Headline Commentary

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

At the beginning of the academic year the system is updated with the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges.

The NEET population is currently at 2.2% compared to 2.1% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 12.8%, compared to 17.9% at the same time last year.

The Participation rate is 83.4%, which is an improvement from the same point last year, 77.7%.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.7% in Canterbury to 2.8% in Dartford. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 7.6% in Tunbridge Wells to 24.5% in Gravesham.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 15.0% compared to last months figure of 48.6%. The same month last year was 20.1%.

The September Guarantee collection period has finished. The figures for September Guarantees Total Offers Made for Years 11 and 12 was 93.2% which is the same as this point last year.

Yr12 & Yr13 NEET %

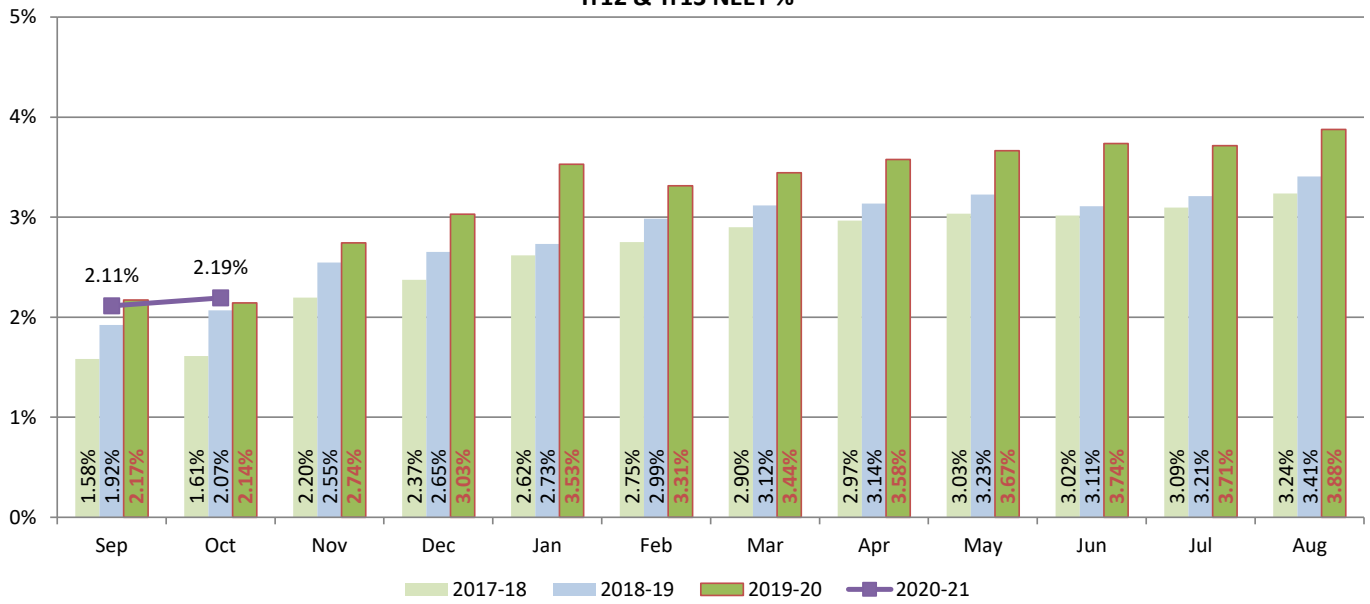
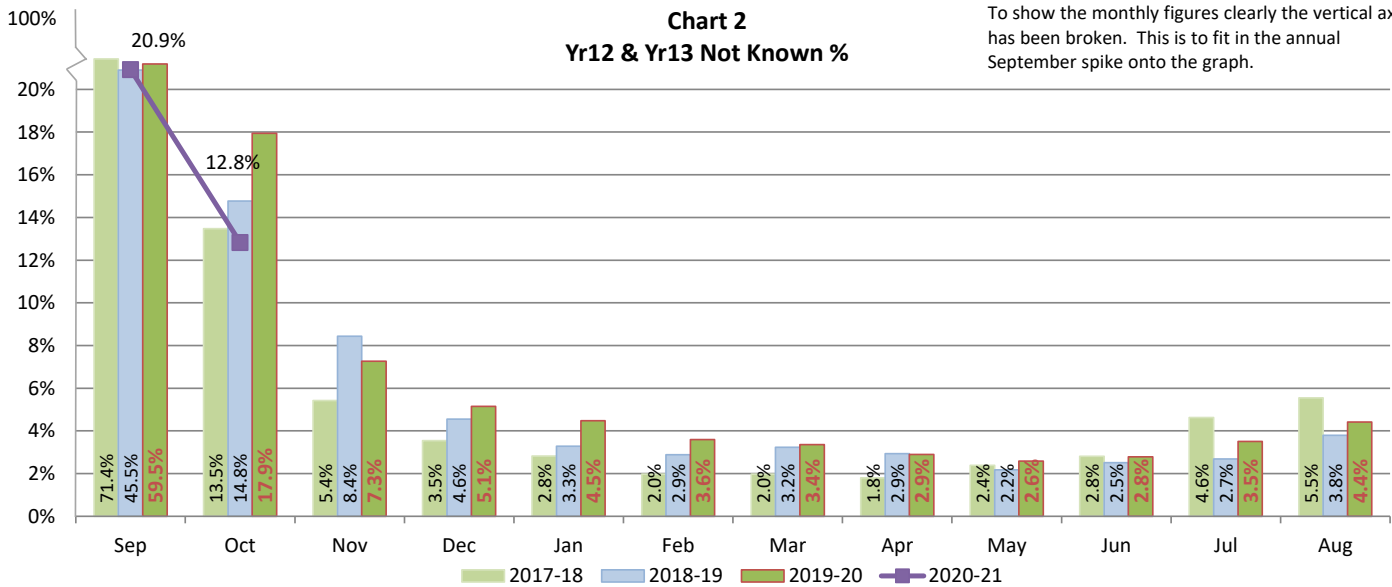

