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# Headline Commentary

## **\*PLEASE READ BEFORE USING THE FIGURES IN THIS REPORT\***

Figures for September are the most unstable of the year, as it is during September that the system is updated with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges, and given the size of Kent, this takes several weeks to complete.

The NEET population is currently 1.6%, and the Not Knowns are at 71.4%. As more enrolment data goes into the system the NEET figure is likely to rise, whilst the Not Knowns will decrease significantly.

Overall, there are 6% of Year 11 and Year 12 pupils without a September Guarantee. This is an improvement on last year's figures of one percentage point.

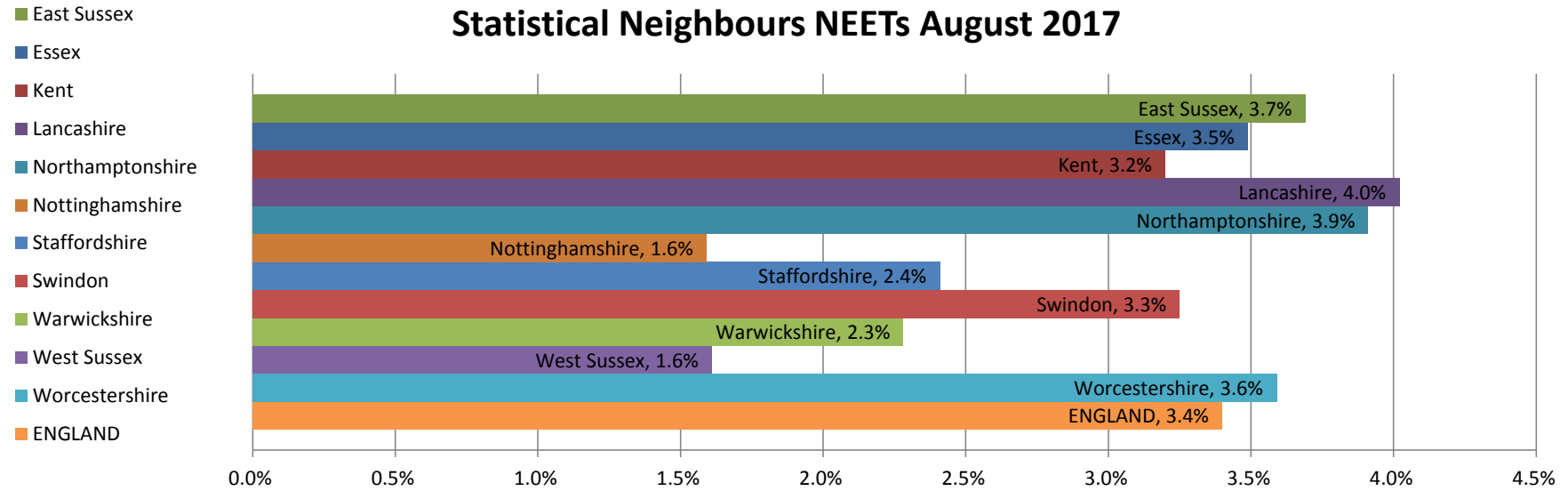

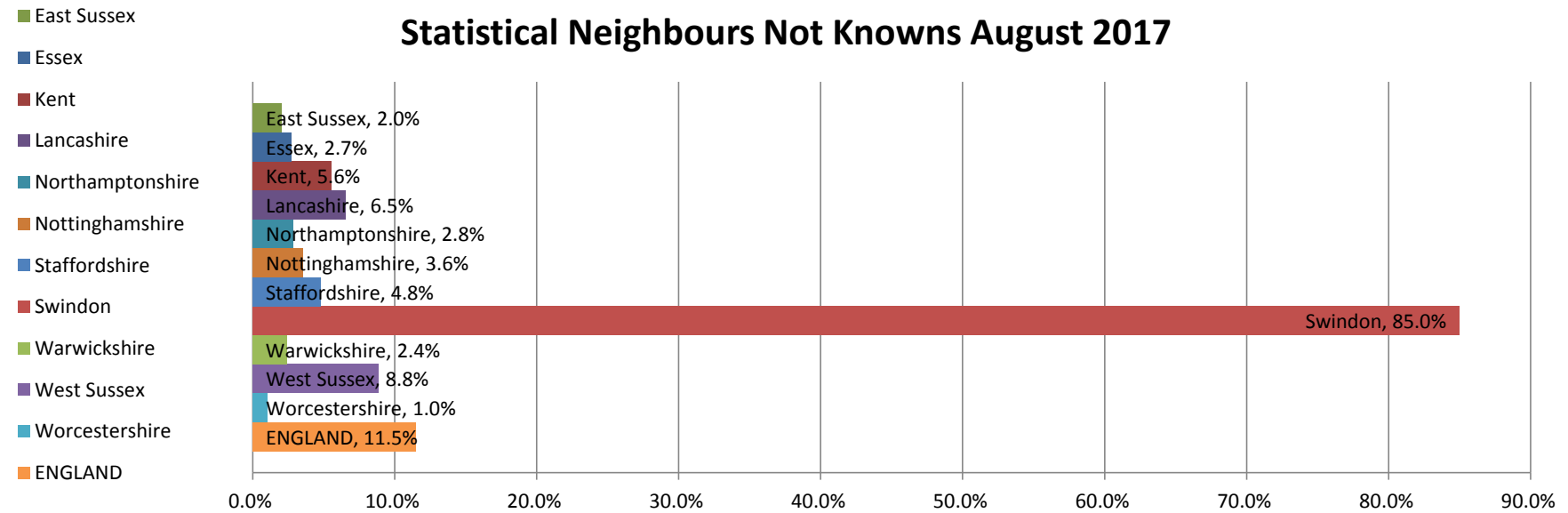
