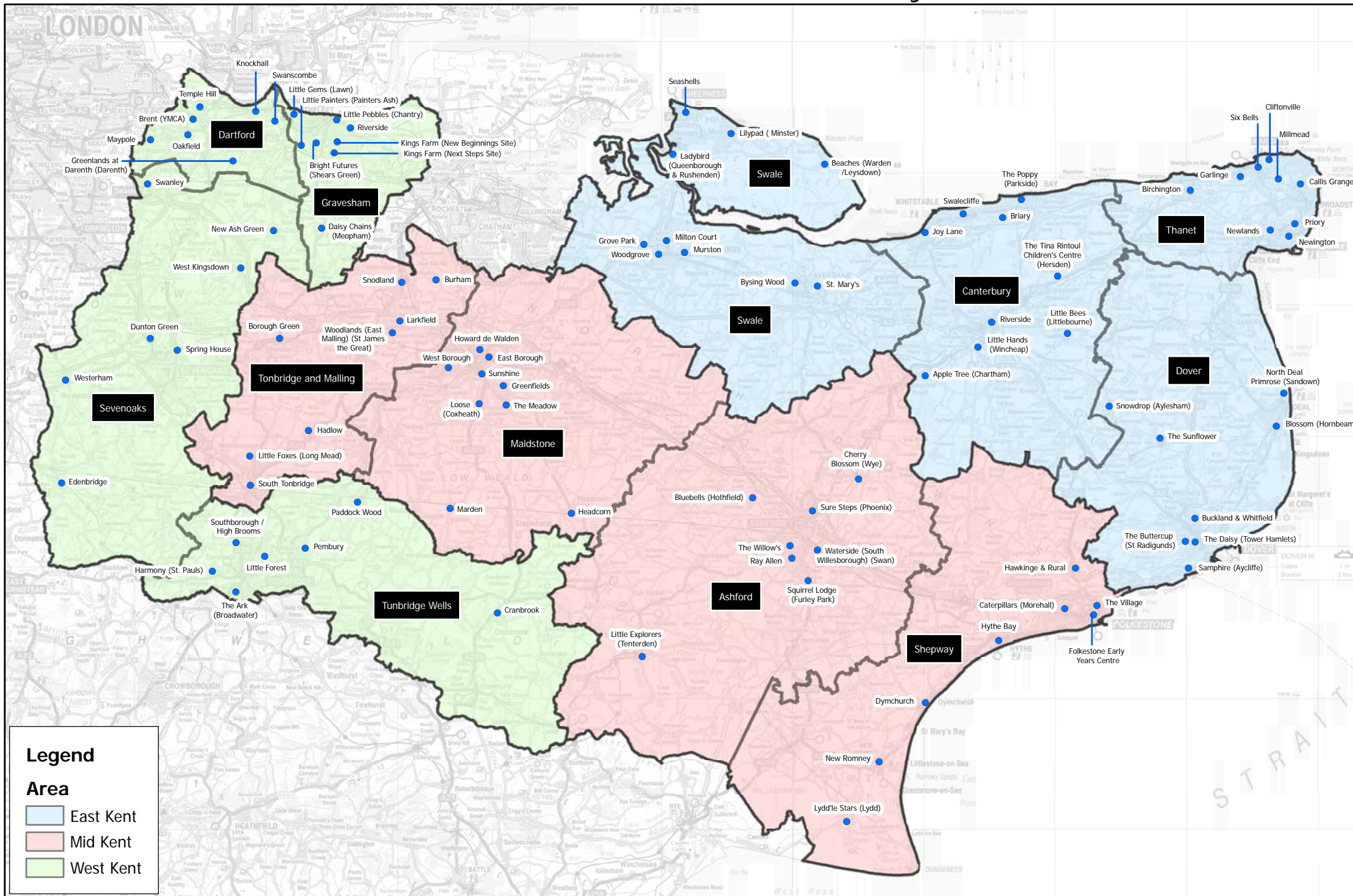

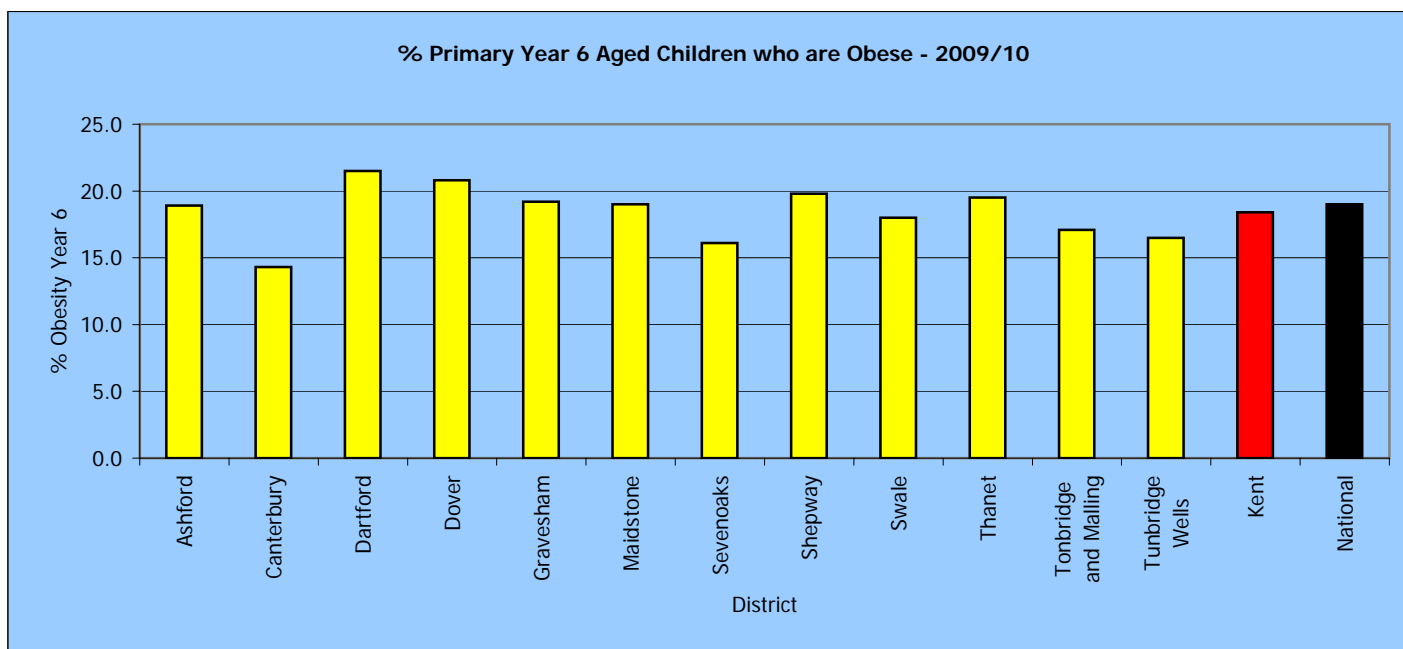

