# Headline Commentary

Figures for January continue to show a stable position, and tend to reflect, with December and February, the most reliable reporting period in the academic year.

The NEET population has increased slightly this month to 2.6% (865 young people), up from 2.4% last month. This compares to a figure of 3.0% at the same time last year. This slight increase to 2.6% is small given the Not Known population fell to 2.8% this month (964 young people), down from 3.5%, showing only a small proportion of these Not Knowns were found to be NEET. The Not Known figure in the same month last year was 3.2%.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is at 5.4%, down from 5.9% last month. The figure for the same month last year was 6.2%

The NEET population of 865 young people comprises 299 in the year 12 age group and 566 in the year 13 age group.

The Participation rate has increased again from last month, up to 91.6%, and is 0.7 percentage points higher than the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.4% in Sevenoaks to 4.3% in Thanet, though most districts are between 1.8% and 3.0%. District performance for Not Knowns ranges from 1.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 3.4% in Thanet. All districts saw a decrease in their Not Known percentages in January.

The collection of Intended Destinations for Year 11 pupils has begun, with Intended Destinations currently known for 48.3% of young people. As more schools submit their returns this will rise significantly.

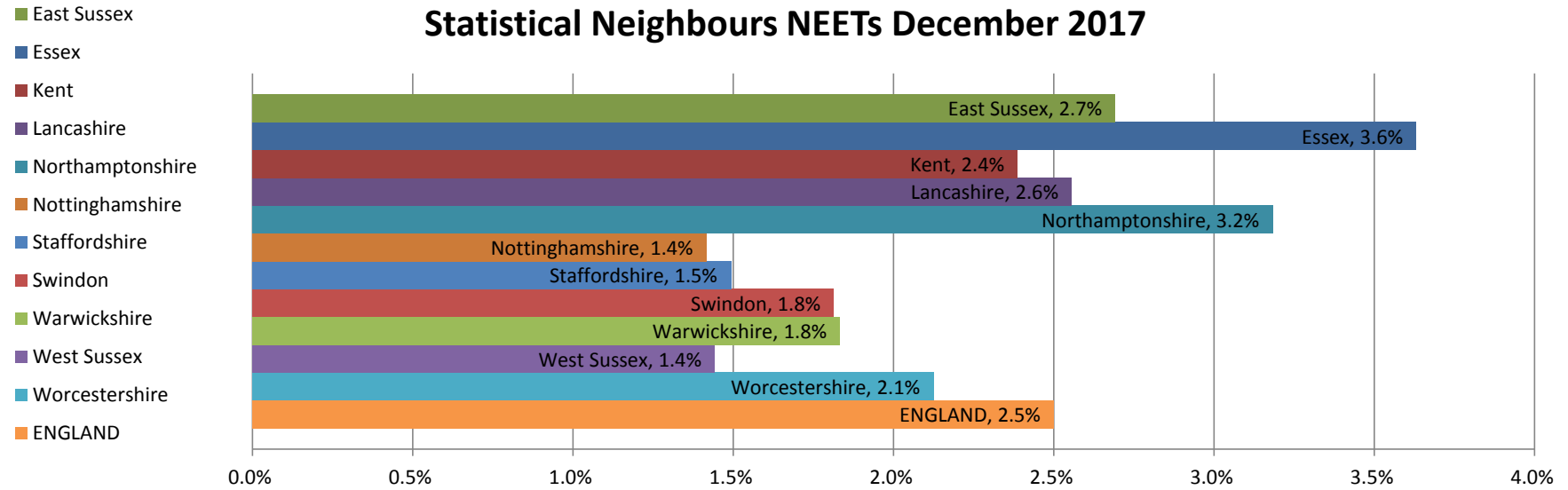

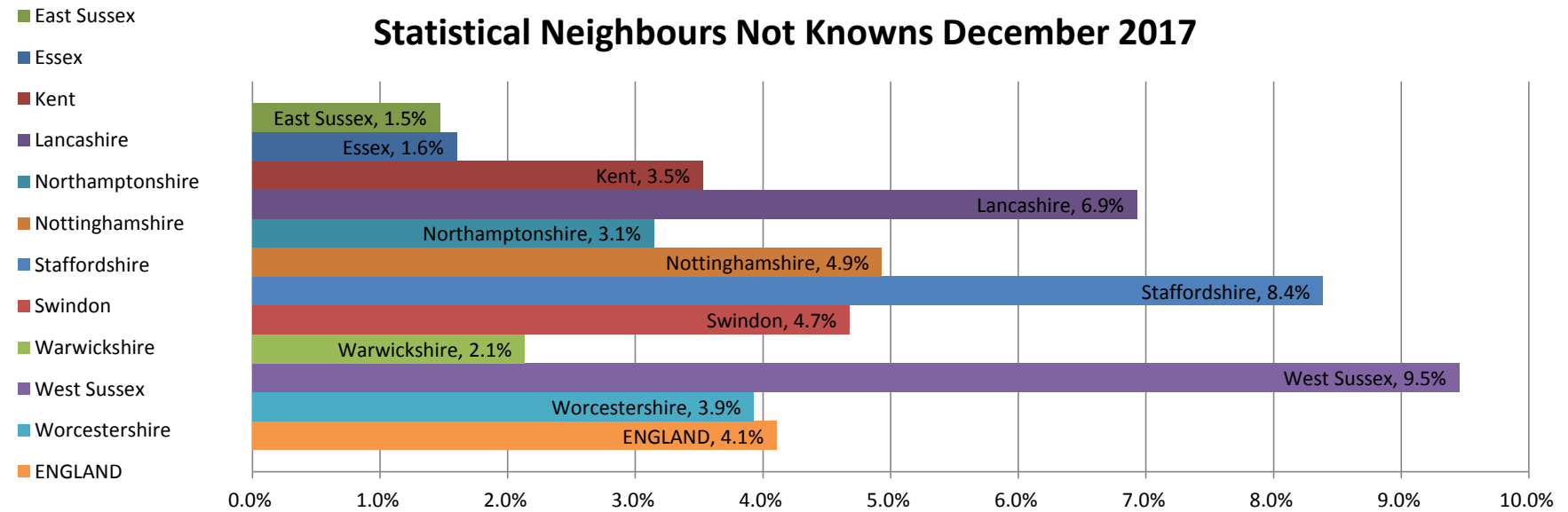
