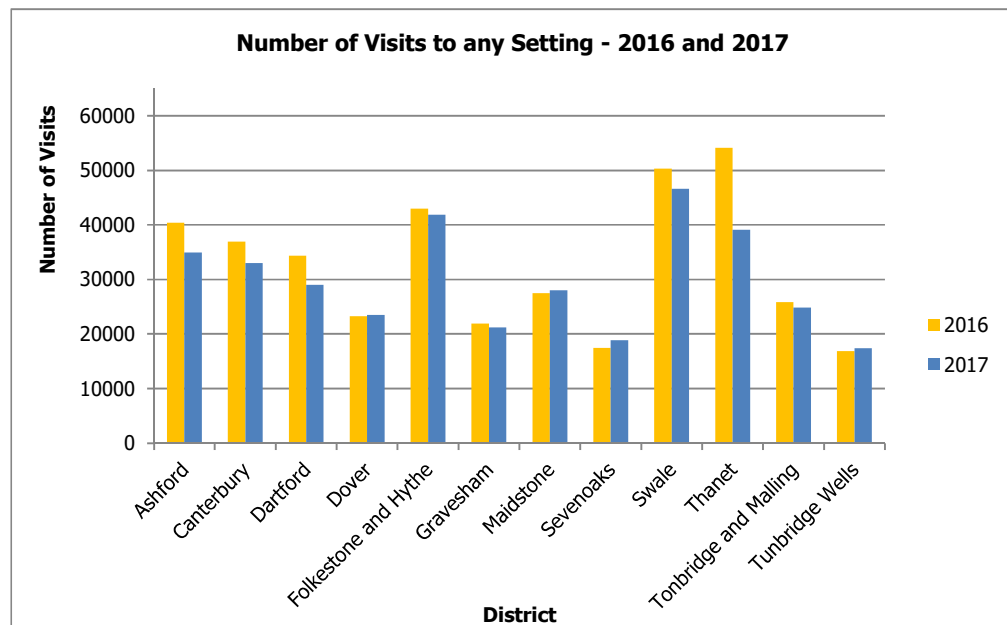

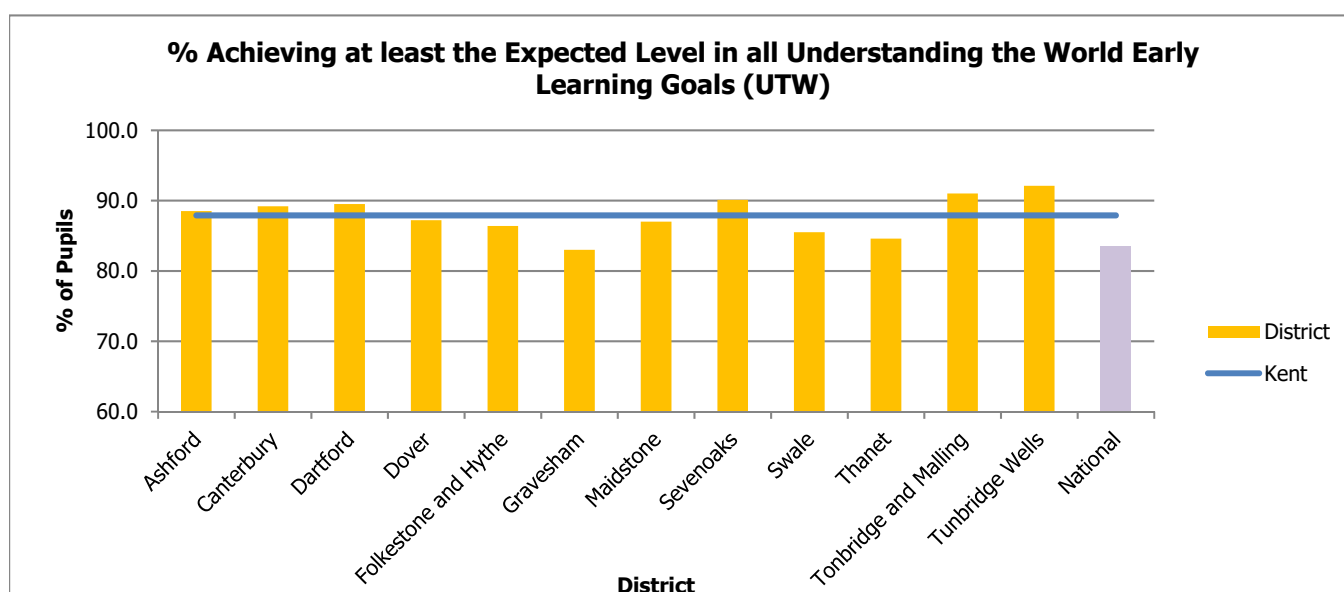
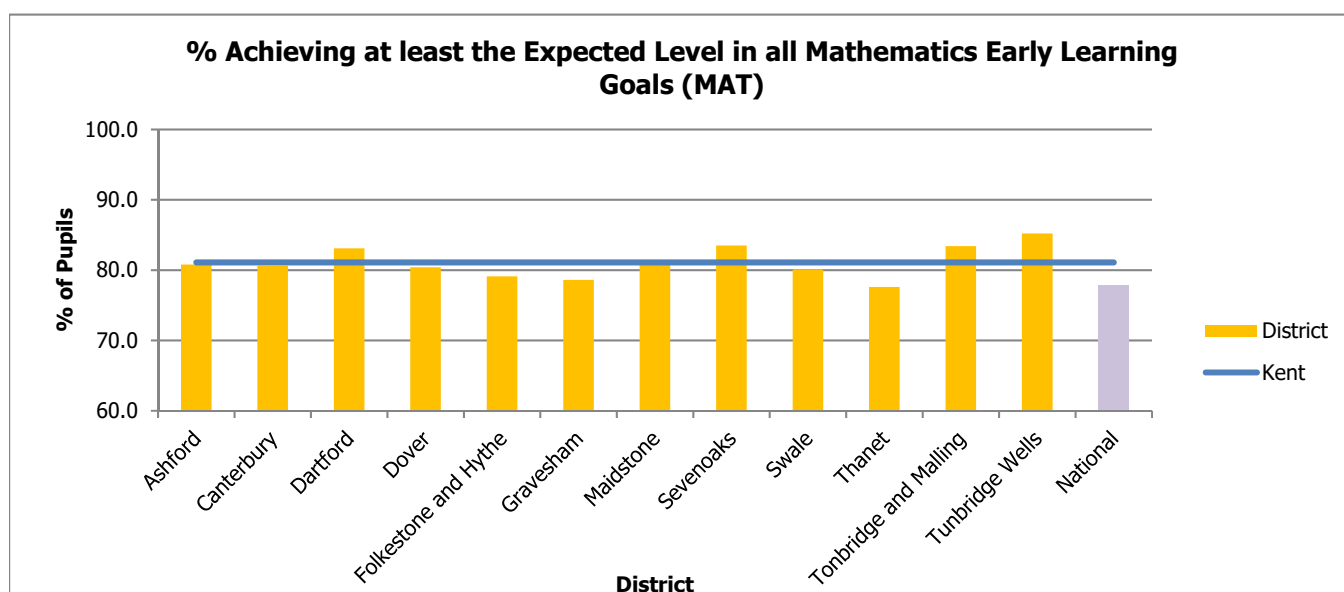
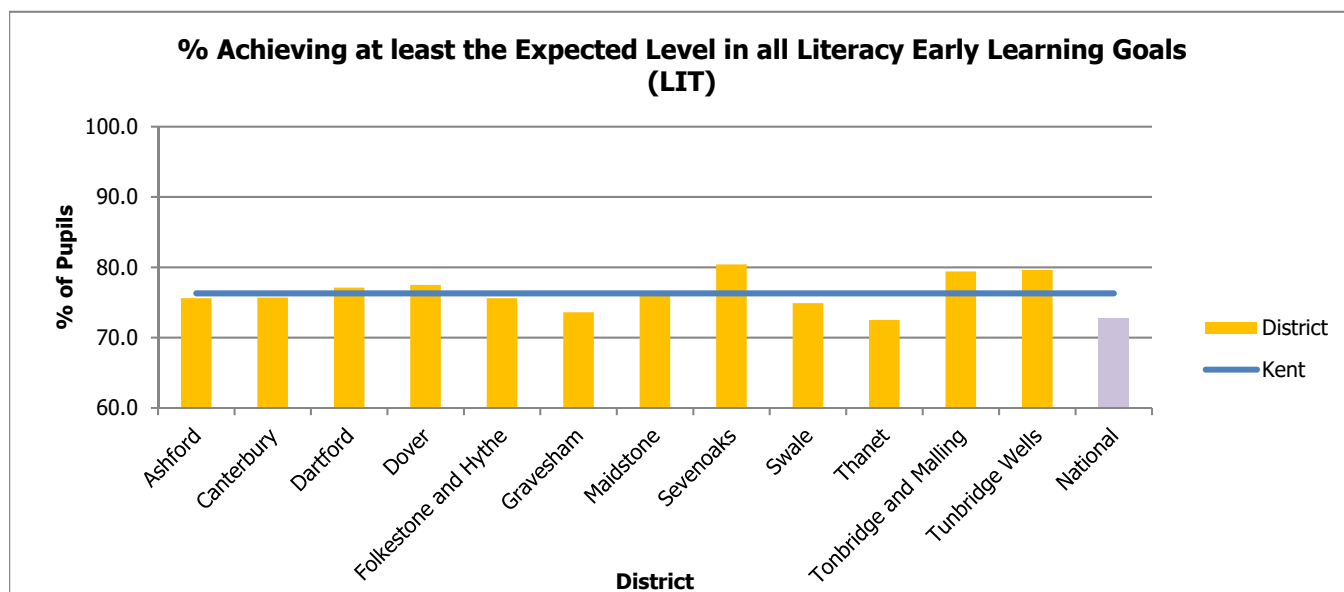
Early Years Foundation Stage Profile Attainment by District 2017

