Young People Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET)

Monthly Report - October 2014

The figures are based on the monthly submission made to DfE via NCCIS for Kent County Council . Academic age is the age of the young person on 31st August (i.e.: prior to the start of the academic year). The figures include all 16 -18 year olds based on academic age with a Kent County Council area postcode as their primary address.



## **Executive Summary**

#### **Context - Transition**

October is always the time of the year that the NEET and Not Knowns figures begin to reduce, following a seasonal high in September, reflecting progress to updating enrolment and activity data on the system at the start of the academic year.

This month both the NEET and Not Known figures having dropped substantially from last month, and are also lower than the same month last year. Much of this improvement is due to the implementation of new streamlined, cross-service processes and systems.

Despite having being in a period of transition, NEET performance by KCC in the past three months has been better than that of last year, as has the Not Knowns. All districts have shown a substantial improvement in both sets of figures this month. This provides a good platform to considerably reduce NEETs this academic year.

#### **Progress - NEETs**

Over the last few months there has been improved data accuracy in recording vulnerable learners. The number of NEET in a vulnerable group has reduced substantially in the last two months, meaning that the number of 16-18 NEET with at least one vulnerable group has almost halved down to just over 500.

The KIASS Re-engage initiative has so far supported over 200 young people. This initiative will continue through the autumn with support from a range of partners.

#### **Progress - Tracking**

An internal LEAN review of the tracking process for the collection of data from schools and colleges has had a significant impact. Streamlined data collection processes from schools and colleges, combined with data in automated formats about apprenticeships, now provide electronic, standardised data across the county instead of relying on a labour intensive district data collection model. It is future proof as it is consistent and doesn't rely on human interpretation and stability of the workforce to ensure validity.

An internal LEAN review of the processes needed to track young people who are NEET, in employment or Not Known has been undertaken. This has streamlined the telephone tracking process and it expected that the number of telephone tracking calls that can be made in a day should increase by almost 20 in the coming months.

#### **Planned Activity**

The Tracking Board that oversaw the operational transition of tracking will change to a more strategic group, run at Head of Service level with a holistic brief that will focus on:

Interpreting the tracking data to improve post-16 participation;

Improving cross-service working and facilitating integration;

Continuous improvement and efficiency;

Creating/commissioning pathways that lead to sustained participation, not NEET churn.

The action plan for the Autumn Activity Survey and annual benchmarking of the whole cohort (52,000 young people) will be implemented by MIU, Skills and Employability Service, SEND and Preventative Services. This work will draw on the efficiencies that have been developed over the past four months and the improved relationships with Kent providers and neighbouring authorities.