**Key Stage Two Attainment by District 2009 to 2011**



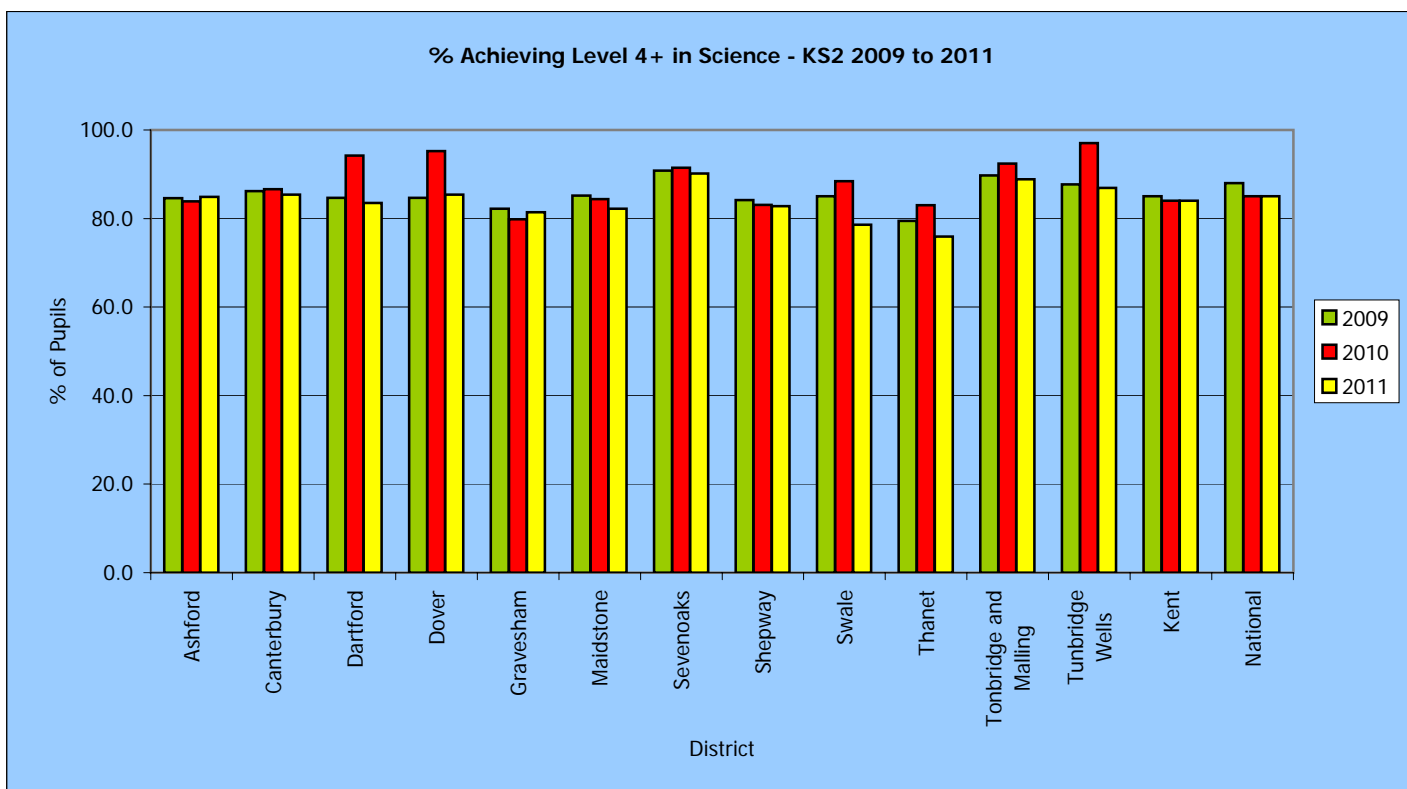
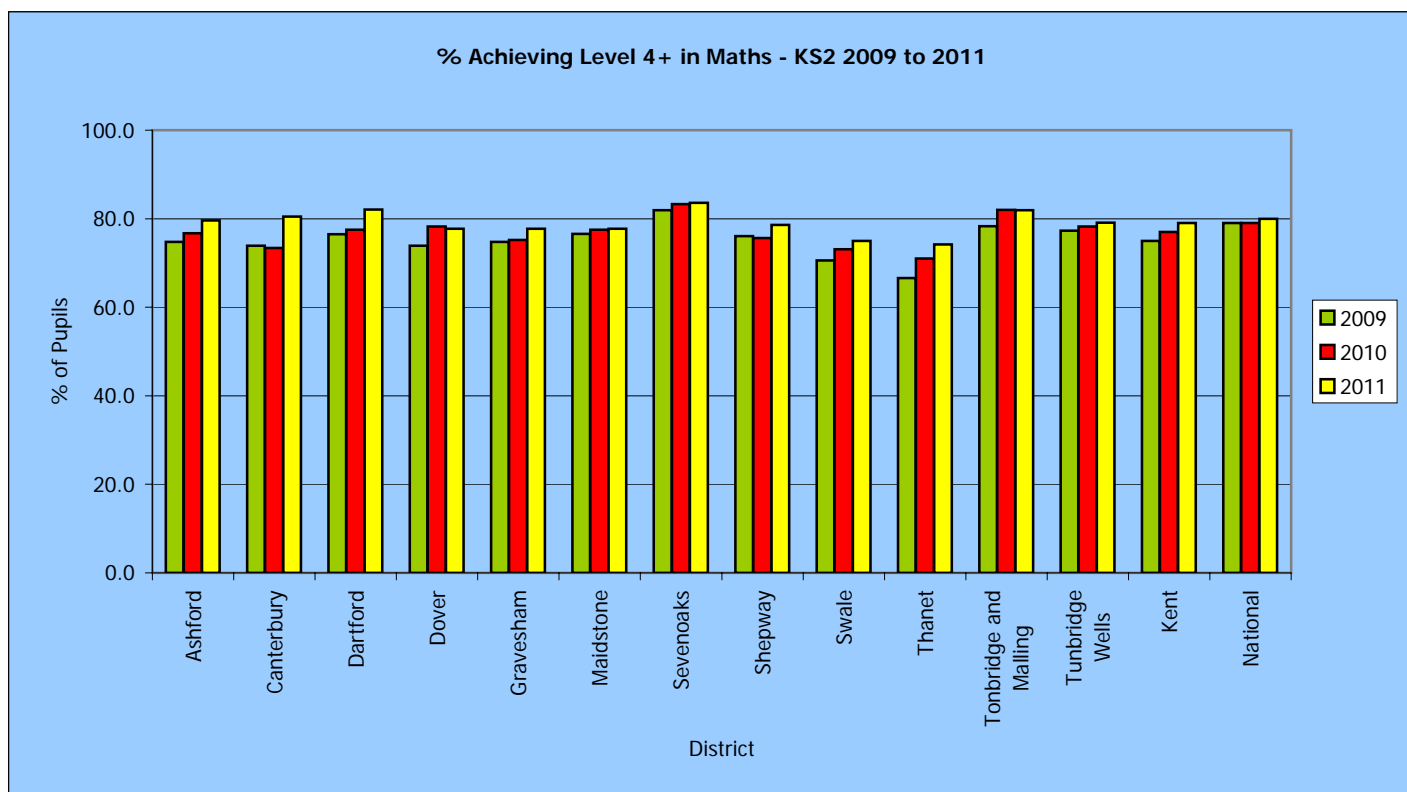