Early Years Foundation Stage Profile - Attainment Gap Trends 2015 to 2017

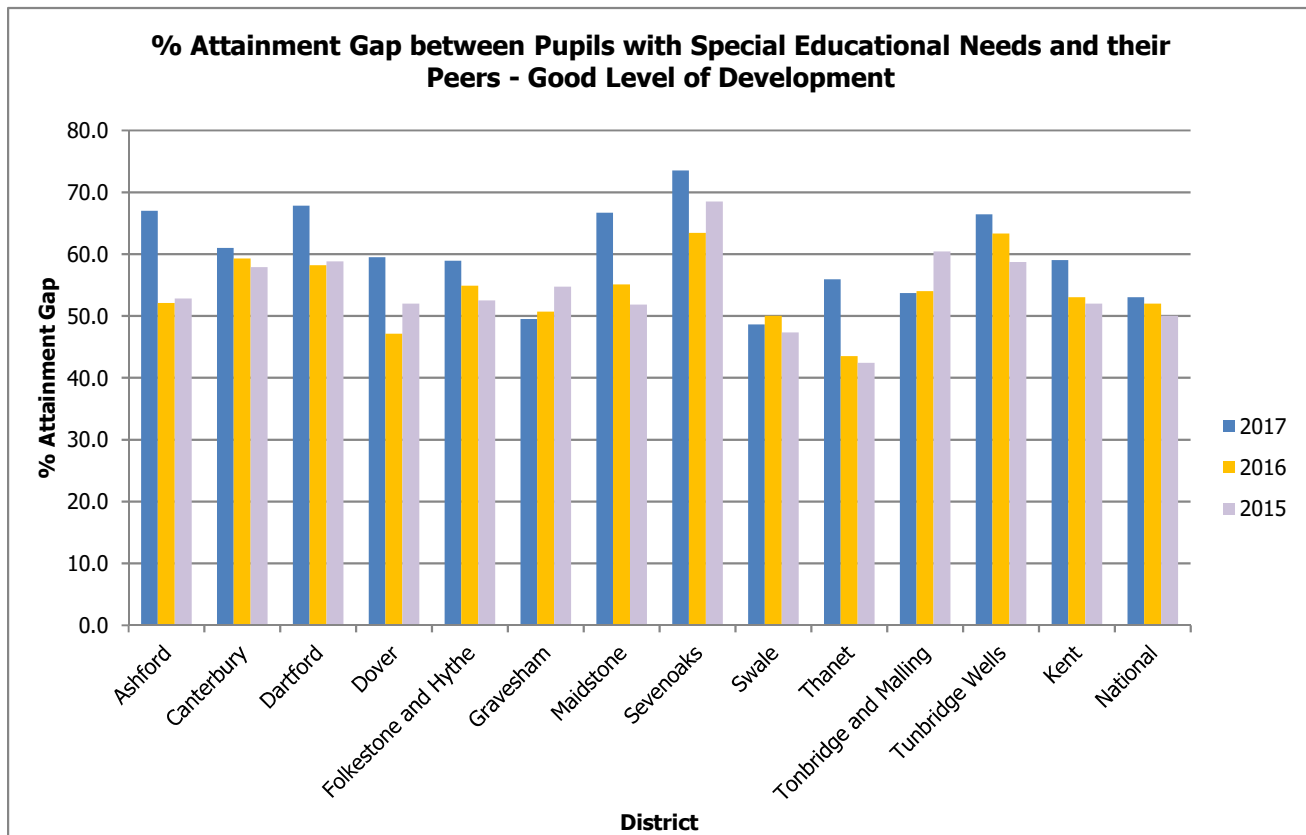

Key Stage One Attainment by District - 2017



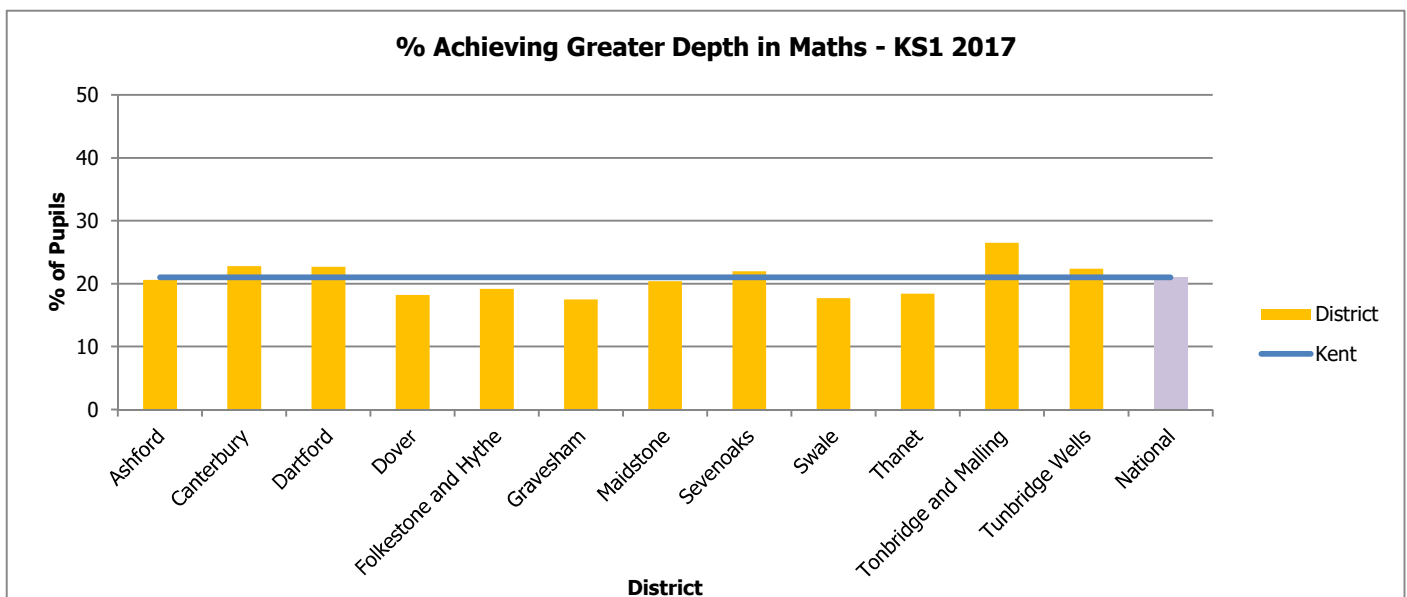
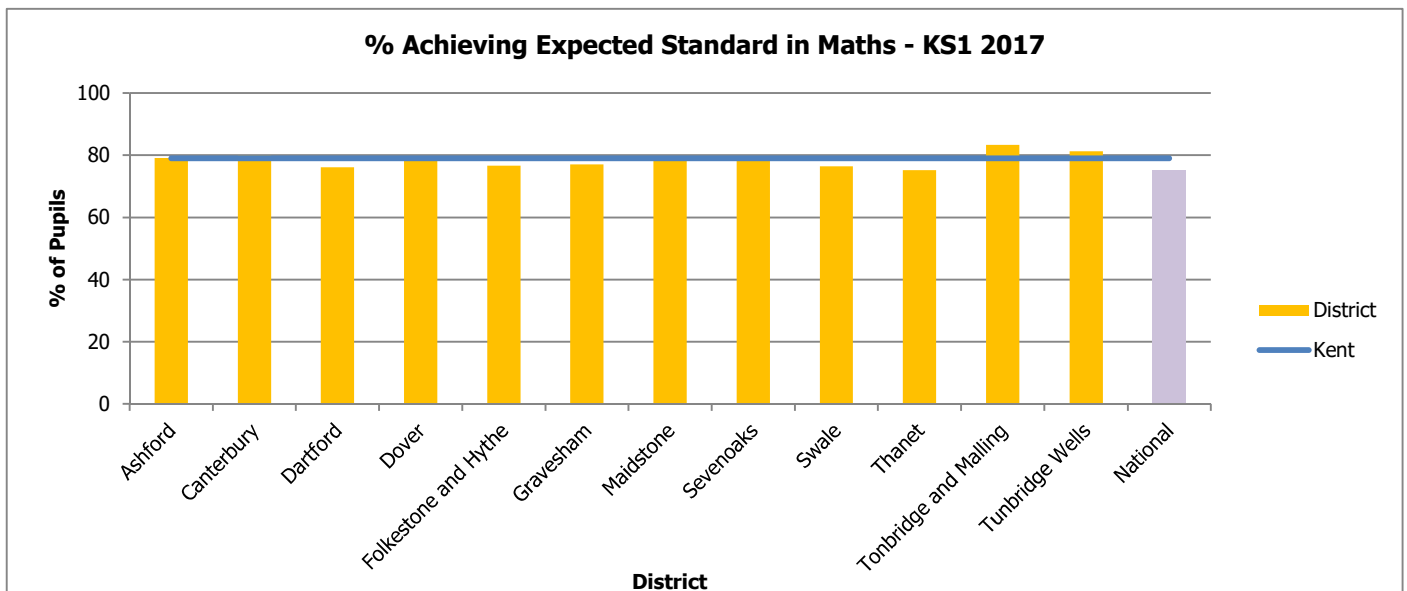
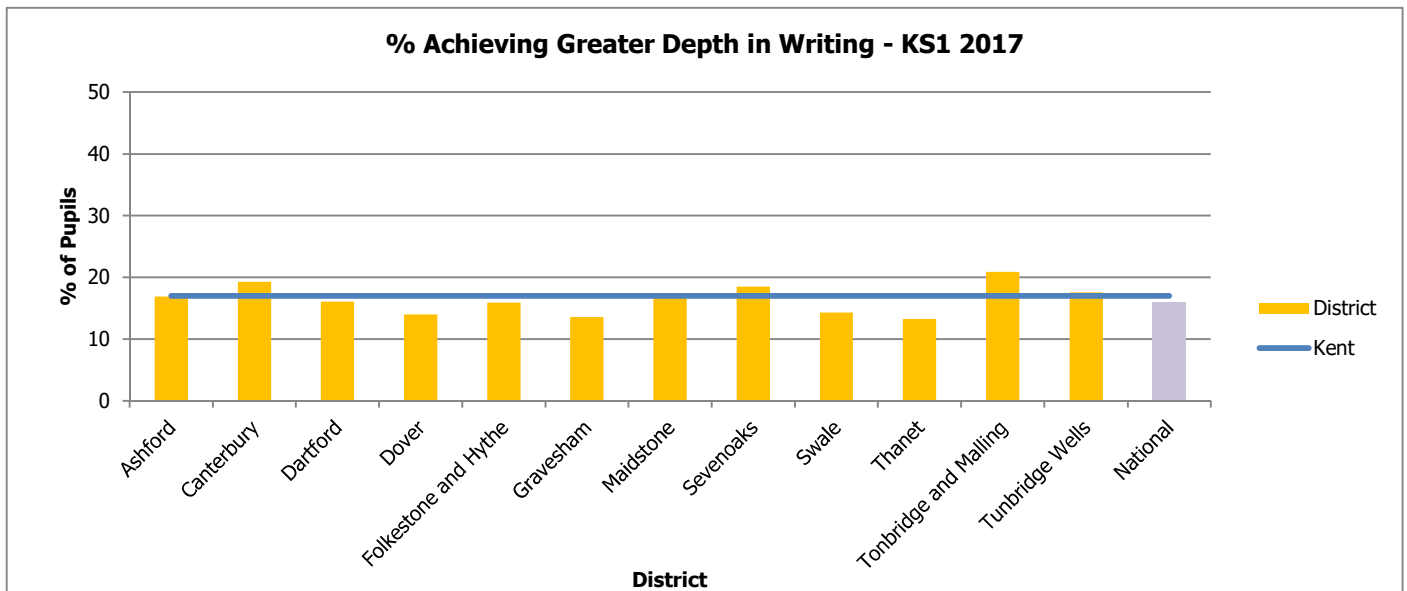

