### **Headline Commentary**

Figures for December are continuing to stabilise, following the system being updated in the Autumn term with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges.

There has been substantial work to reduce the percentage of not knowns as these young people who haven't appeared on enrolment lists are followed up over the last few months. The Not Known percentage drop from last month clearly reflects this.

The NEET population is currently at 3.0% compared 2.7% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 5.1%, down from 7.3% last month. This is slightly higher than this time last year at 4.6% in December 2018. The Participation rate has improved again to 88.5%, up from 87.2% last month, this is down 1.3 percentage points compared with the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.2% In Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 3.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 6.2% in Dover.

The Department for Education (DfE) publishes an estimate each year of the proportion of young people not in education, employment or training (NEET). The performance of all Local Authorities is averaged in December, January and February. For these months, Management Information are able to include Postive Destinations created after the end of the month.
