Headline Commentary

Figures for November are beginning to stabilise, following the system being updated in September and October with all the new enrolment information for young people in schools and colleges.

There has been substantial work to reduce the percentage of not knows as these young people who haven't appeared on enrolment lists are followed up.

The NEET population is currently at 2.7% compared 2.5% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 7.3%, down from 17.9% last month. This is also less than this time last year at 8.4% in November 2018. The Participation rate has improved again to 87.2%, up from 77.7% last month, this is up 0.8 percentage points compared with the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 1.6% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.0% In Gravesham. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 5.1% in Tunbridge Wells to 8.8% in Dover, indicating the districts where enrolment data may not yet be on the system in full.