Key Stage One Trend by Area and District - 2015 to 2017



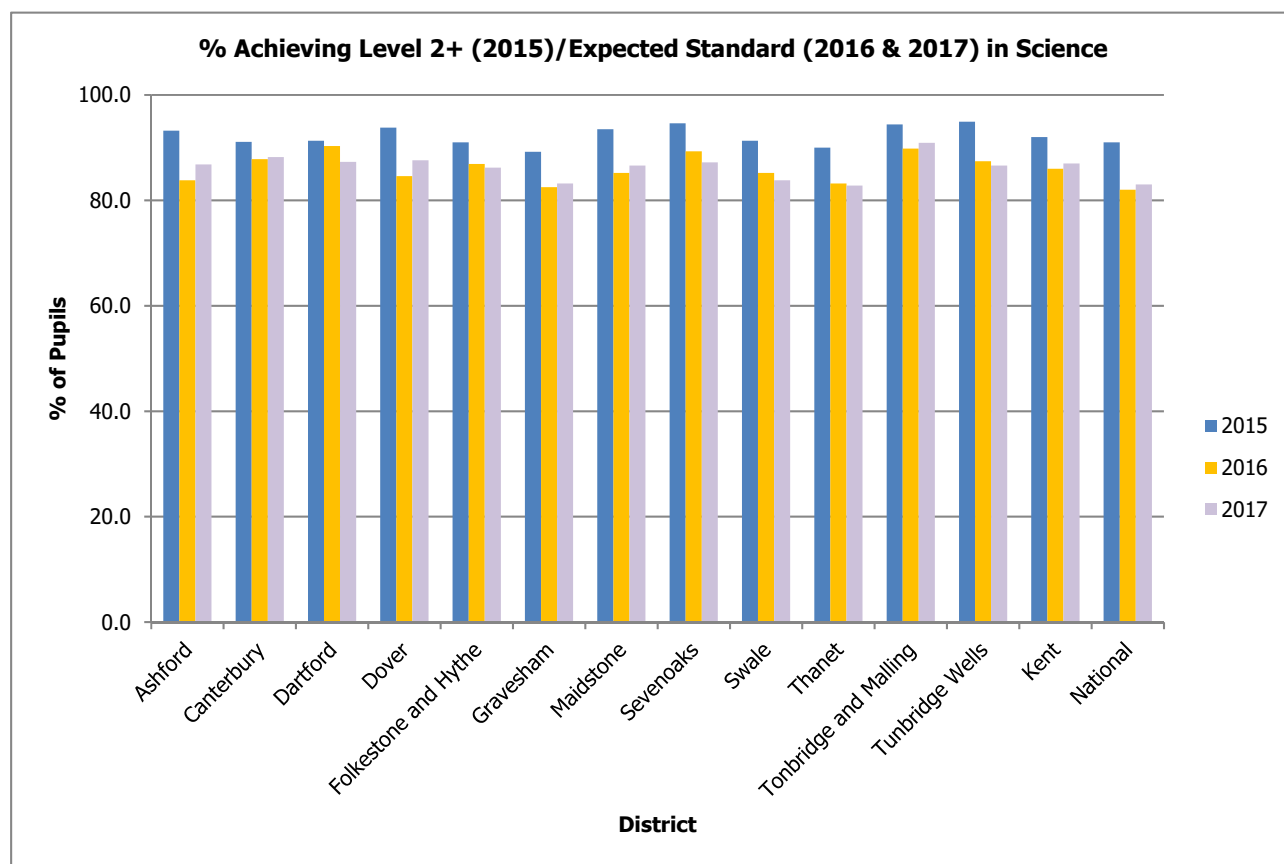
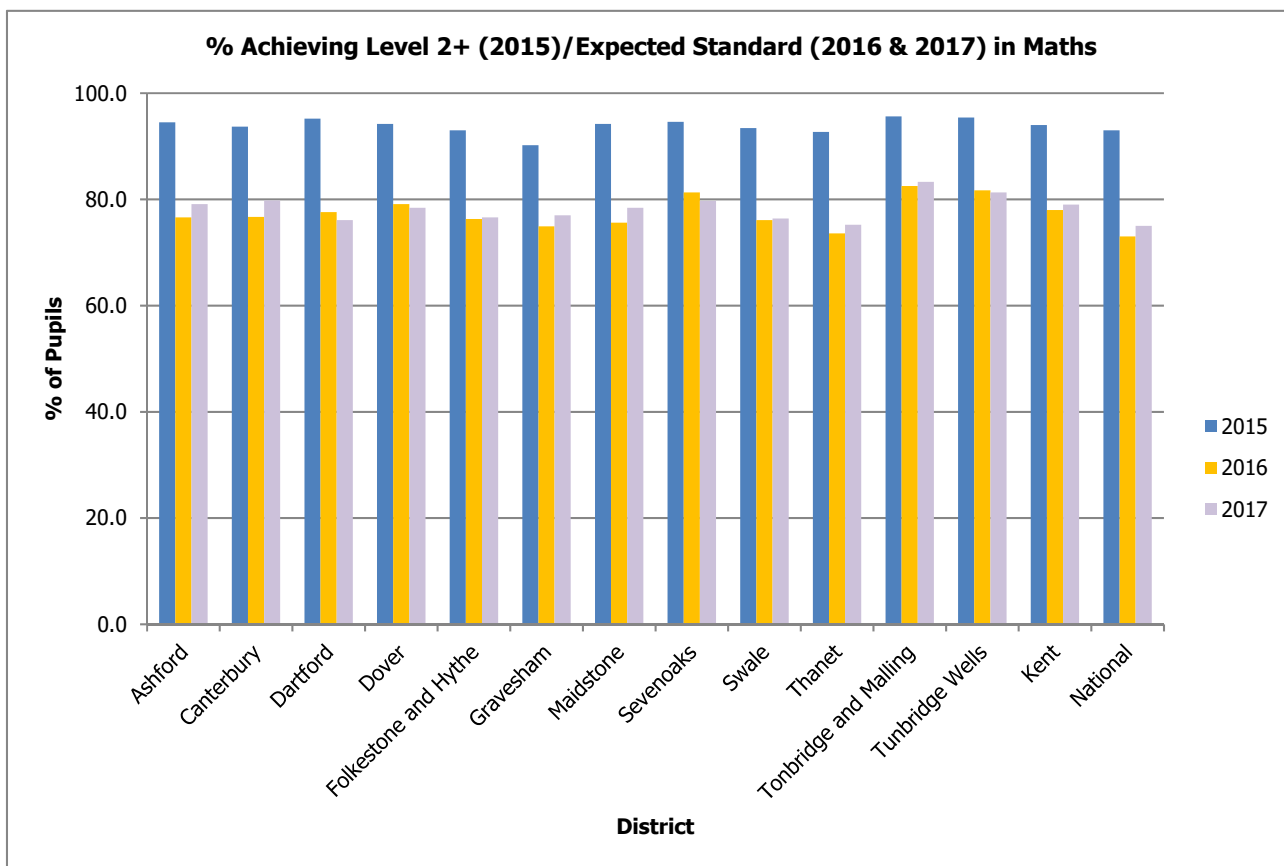

