Headline Commentary

The NEET population at 3.1% this month (1,011 young people) has decreased by 38 young people compared to last month. This compares to a figure of 3.0% at the same time last year. The Not Known figure has increased to 2.5% this month (818 young people) which is an increase of 110 young people. This compares favourably to 2.8% on the same month last year. The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 5.6%, which compares to last month's figure of 5.4%, which is an increase of 0.2% but is an improvement on the figure for the same month last year at 5.8%.

The NEET Interdependencies group has reconvened and is working to review and streamline processes to support a reduction in our figures, particularly the Not Known cohort, in order to ensure young people are offered the best support possible to move into a positive destination.

The NEET population of 1,011 young people comprises 401 in the year 12 age group and 610 in the year 13 age group. District performance for NEET varies from 1.5% in Sevenoaks to 5.5% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.0% and 3.0%.

The Participation rate has decreased slightly this month to 89.8%, and is 0.3 percentage points lower than the same point last year. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 1.7% in Gravesham to 3.6% in Thanet.

The collection of Intended Destinations for Year 11 pupils is complete.

The collection of September Guarantee data for Year 11 and Year 12 pupils is underway. Schools and colleges must submit details of those students they have offered places to for September. Services can then work with young people without a September Guarantee prior to September to ensure they have an appropriate positive destination to move into that will meet their needs and aspirations.

