#### Strategic and Planning

#### **Management Information**

- Post statutory school enrolment data completed by the end of September apart from 3 schools who failed to submittheir data in time. This has been resolved in October.
- College enrolment data on schedule to be completed by the end of October.

#### SEN

During August, SEN completed a focused piece of work (involving 11 members of staff across the 4 areas) as outlined in the NEET Interdependencies Action Plan. The review compared IYSS post 16 records for young people 'flagged' as SEN with the SEN Service database held on Impulse. The level of need and characteristics on IYSS have been updated to ensure data on IYSS now accurately reflects the status of these young people and clearly identifies those young people who are currently subject to statutory SEN Statements, LDA or EHCP. This work to verify system records is fully complete.

This exercise identified a large number of young people 'flagged' as SEN not in education who are **not** subject to statutory SEN provision e.g. Statement, LDA or EHCP.

To maintain high quality data, each SEN Area team has identified a member of the team who will have lead responsibility for IYSS and the NEET/Not Known agenda in support of KCC targets. All Area Managers have been proactive within their area teams in promoting the importance of working collaboratively with other KCC services to support the achievement of this target. Recent IYSS training for the SEN Service has increased the number of SEN users. All District Leads and all casework Young People Officers and at least one admin support in each area are now working to ensure IYSS is kept updated. This is now becoming embedded within SEN processes. In order to ensure good understanding of the IYSS within SEN, three staff will act as SEN's IYSS training team with the role of SEN Lead Trainer being fulfilled by one of the SEN District Leads who has significant experience of IYSS prior to joining KCC. Further CPD to 'train the trainer' is programmed for the end of September 2015.

SEN is developing a Post 16/18 Transfer process which will incorporate updating IYSS with intended destinations, September guarantees and destination information during activity survey and at any point a young person changes provision mid-year.

#### **Troubled Families**

- Our Troubled Families Support Officer is now trained on IYSS and we will be training all TF district based Admins
- The Admins will then be responsible for entering data on to IYSS from TF Commissioned Services and Troubled Families Employment Advisors (Jobcentre Plus secondees)
- Briefed new Jobcentre Plus NEET Worker on the TF Programme

Summary update on activity from 3FTEs that form the TF Employability Officers Since September 2014 when the team commenced, we have achieved the following outcomes for young people in the TF cohort:

- Paid employment 49
- Traineeships or Up skilling 61
- Apprenticeships 21
- Work experience 31
- Saturday Job Scheme 16

The team report identified barriers to learning as; a lack of qualifications, disability and a criminal record. The Saturday Job Scheme has been a success, but is currently on hold at the moment while we implement a revised Risk Assessment Process.

#### Strategic and Planning continued

#### Early Help & Preventative Services (including Youth Justice and Troubled Families)

The critical development for Early Help & Preventative Services (including Youth Justice and Troubled Families) is the planned strategy that now awaits the final approval of both the Divisional Management Team and of the Directorate Management Team.

#### Core elements of the Strategy include:

- (i) partnership working with Skills & Employability to ensure that all with a responsibility for reducing the number of NEETs are fully informed of the College, training and employment opportunities available on a District by District basis
- (ii) tracking processes are in place to enable early identification of those young people vulnerable to being NEET while they are still in Year 11
- (iii) ensuring a partnership approach is in place at the District level between EHPS, YOT and training organisations enabling young people who are NEET to access these organisations so that they are well informed
- (iv) the planned roles of the Youth Hub Delivery Managers and the TFP District Partnership Managers in co-ordinating the NEET strategy and provision within their respective Districts
- (v) guidance being provided for EHPS staff on data capture relating to the EET / NEET populations so that there is a clear understanding of the impact being achieved by the new strategy. This work will include the involvement of Children's Centres (Teenage Parents), Pupil Referral Units (early identification of those who are vulnerable) and the YOTs (the current position of those subject to statutory supervision)
- (vi) the identification and training of staff who will be responsible for data entry in each of the Districts (the train the trainer programme was completed during September by the Systems Training Officer based in Information & Intelligence)
- (vii) an audit is being undertaken of the YOT population in Year 11 last academic year to consider how risks of them becoming NEET are being addressed and to identify what further inputs are required
- (viii) Information & Intelligence is promoting the availability and use of accredited programmes (e.g. Rapid English, ASDAN) in each of the Hubs with a view to increasing the employability of young people. Licences have been funded (ix) the Participation Pathways Operational Group will be used by EHPS to support a co-ordinated approach with colleagues from Skills & Employability, Specialist Children's Services and the SEN Assessment & Placements Teams to the implementation of the strategy and to assessing its impact
- (x) the YOTs will continue to monitor their performance with respect to the engagement of young people subject to statutory supervision in full time Education, Employment & Training. Routine joint working arrangements will be established between the Practice Leads in the YOTs and the Youth Hub Delivery Managers for each of the Districts (xi) the Improvement Team for Youth Justice and Youth Work will support the Youth Hub Delivery Managers to meet their responsibilities, including discussions at the county meetings of these staff led by Nigel Baker, Head of Service, East Kent, for EHPS

