# Headline Commentary

**\*PLEASE READ BEFORE USING THE FIGURES IN THIS REPORT\***

Figures for September are the most unstable of the year, as it is during September that the system is updated with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges, and given the size of Kent, this takes several weeks to complete. The NEET population is currently 1.9%, and the Not Knowns are at 45.5%. As more enrolment data goes into the system the NEET figure is likely to rise, whilst the Not Knowns will decrease significantly.

Overall, less than 2% of Year 11 and Year 12 pupils are without a September Guarantee. This is a significant improvement on last year's figure of 6%.

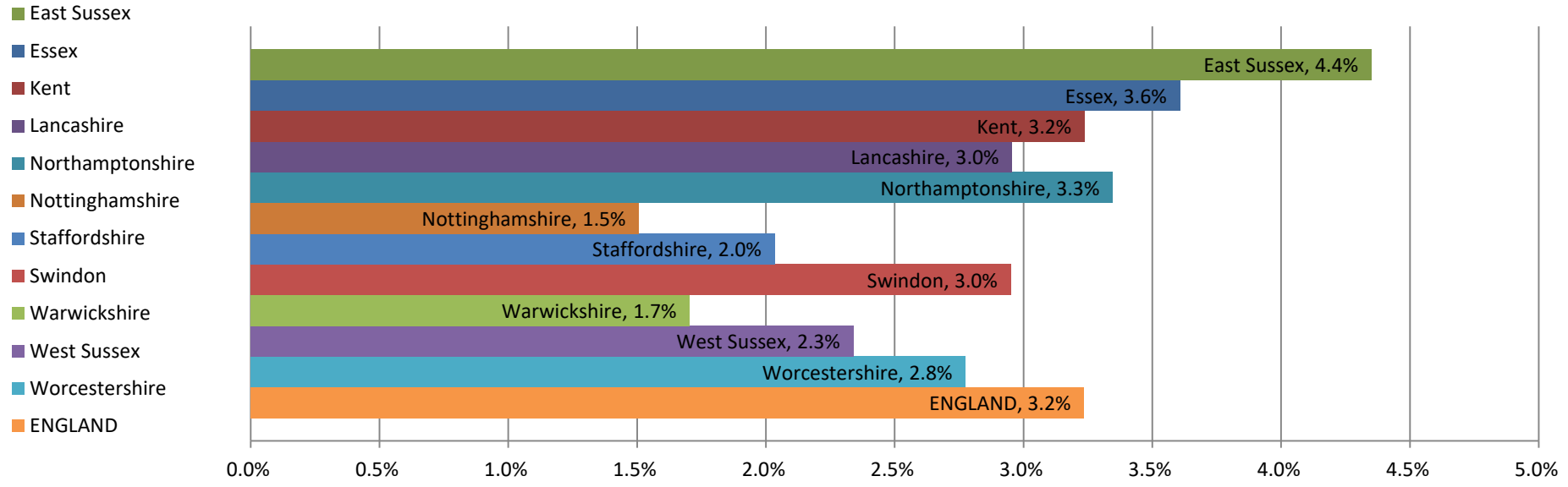

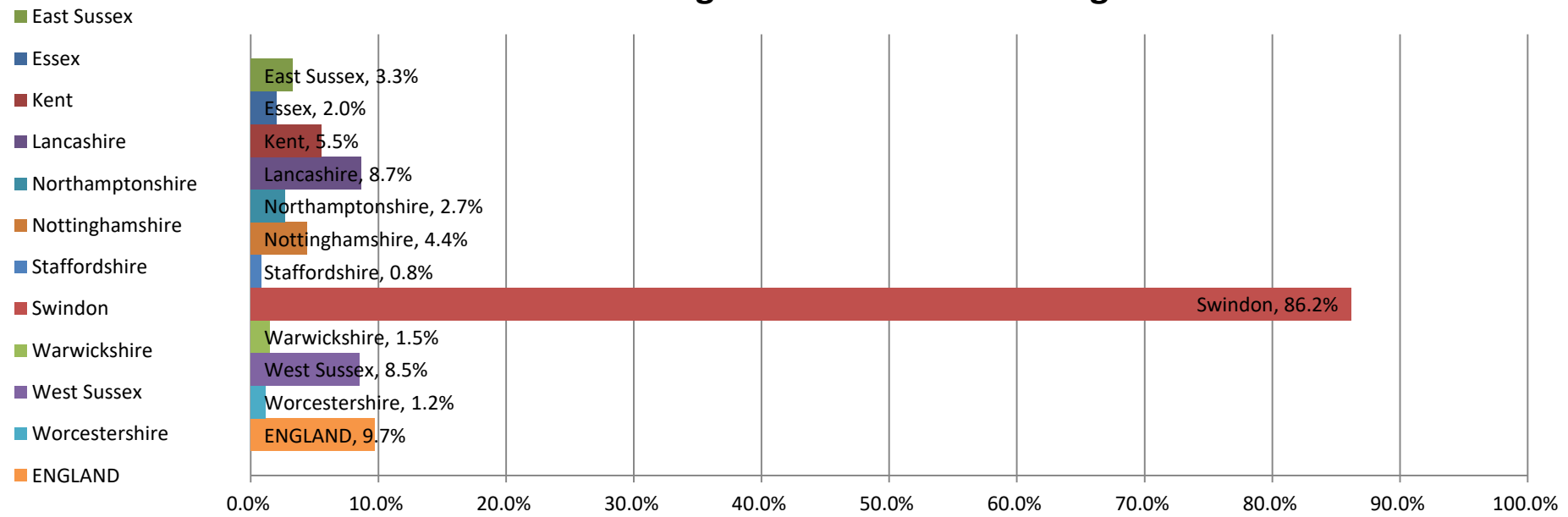
