The NEET population is currently at 4.2% compared to 3.7% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 2.9%, compared to 1.4% at the same time last year. The Participation rate is 89.2%, compared to 90.7% the same point last year.


District performance for NEET varies from 2.6% in Tunbridge Wells to 5.6% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 1.4% in Thanet to 4.0% in Folkestone & Hythe.

It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.






SEND NEET and Not Known Breakdown






Youth Offending Team NEET and Not Known Breakdown


