

# North Kent - Results Hub



## WHAT IS IT?

The Results Hub ran for two days post GCSE results to support Year 11 students, who once receiving their results, needed guidance on their post-16 pathways as their results were not what they expected for the post-16 place they had applied for.

## HOW DID IT WORK?

The Hub was able to use the Pathways for All network to connect students to the appropriate adults at potential provisions to help students secure places. There were volunteers from a range of education providers available to talk to young people who had not achieved the grades they needed, help them explore their options, and make choices about what to do next.

## WHAT WAS THE IMPACT?

57 students from 15 different schools attended and each were provided with a possible pathway and a connection made to that provider. Students who were seen were largely vulnerable, low attaining learners who were Special Educational Needs and/or Disability (SEND), English as an Additional Language (EAL) and many with Social, Emotional, and Mental Health (SEMH) needs, but there were also more able students who had failed to achieve their places at their Grammar school who needed help finding placements.

## NEXT STEPS

The two-day Results Hub is being repeated in August 2026 due to its success.
