
The NEET population is currently at 3.7% compared to 3.5% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 1.4%, compared to 1.7% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 90.7%, compared to 90.3% the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.4% in Tunbridge Wells to 5.7% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 1.0% in Thanet & Tonbridge & Malling to 2.1% in Sevenoaks.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

Please note the Kent and district NEET Y12 & Y13 targets have been updated to the September 2022 figures.


#### **SEND NEET and Not Known Breakdown**






#### **Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown**





