Academic age is the age of the young person on 31st August (i.e.: prior to the start of the academic year). The figures include Y12 & Y13 (academic age 16 & 17) with a Kent County Council area postcode as their primary address.

The 2016 NEET and NK figures do not have weighting from September

Headline Commentary

Progress has been made in March for both NEET and Not Known populations. The NEETs have decreased by 0.1% down to 3.2% (1,094 young people), and the Not Knowns have decreased by 0.3% down to 2.8%.

The NEET population of 1,094 young people comprises 388 in the year 12 age group and 706 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate remains the same as last month, and at 90.5% is 2.5 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.68% in Sevenoaks to 5.0% in Thanet, though most districts are between 2.5% and 3.5%. Ashford, Canterbury, Gravesham, Tonbridge and Malling, and Tunbridge Wells all reduced their proportions of NEET young people in March from the previous month. NEET proportions rose in Dartford, Dover and Thanet, whilst they remained the same in Maidstone, Sevenoaks, Shepway and Swale.

District performance for Not Knowns is less varied, and ranges from 2.27% in Canterbury to 3.35% in Dover. All districts, with the exception of Maidstone, reduced their Not Known percentages in March, which is very encouraging progress, especially as the overall Kent NEET percentage also reduced.

62% of NEET young people have been NEET for 27 weeks or more. In the same month last year this figure was 71%, so there has been some progress in tackling the long-term NEET population.

Chart 6 Statistical Neighbours NEETs Febraury 2017

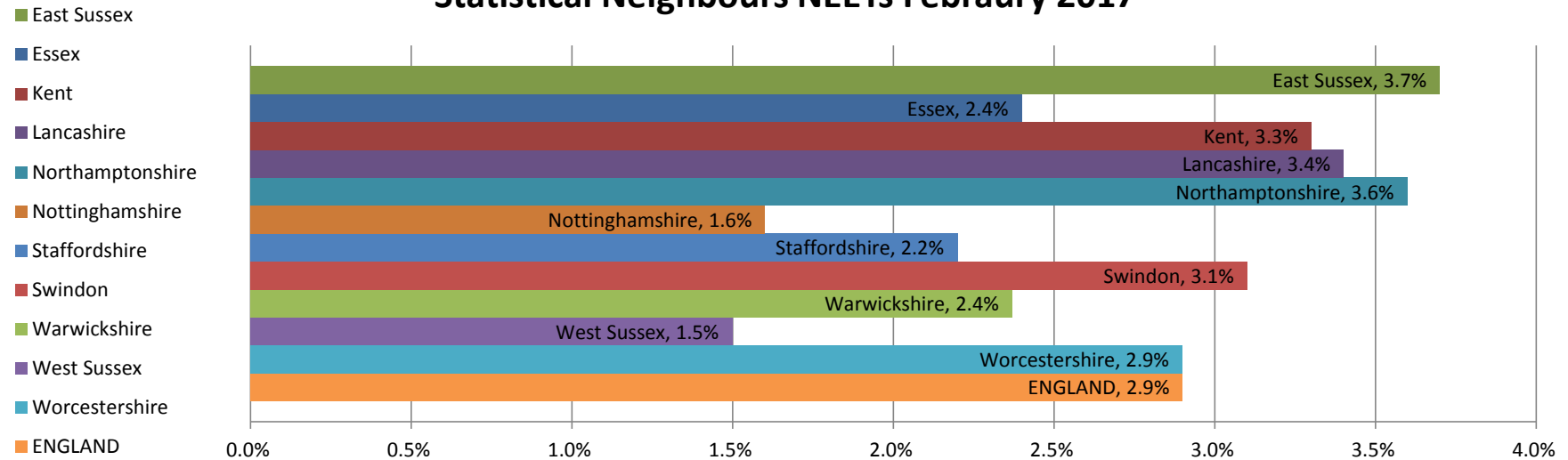
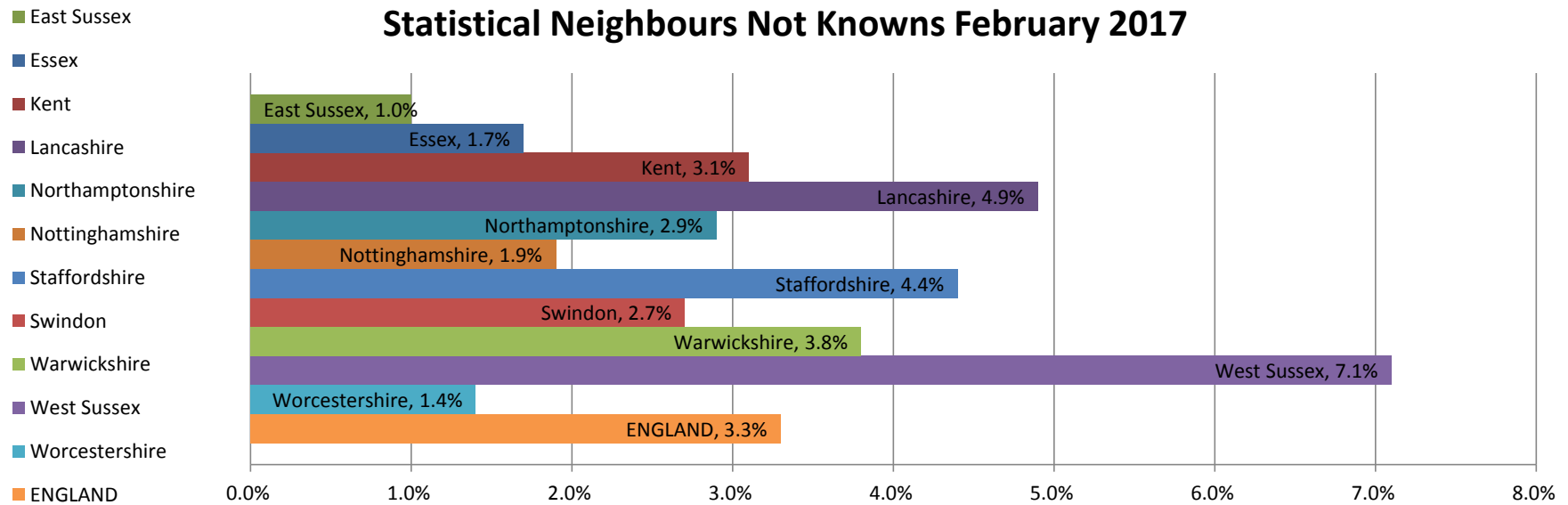


Chart 7 Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns February 2017