Key Stage Two Attainment by Area and District 2017



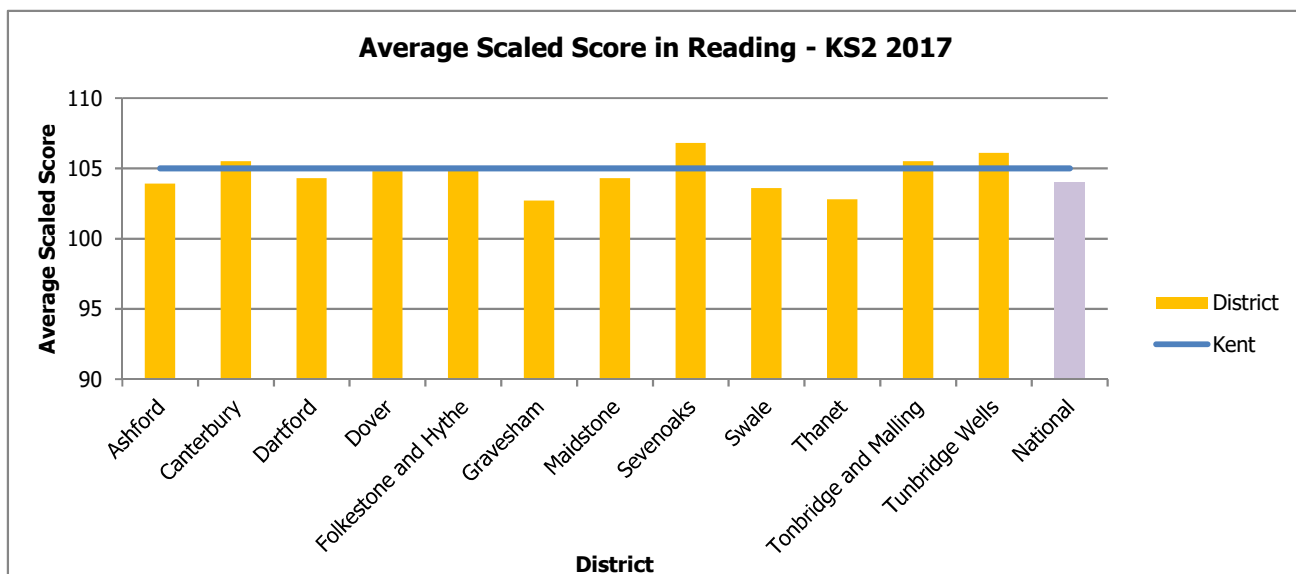
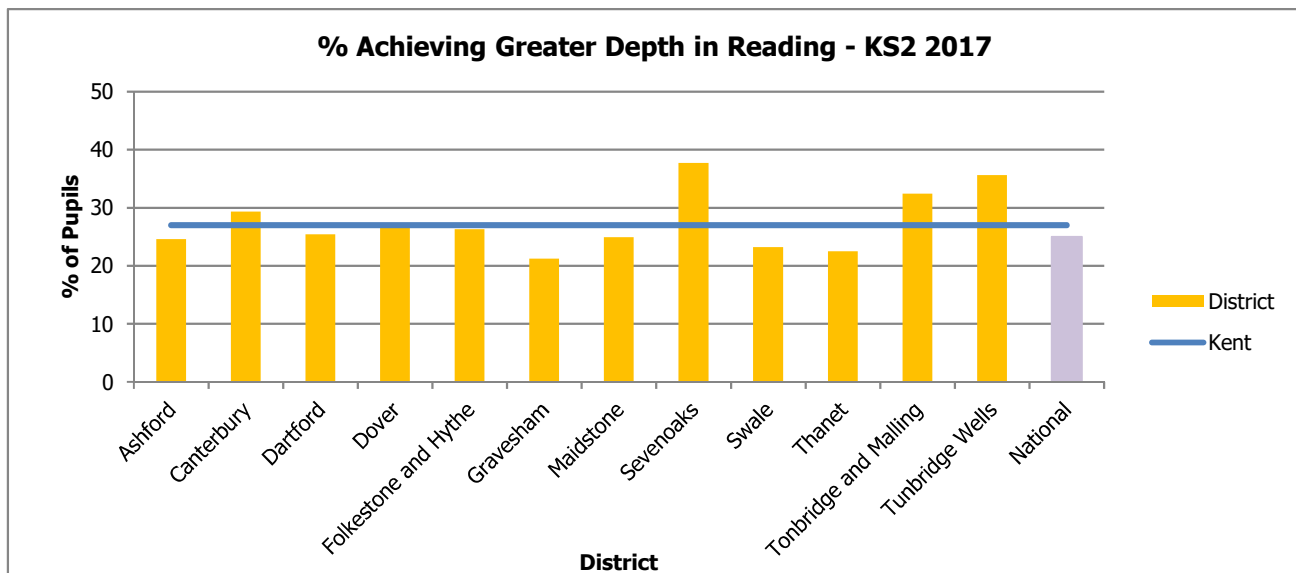
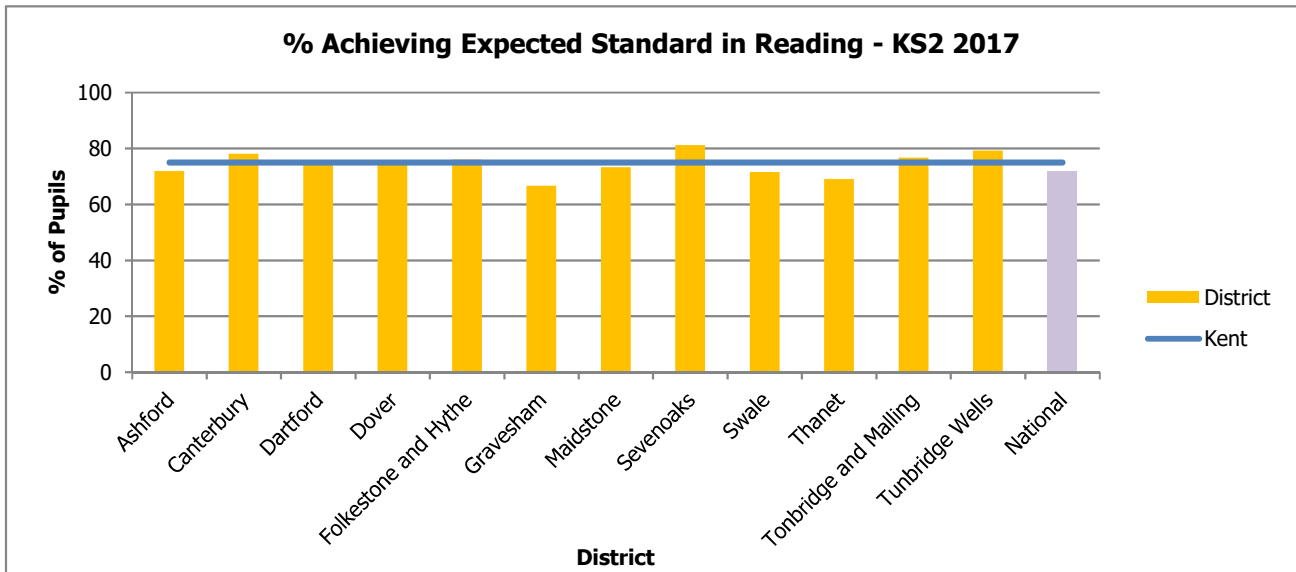