Yr12 & Yr13 Not Known %

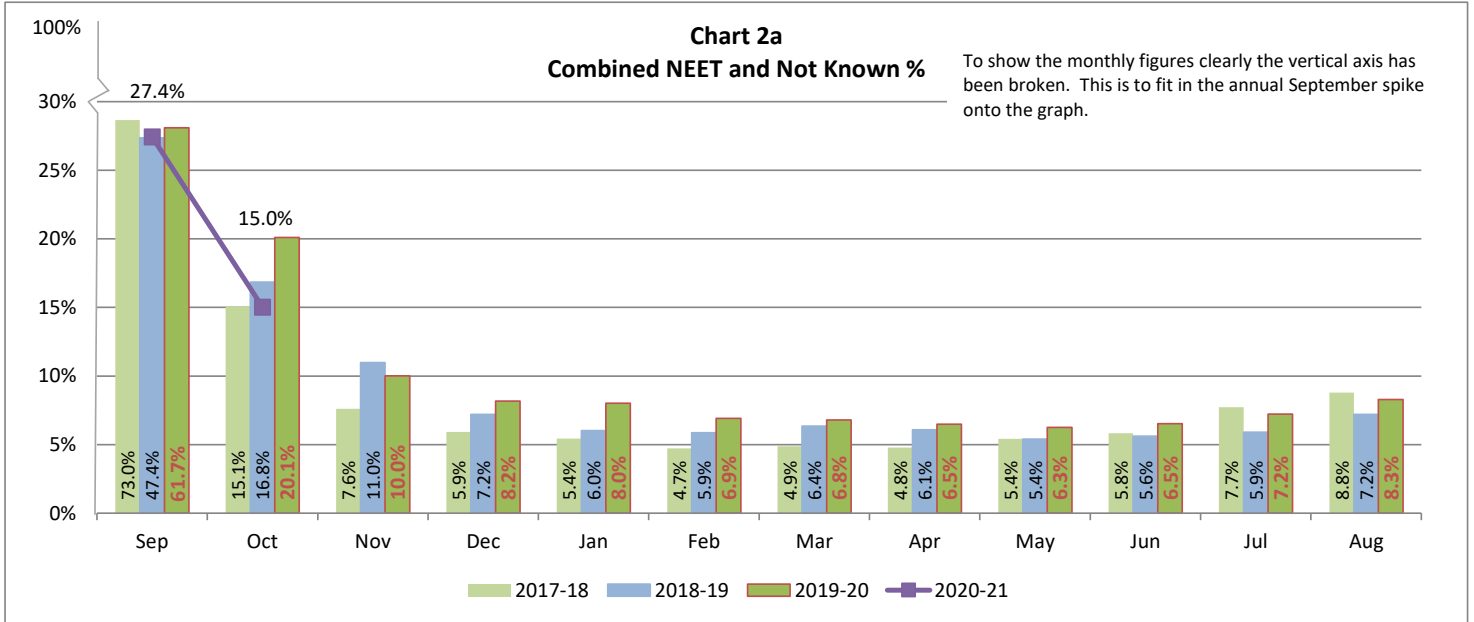

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs September 2020

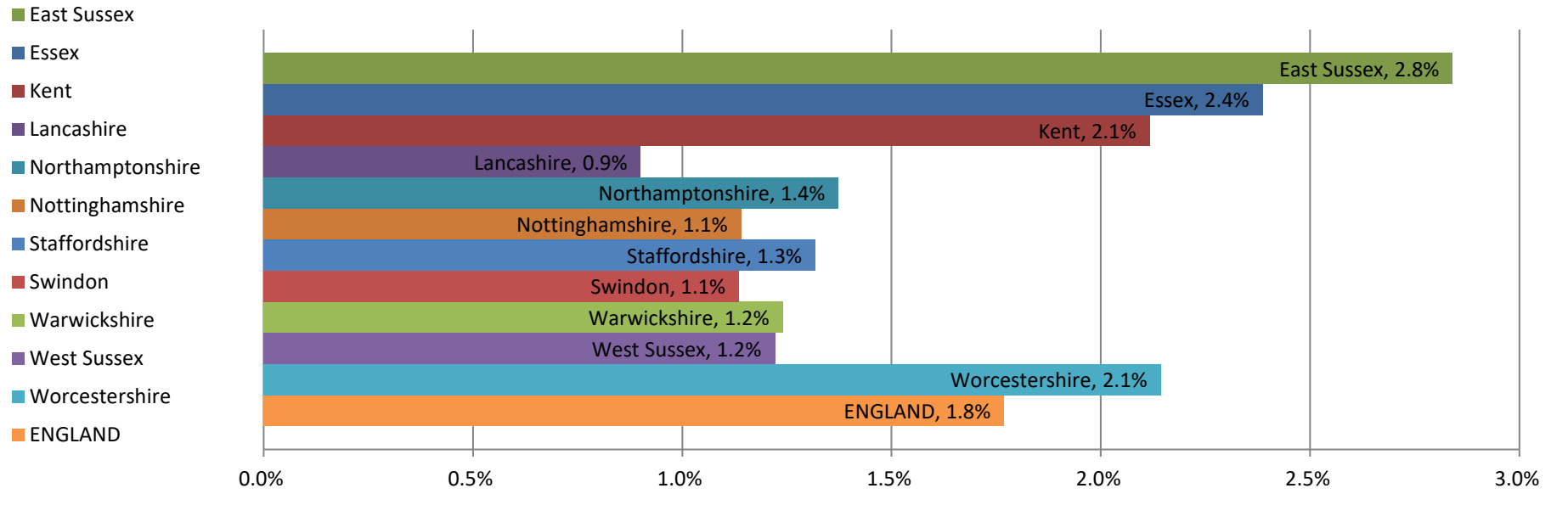


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns September 2020
