Headline Commentary

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

The NEET population is currently at 3.6% compared to 3.7% at the same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 3.1%, compared to 2.8% at the same time last year.

The Participation rate is 90.2%, which is an improvement from the same point last year, 90.0%.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.7% in Sevenoaks to 4.5% in Thanet. District performance for Not Knowns varies from 1.9% in Tonbridge & Malling to 4.4% in Dover.

The combined NEET and Not Known figure is 6.6% compared to last months figure of 6.5%. The same month last year was 6.5%.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16- and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

The process in place to collect this data is a partnership between MI, The Education People's Skills and Employability service and Kent schools and colleges. Despite the challenging times we find ourselves in, we are endeavouring to complete this process as usual.

Please note the Statistical Neighbour report has not been updated to reflect the new neighbours. This work is currently being discussed with DfE and the report will be amended in due course.

Chart 6 - Statistical Neighbours NEETs May 2021

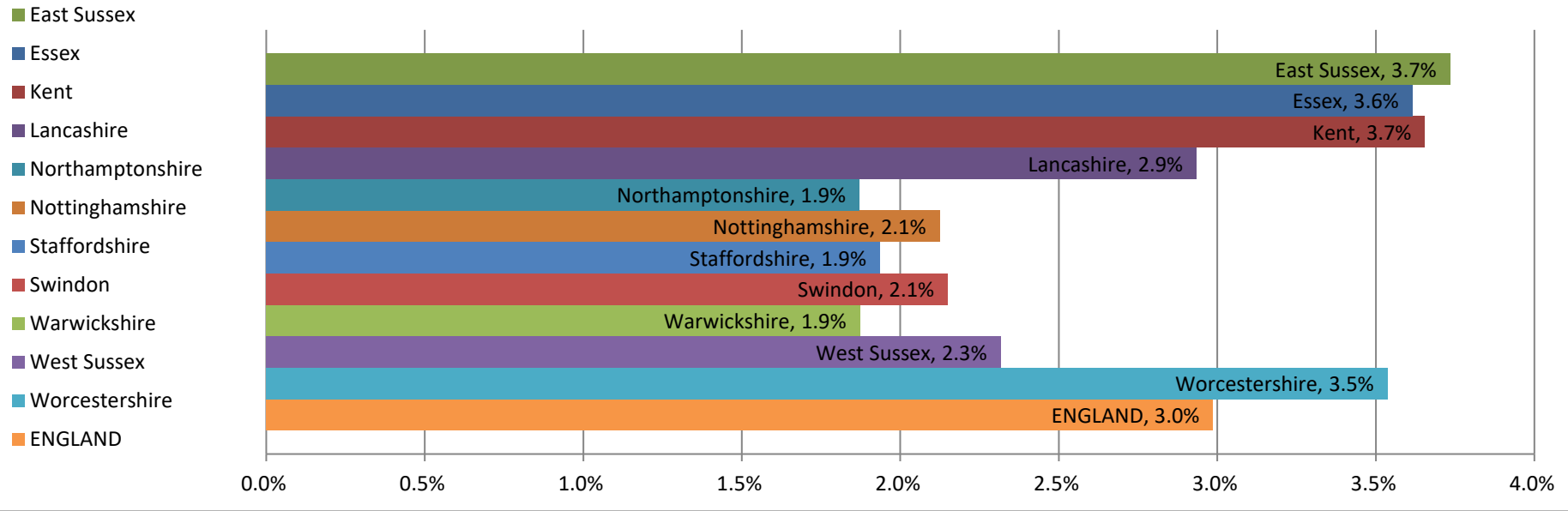
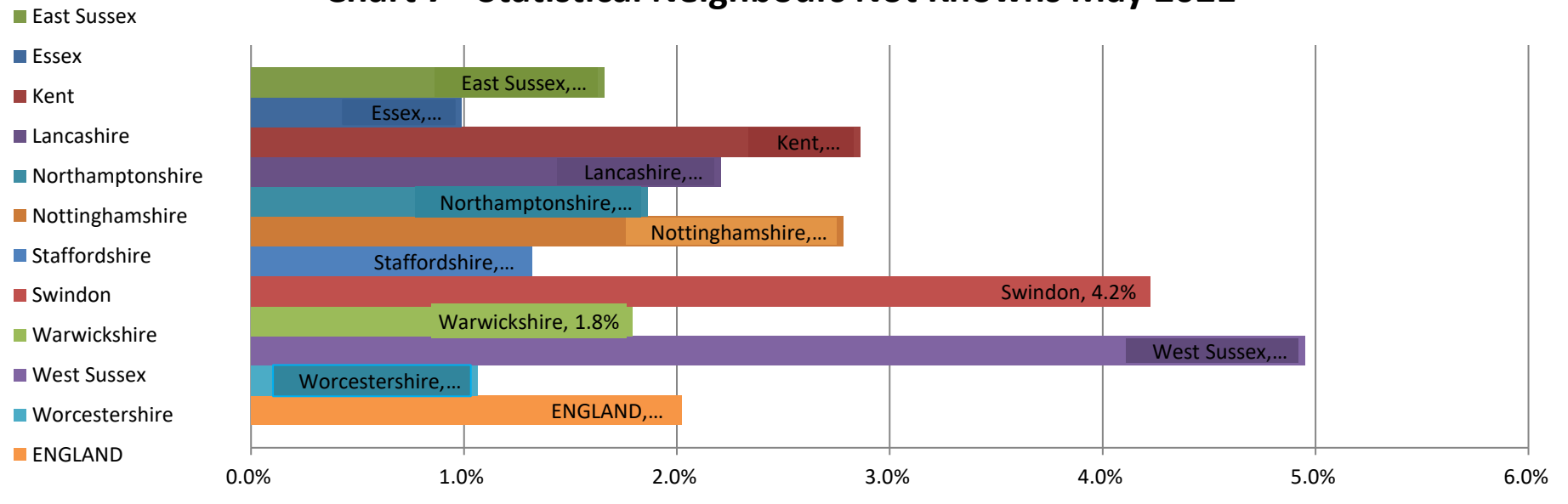


Chart 7 - Statistical Neighbours Not Knowns May 2021