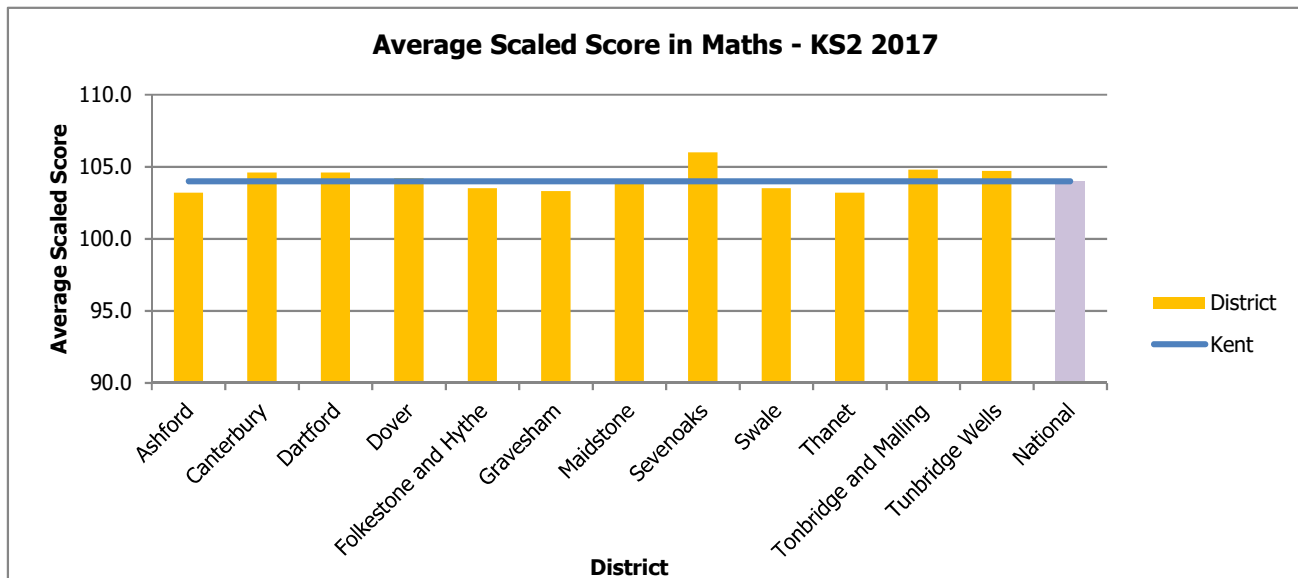
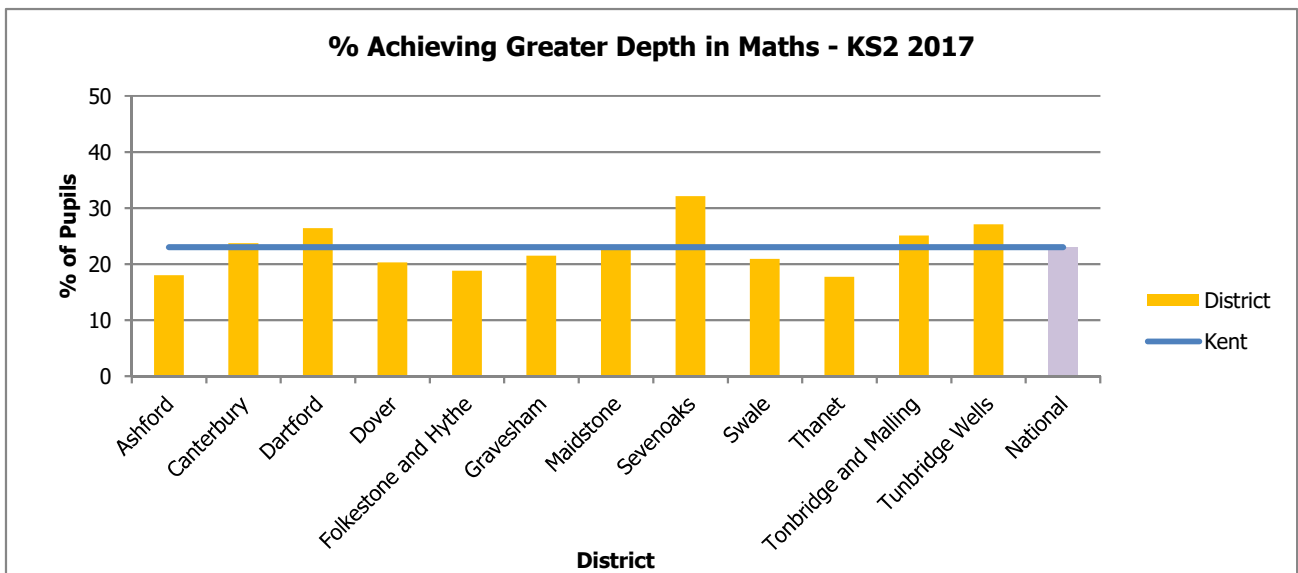
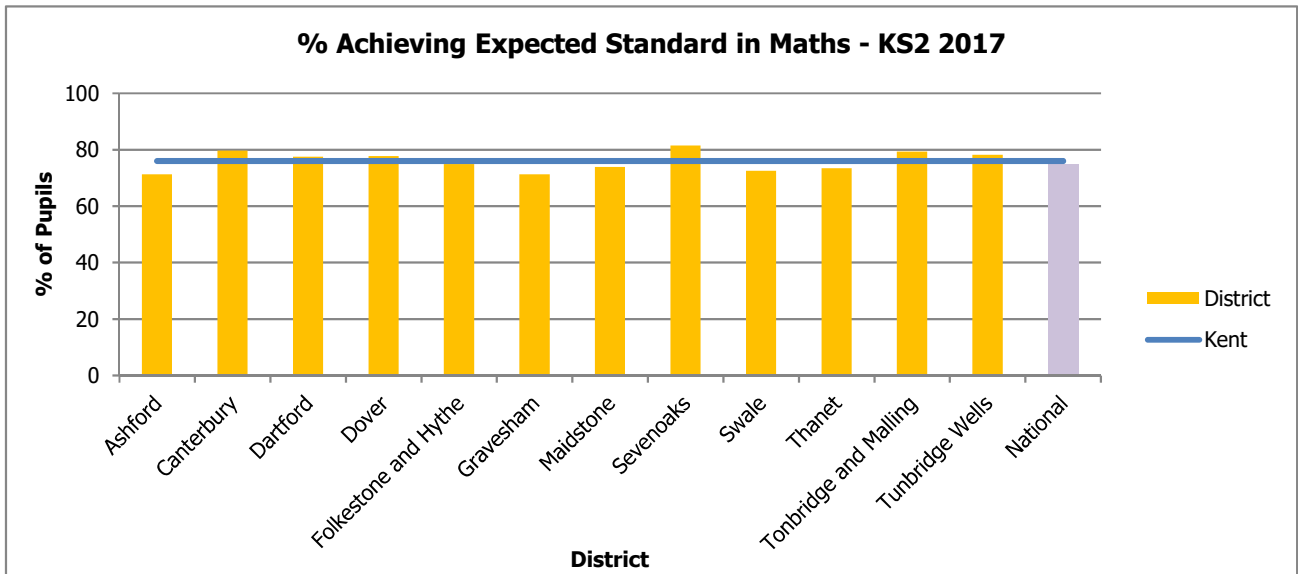
Key Stage Two Attainment by Area and District 2017

Key Stage Two Trend by Area and District - 2015 to 2017



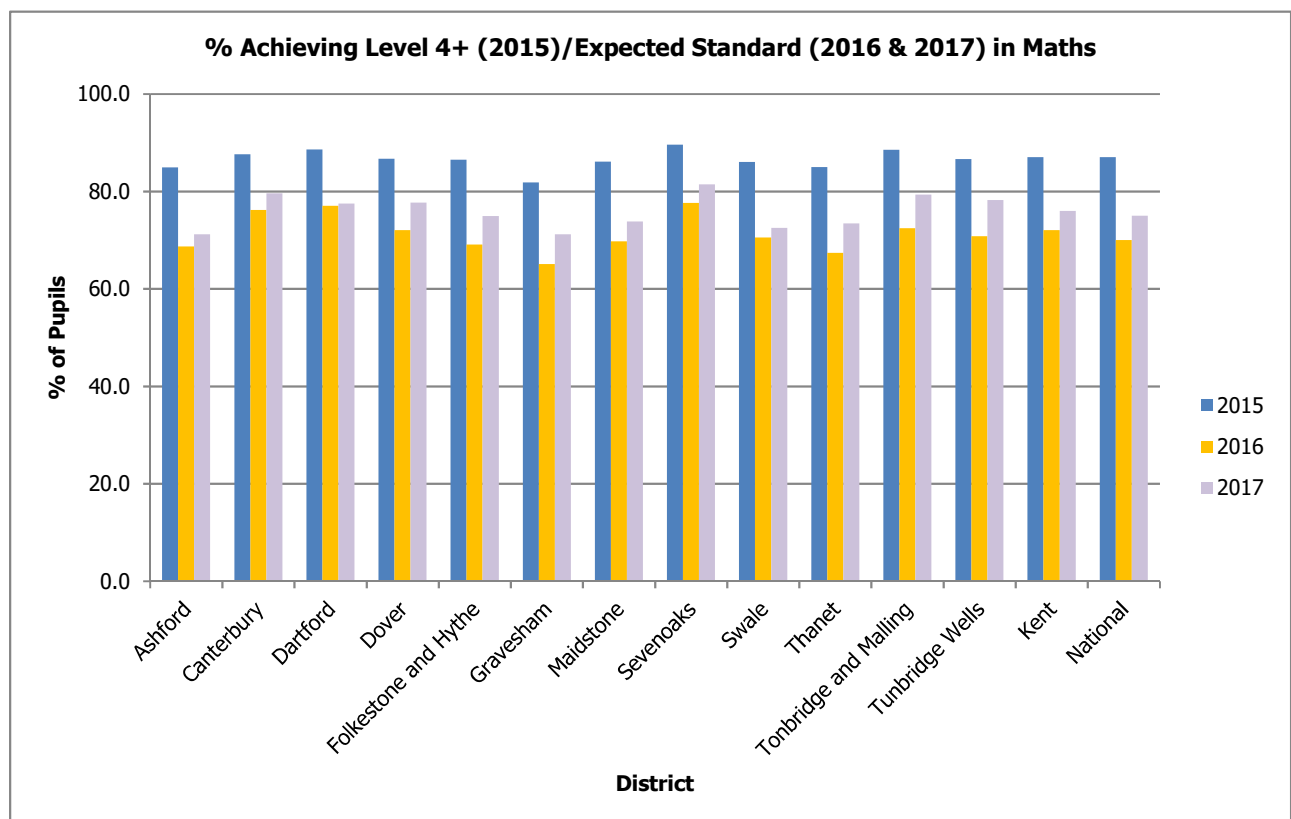
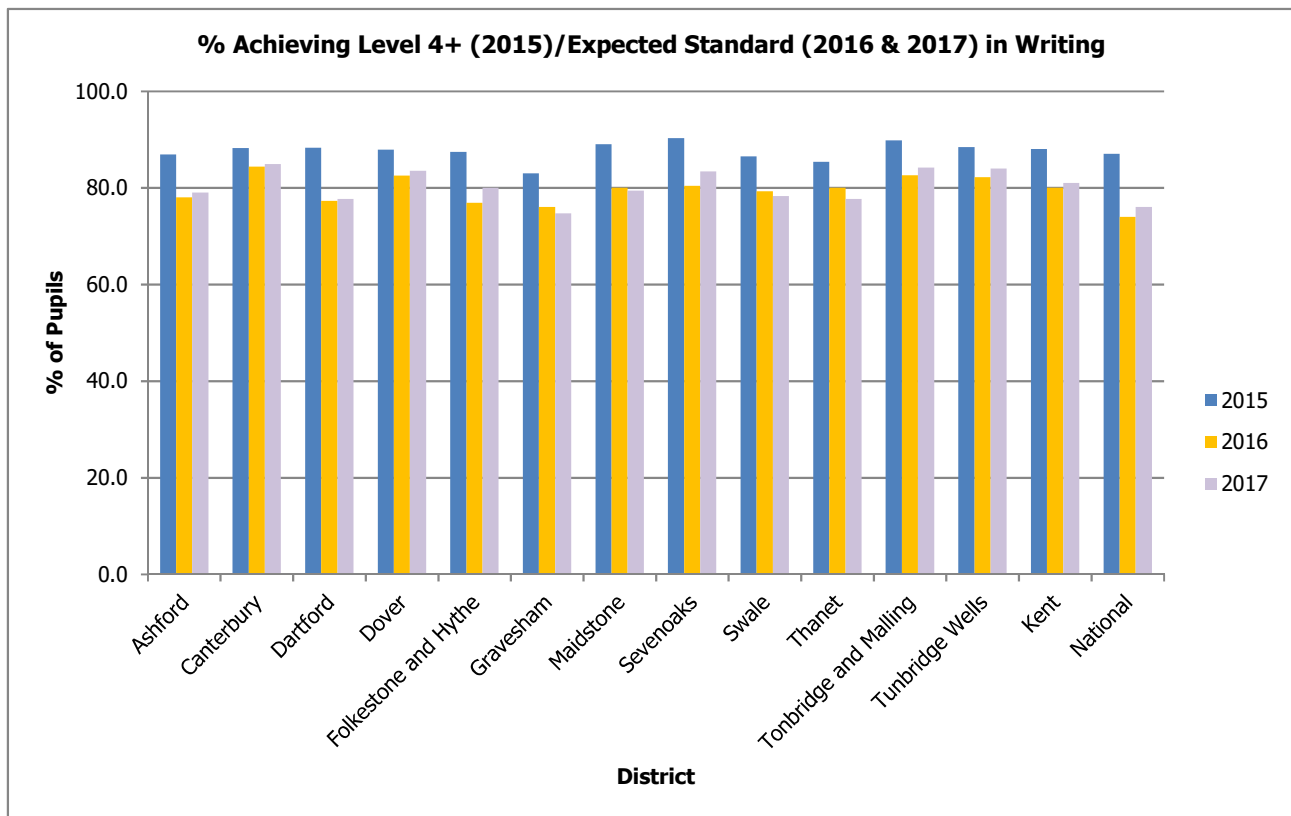

Key Stage Two Trend by Area and District - 2015 to 2017



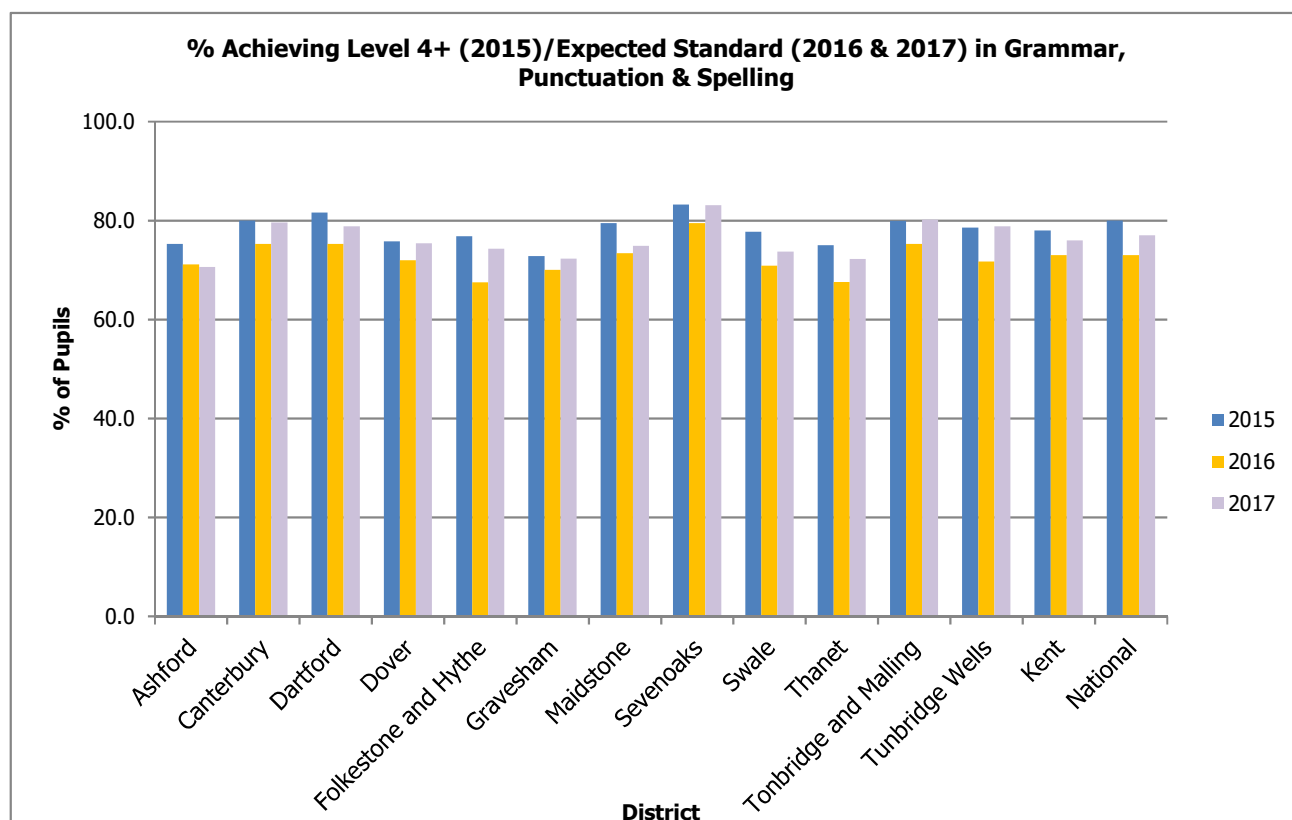

Key Stage Four Attainment by Area and District 2017



