# **Headline Commentary**

Figures for April continue to show a stable position, and are in line with the positive figures seen last month.

The NEET population has increased slightly this month to 3.0% (981 young people), up from 2.9% last month. This compares to a figure of 3.2% at the same time last year. The Not Known figure has reduced to 1.8% this month (598 young people). This is the lowest ever-recorded level of Not Knowns in Kent. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 3.7%.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is at 4.8%, down slightly from 4.9% last month. This is the lowest ever-recorded combined figure in Kent. The figure for the same month last year was 7.0%.

Our NEET figure is the 0.1 percentage points higher than national, and our Not Known figure is 0.8 percentage points below national, meaning that our combined NEET and Not Known figure is also below national, which reflects the significant progress that as been made over the last year.

The NEET population of 981 young people comprises 360 in the year 12 age group and 621 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has decreased slightly from last month, down from 91.6% to 91.4%, and is 1.9 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.6% in Sevenoaks to 4.8% In Thanet, though most districts are between 2.0% and 3.0%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 0.5% in Tunbridge Wells to 2.7% in Gravesham.

Work has been taking place this month to ensure that our recording is as accurate as possible in line with statutory requirements for children in care. This has resulted in a slight shift in figures and provides a stable baseline from which to move forwards.

The collection of Intended Destinations for Year 11 pupils is almost complete. All schools have submitted returns, and Intended Destinations are currently known for 87.5% of young people. The remainder is either where young people are undecided, or where there are matching and data quality issues. These are currently being followed up.
