Department for Education Early Years Census 2019 – setting level data

As advised in our previous email dated 12/12/2018, it is the time of year when the statutory annual Early Years Census must be collected and sent to the Department for Education (DfE). Your setting level data will be collected via the EY Census form link below, this link can also be found on the Homepage of the FIS Provider Portal. Census day is Thursday 17th January 2019 and the census needs to reflect the situation within settings during the headcount week Monday 14th to Friday 18th January 2019.

The Early Years Census consists of 25 questions. As Kent County Council receives funding from the DfE based on information supplied in the Early Years Census **ALL** questions are mandatory. To secure your funding it is vital that the Census Data Collection is completed accurately and submitted by **5pm on Thursday 31**st **January 2019.**

In line with the Provider agreement (Section 15.2; page 17, Section 16.4; page 19 and Section 18.4; page 20) all settings should submit a Census even if you are not claiming for any children in Spring 2019, otherwise you may no longer be eligible to claim 2, 3 and 4 year old funding.