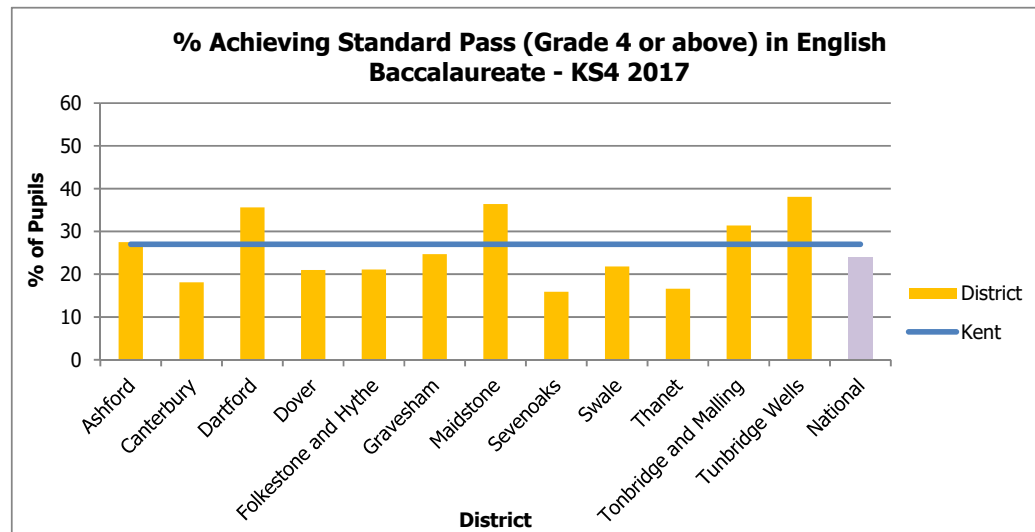
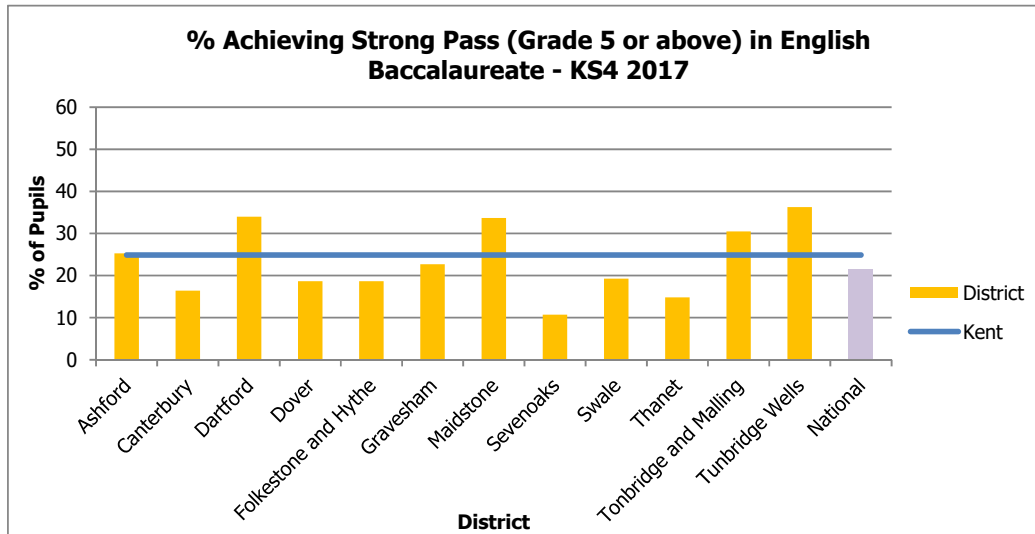

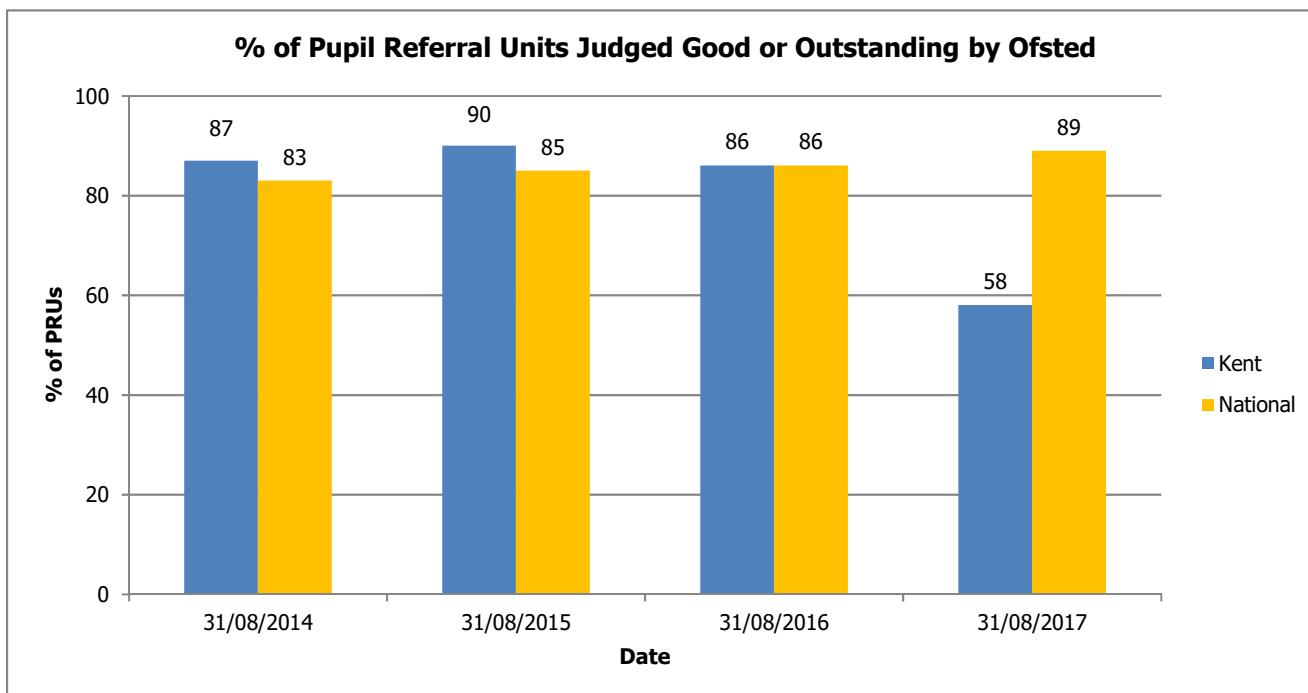
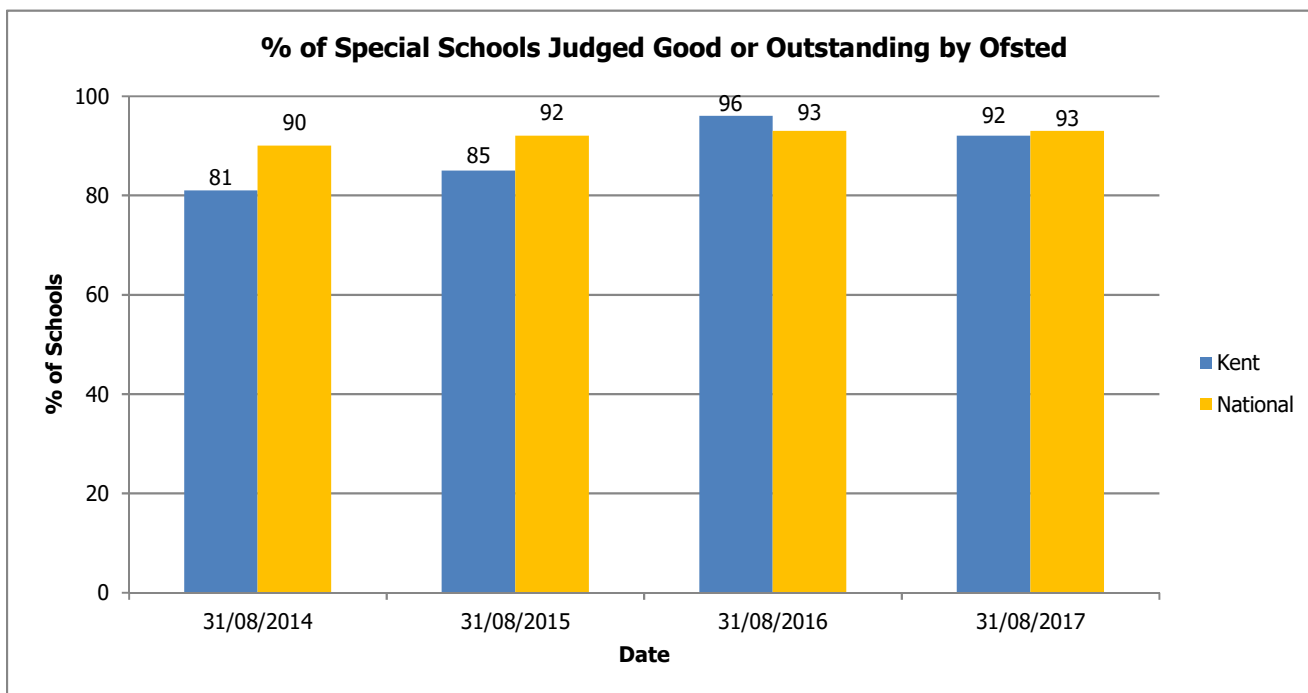
