
The NEET population is currently at 3.4% compared to 2.9% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 1.7%, compared to 1.8% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 90.5%, compared to 91.8 the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.2% in Dartford and Tunbridge Wells to 5.3% in Thanet.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

Please note the Kent and district NEET Y12 & Y13 targets have been updated to the September 2022 figures.


County NEET and Not Known Breakdown




District NEET Trends

NEET Cohort by District






Current Month Target Comparison






Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown





