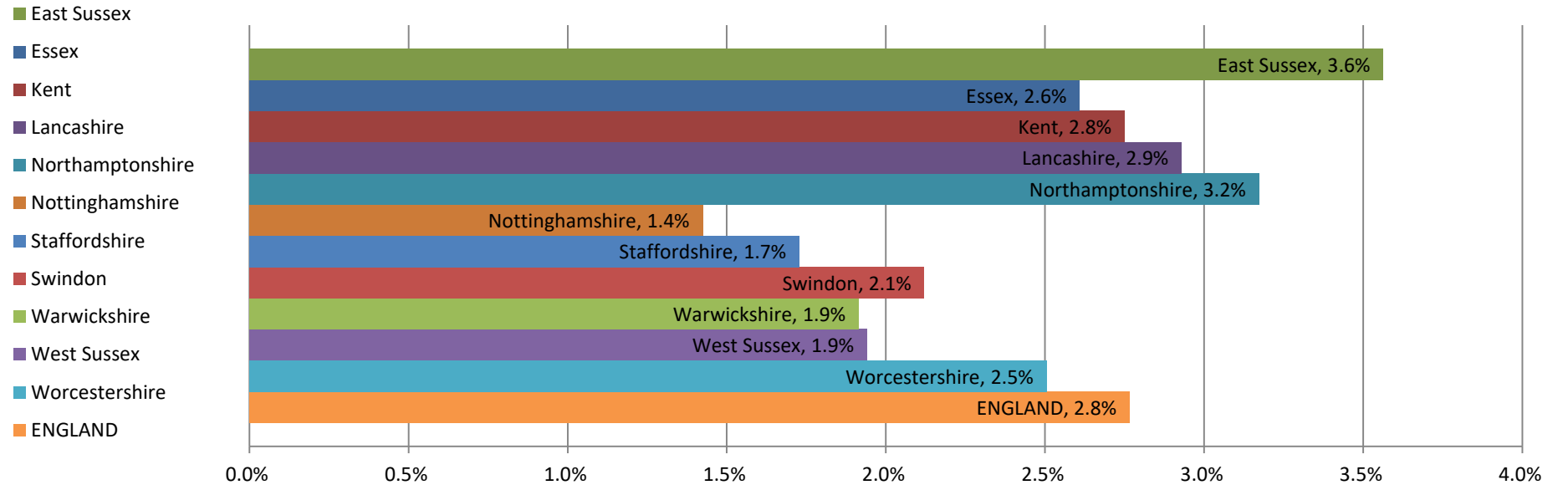
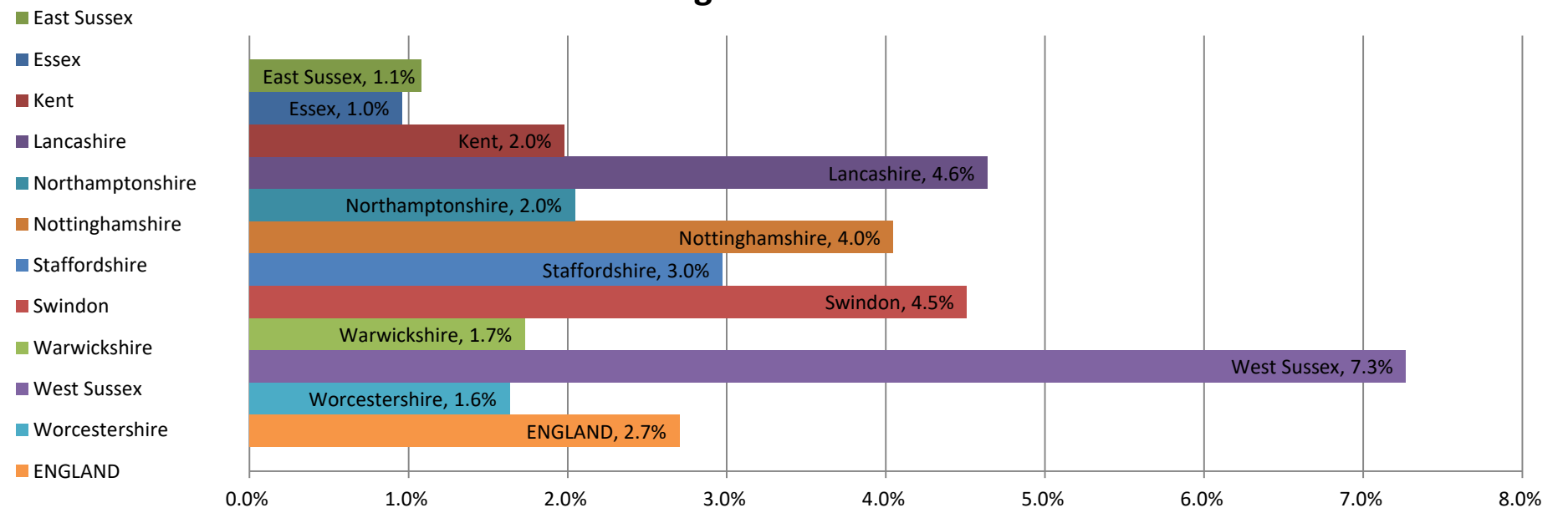


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns March 2018
