#### **Professional Resource Group**

The Professional Resource Group (PRG) is a group that:

- Supplies additional resources that schools may require in supporting their children and young people with SEN
- Teams can be contacted **directly** by schools, as required, without the need to approach your community, request formal diagnoses or complete lengthy referral applications

### FAQs 'most asked' spotlight

Many questioned KCC's statement that only one person per school should attend and it should be the SENCo (or an inclusion lead with decision-making authority)

- In other LAs running similar models it works best when the SENCo attends
- It is ultimately school's decision who will represent them
- The attendee does NOT require in-depth budget knowledge
- The attendee MUST have delegated responsibility to request funds
  for the school

### **Funding for Year R**

- All children entering Year R who have an EHCP are being mapped against new funding descriptors
- Mapping exercise is nearing completion
- Schools will be informed before the end of the academic year as to the funding they will receive. Funding will go straight to the school
- Working with STLS to consider what a 'dedicated' Year R team might look like. All Year R transition meetings have already taken place

#### **New EHCPs**

- All new EHCPs which were issued between January and July are also being mapped against funding descriptors
- Have started mapping exercise with Special Schools and SRPs
- Will work with schools in the autumn to map existing children with EHCPs and ensure there is strong moderation across the system
