Headline Commentary

Figures for October are significantly more stable than September, but still do not quite reflect the true position of the NEET and Not Known cohorts in Kent. It is at the beginning of the academic year that the system is updated with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges, and given the size of Kent, this takes several weeks to complete.

The NEET population is currently 2.1%, and the Not Knowns are at 14.8%. Not Knowns have fallen from 45.5% last month, due to the system being updated with new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges. As the remaining enrolment data goes into the system during November the NEET figure is likely to rise slightly, whilst the Not Knowns will decrease even further.

The Participation rate has improved significantly from last month, up to 81.1%, similar to the same point last year.

District performance for Not Knowns is varied, and ranges from 8.5% in Maidstone to 22.4% in Swale. This is due to differing levels of data returns from schools and colleges.

District performance for NEET is also varied currently, and ranges from 0.9% in Sevenoaks to 3.8% in Thanet.

Districts have been working with colleges to support young people in their first few weeks at college to ensure any issues can be addressed quickly and appropriately.
