Headline Commentary

Figures for February tend to reflect, along with December and January, the most reliable reporting period in the academic year.

The NEET population rose slightly to 3.0% this month (970 young people), up from 2.7% last month. This compares to a figure of 2.8% at the same time last year. The Not Known population fell to 2.9% this month (937 young people), down from 3.3%, which may partly explain the increased NEET figures. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 2.0%.

The NEET population of 999 young people comprises 343 in the year 12 age group and 627 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate is in line with last month, now at 90.5%, and is 1.3 percentage points lower than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Sevenoaks to 4.8% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.3% and 2.9%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 2.2% in Dover to 3.5% in Sevenoaks.

Work has recently taken place to cross-reference the Not Knowns population with other sources of young people's information to increase the accuracy and volume of contact details in order to facilitate improved contact with that cohort.

30% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was 38%, so whilst there has been a slight rise in the NEET population, it has not been caused by, or led to, an increase in the long-term NEET population.

Work has recently taken place to review our processes and practice in order to ensure that they are as effective as possible. This will support both the accuracy and timeliness of data recording, and how it is used effectively to support and reduce the NEET population.