Yr12 & Yr13 NEET %

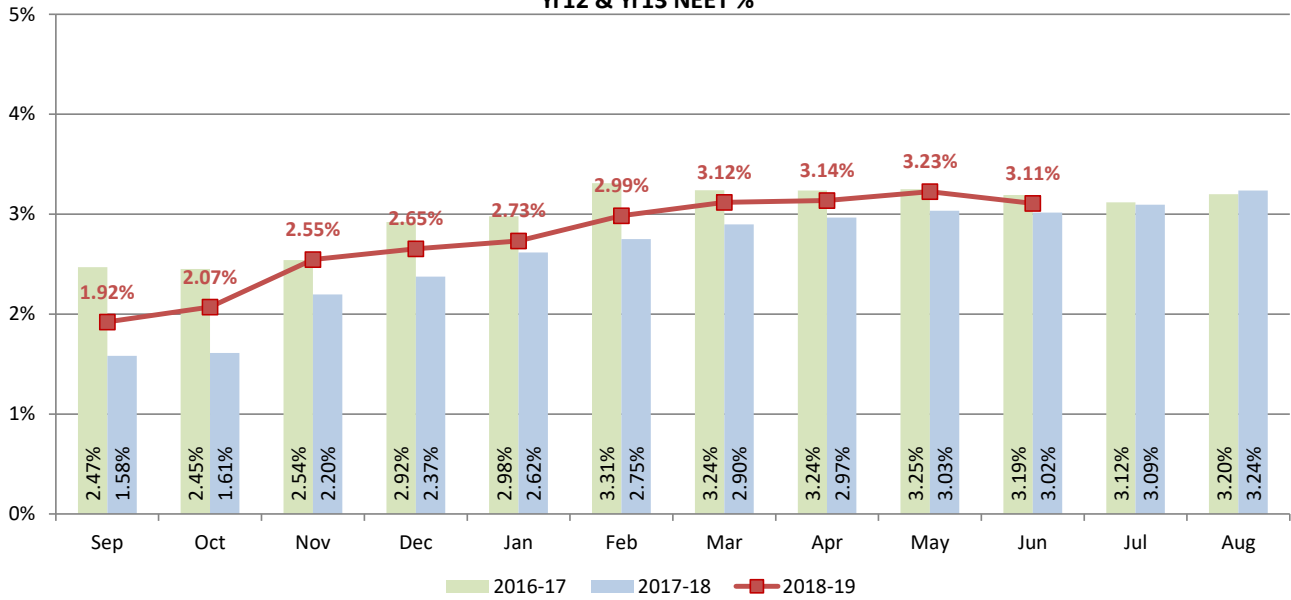

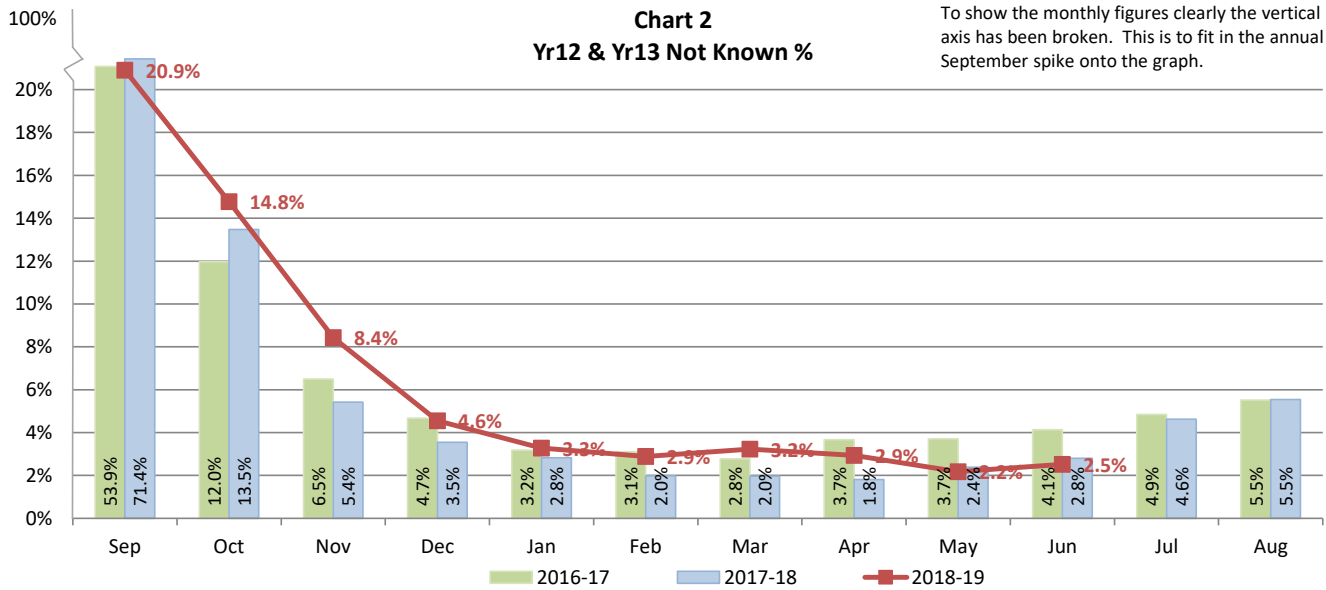
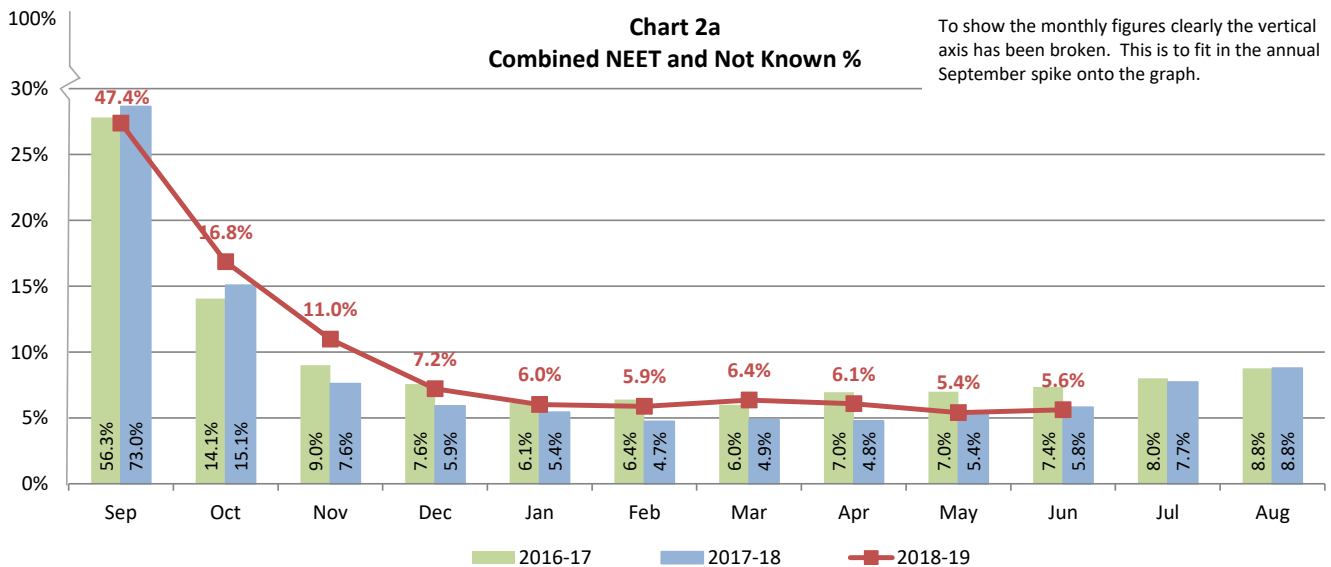