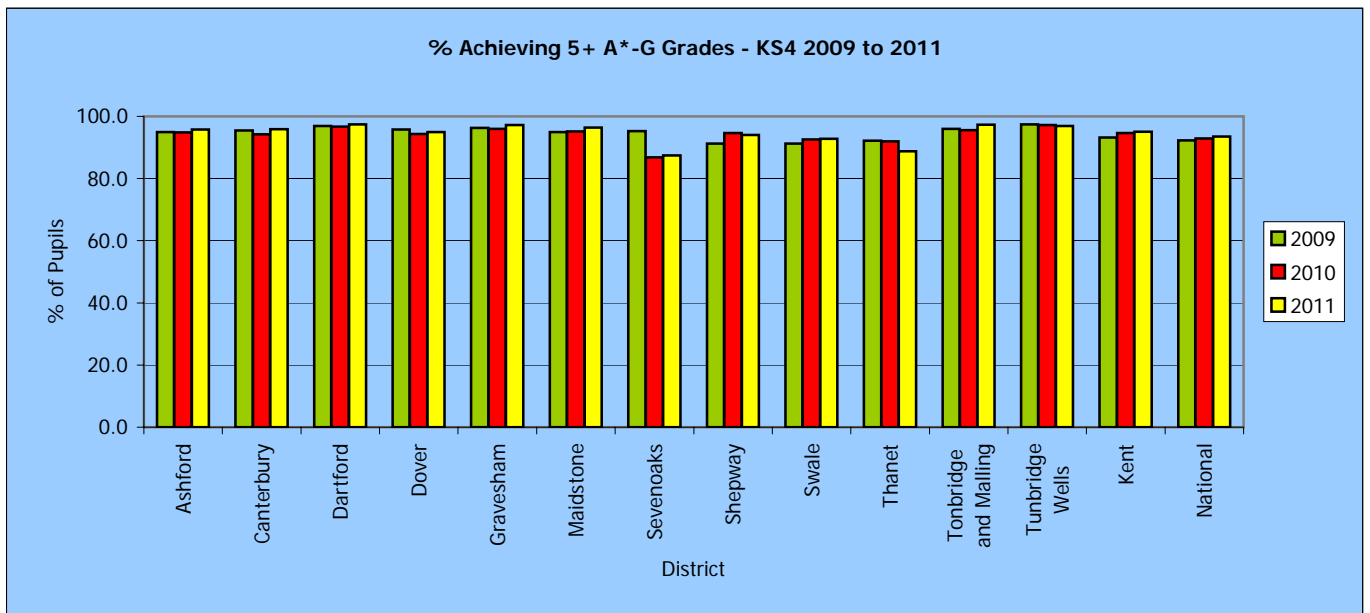
