Strategic and Planning Skills and Employability

The Skills and Employability Service has been coordinating the cross directorate NEET Interdependencies task and finish group chaired by Patrick Leeson. This group is clarifying the roles and responsibilities of each service within the Education and Young People's Directorate and developing interdependent processes to reduce NEETs and Not Knows. The final report is due in July with implementation in September. It is anticipated that this will have a significant impact on reducing Not knowns and NEETs, particularly within the vulnerable groups. Cont next page ...

In anticipation of the next academic year, the Skills and Employability Service ran a series of county wide tracking briefings for all types of schools and PRUs in June to clarify expectations and processes for the collection of data. These have proved popular, with 70% of the Kent schools attending. Those who were unable to attend have been followed up. Improving this process at the start of the next academic year will create a solid foundation for tracking during the remainder of the year and will enable the percentage of Not Knowns to be significantly reduced and the early identification of NEETs.

The percentage of Not Knowns has now fallen for the third month in a row, during the same period last year the number of not Knowns increased each month. The percentage of Not Knowns is now 2.48% lower than the same time last year.

Virtual School Kent (VSK)

- · Post 16 team are working hard to make contact with young person and Social Worker to identify what the young person's current status is and how we can support their re-engagement where appropriate
- Limited options at this time of the year so the focus is on making application for opportunities for the Sept ember 2015 start

Next Steps

Skills and Employability

This year for the first time, young people who have completed a college course will be identified as Not Known on the IYSS database at the end of their course, rather than on 31st August, which was used in previous years. As a consequence the spike in Not Knowns that traditionally occurs in September, when young people are in flux, will begin in July, continue in August and September before it comes down in October. In July this year approximately 13,000 young people will be added to the Not Known lists, so that the total not knowns will be in the region of 17,000 in July.

Early Help & Preventative Services (EHPS)

A series of meetings are taking place to consider how to embed the NEET strategy into all aspects of Early Help & Preventative Services, to ensure an integrated approach across the service when working with young people at risk of NEET, or with those already NEET. Once fully scoped and planned this new process will be launched as soon as possible. This work is part of the wider partnership approach to NEET involving Skills & Employability, SEN, Fair Access, VSK and our commissioned services.
