
The NEET population is currently at 2.5% compared to 2.6% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 4.8%, compared to 7.5% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 90.1%, compared to 87.9% the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.0% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 3.4% in Ashford to 7.0% in Swale.

The September Guarantee collection period has finished. The figure for September Guarantees Total Offers Made for Years 11 and 12 was 94.7% which is an improvement from the same time last year 93.2%.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16 and 17 year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to iden fy those at at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.




Current Month Target Comparison








Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown