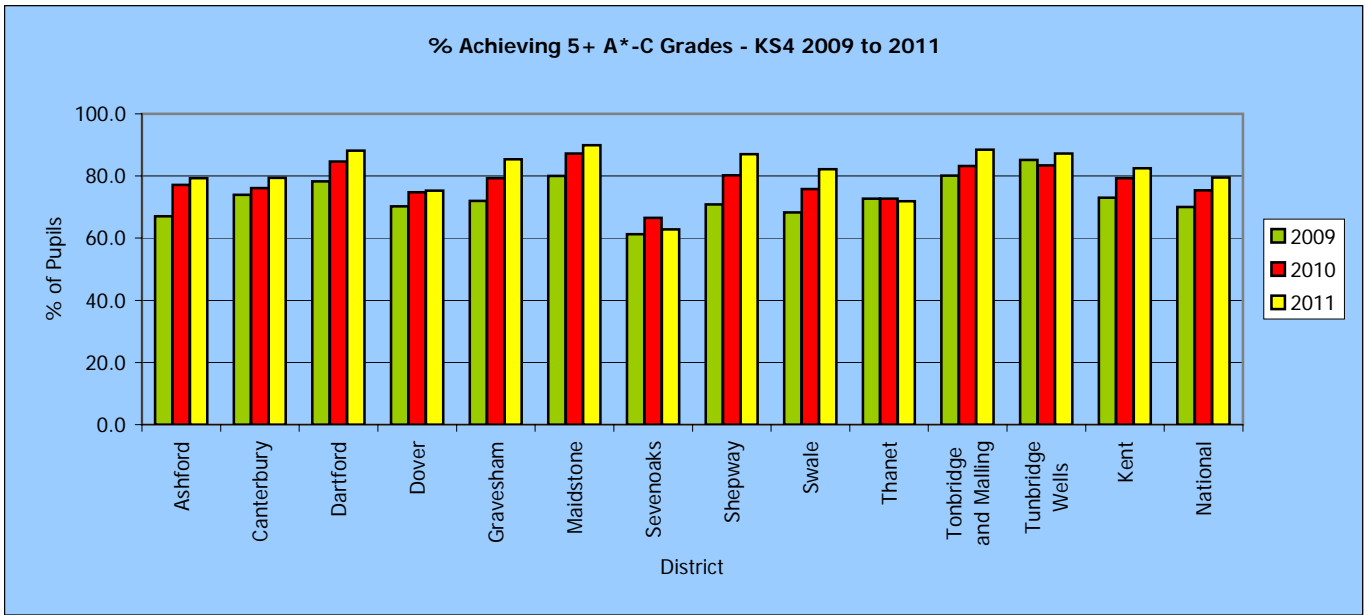
Key Stage Four Attainment by District 2009-2011
