## **Headline Commentary**

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

At the beginning of the academic year the system is updated with the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges.

The NEET population is currently at 2.6% compared to 2.7% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 7.5%, compared to 7.3% at the same time last year.

The Participation rate is 87.9%, which is an improvement from the same point last year, 87.2%.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.8% in Canterbury to 3.3% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 4.5% in Tonbridge & Malling to 14.9% in Gravesham.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 10.1% compared to last months figure of 15.0%. The same month last year was 10.0%.

The September Guarantee collection period has finished. The figures for September Guarantees Total Offers Made for Years 11 and 12 was 93.2% which is the same as this point last year.