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs May 2019

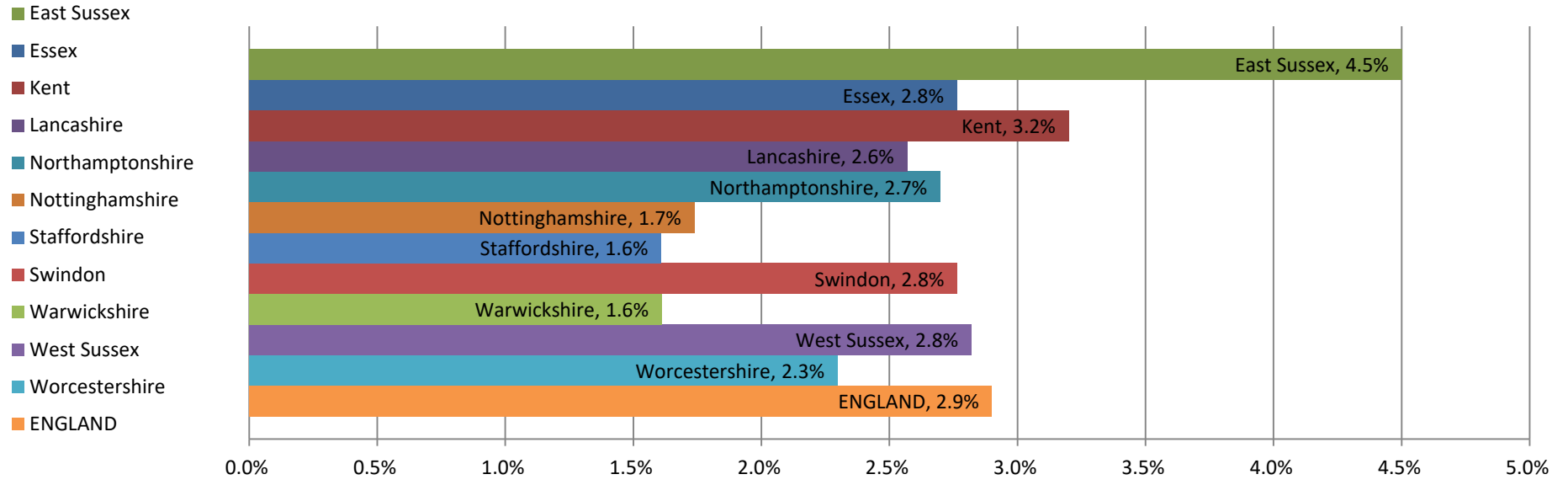
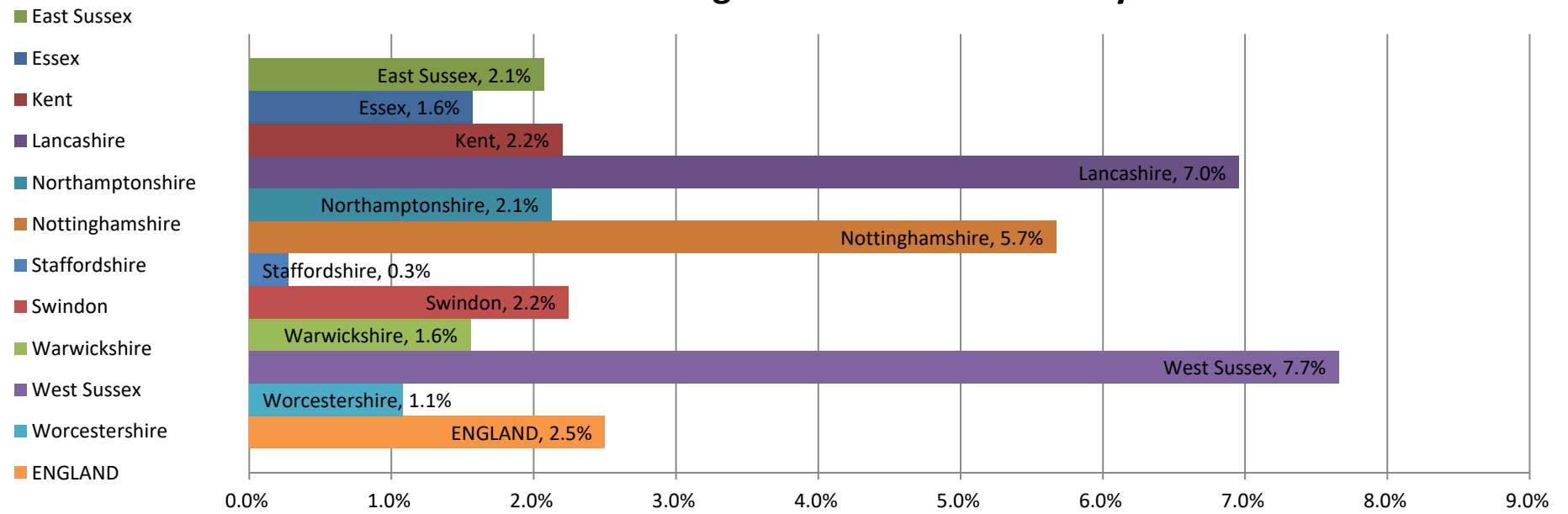


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns May 2019
