About the Kent Invicta Award

The Kent Invicta Award is an annual award, given to an individual, in recognition of someone who has:

- achieved excellence in their chosen field;
- has had a positive impact on Kent, whether or not they are residents of the county;
- has provided an exceptional service and commitment to Kent and had a major impact on its communities;
- acted with honesty and integrity

The outstanding achievement or contribution of individuals can be on a one-off or ongoing basis.

Previous winners of the Kent Invicta Award include:

This year, to honour the Kent Year of Green Action, Kent County Council is running a competition to design the Kent Invicta Award and to attend the special meeting of the Council to see the winning Award being presented to the Kent Invicta Award recipient.

The competition

- 1. The Kent Invicta Award Design competition is open to all secondary school children in KS4.
- 2. To commemorate the Kent Year of Green Action, designs should be made from sustainable or recycled materials.
- 3. Designs must be no more that 40cm by 15cm by 15cm.
- 4. The competition will be judged in two stages:
 - a. <u>Stage 1</u> Paper Designs: The deadline for this stage is Friday 4 October 2019. Designs should specify materials to be used and include dimensions. The judging panel will select 3 designs to go forward to the final, which will be held on Tuesday 19 November 2019 at





County Hall in Maidstone. Please note that all paper designs submitted will be on display at the final judging event.

- b. <u>Stage 2</u> Final Judging: The three finalists will be invited to make their awards and bring them along to County Hall in Maidstone on Tuesday 19 November 2019, where the winner of the competition will be announced.
- 5. Pupils can use any medium of their choice for Stage 1, but designs must include the dimensions of the award and a front and side view of the design. Stage 1 designs should be submitted on paper no larger than A3.
- 6. Designs must include the following:
 - a. Kent County Council (wording or logo) must be included in the design
 - b. Kent Invicta Award 2019 wording must be included (either in the design or on a stand/plinth for the design to sit on)
- 7. Awards should have a 'Kentish' Theme.
- 8. The competition winner will be invited to County Hall on Thursday 12 December to see their Award being presented to the recipient of the Kent Invicta Award for 2019. They will have the opportunity to meet with the recipient and will be invited to stay for lunch in the Darent Room at County Hall with Members and Senior Officers of the Council.
- 9. Please note that paper entries cannot be returned until after the final judging event on Tuesday 19 November 2019.
- 10. Please note that the winning entry will be presented to the Kent Invicta Award Recipient for 2019 and therefore cannot be returned to the winner.
