## Children and young people with SEND disproportionately affected by pandemic 16 June 2021

First Published: A new report by Ofsted has found there are long-standing problems in the system of care for children and young people with SEND have been made even worse by the COVID-19 pandemic.

### Coronavirus (COVID-19): right to work checks 18 June 2021

Advice for employers carrying out right to work checks during the coronavirus pandemic, which was updated as the end date for the temporary adjusted checking processes is now 31 August 2021.

public on the directory are also likely to receive this reminder on 1 July; however CFIS will be taking steps to try to ensure they do not receive further mailings.