#### **Fair Access Team**

- All EHE officers are trained on IYSS and have been assigned responsibility for a locality, they are responsible for updating the movement of the Year 11 CYP who were previously Home Educated.
- All EHE officers will contact the Y 12 CYP assigned to their case load in October and update the position of those unaccounted for on IYSS. Updating information where it is known.
- Current processes are being reviewed to incorporate early monitoring of year 10 & 11 EHE CYP. EHE officers will contact families to arrange a visit where they can, to discuss FE opportunities available for CYP in Year 11.
- Those families who do not permit an officer to visit will be contacted and the information relating to the September Guarantee will be gathered via telephone, email or letter.

### Strategic and Planning continued Skills and Employability

Data:

The not known figures are better than this time last year despite the change to reporting course end dates for colleges, as mentioned in the August report.

Skills and Employability have set up secure email links with school sixth form coordinators for the exchange of data. This has been completed for all but 4 schools. The data on year 13/14 destinations is coming in ahead of the 9<sup>th</sup> October deadline.

The Skills and Employability Service briefings are taking place across Kent. Invitations have been sent to schools, FE colleges and KCC partners in the NEET strategy. These briefings state the core activities that take place across the year and the responsibilities for tracking from schools and colleges, options for young people who are potentially NEET and the contact details for the district teams who can assist (available at the briefings and on Kent Choices).

#### **Increasing Participation**

20,000 KentChoices magazines have been distributed to schools, offering high quality careers advice over a number of different pathways, and supporting the Careers Information Advice and Guidance programmes run by Schools. The KentChoices application platform run by UcasProgress is now open for all of year 11 students. Letters are going out to schools, young people and their carers explaining the process with log in details.

In addition to this the District offer has been published for this academic year

on <a href="http://www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/college-sixth-form-employment-and-training">http://www.kent.gov.uk/education-and-children/college-sixth-form-employment-and-training</a>. This is for young people whose needs aren't met by the mainstream provision offered by schools and colleges and for those young people who need a placement outside of the September start. Working in partnership with local schools, colleges, training providers, local agencies and employers, Skills and Employability has identified the need to improve educational outcomes and employability skills and increase participation for those at risk of becoming NEET or seeking employment opportunities. In response the local Employability Offer has been introduced and developed, with the aim of re-engaging learners in education and supporting them to develop employability skills, including mathematics and English, whilst providing progression pathways to higher levels of study or into employment, traineeships and Apprenticeships. These offers are regularly reviewed.

#### **Virtual School Kent**

As the data shows, the CIC/CL under Kent VSK are beginning to reduce as the team have been tracking the young people. The Post 16 VSK team have been supporting the College enrolment process and collating enrolment data for their records for those within a Kent and Medway College. The Locality VSK teams are also collating school enrolment data. Both processes are enabling the teams to identify those that are NEET, or have not enrolled where they had planned to. For those that are Not Known, the Post 16 team have been contacting the Social Workers with the aim of establishing the current status of the young person and to offer support where necessary. This is heavily reliant on hearing back from the lead professional for that young person. Follow-up work is now in place. The Post 16 Assistant Head is continuing to meet with Social Workers at team meetings to ensure they are clear of the post 16 options and that it is not too late to enrol somewhere, and that support is available for those that are at risk of becoming NEET.

#### **Next Steps**

#### **Troubled Families**

- Ensure all TF Admins are trained and entering data in to IYSS
- Business Case due to submitted by the Skills and Employability Team to secure approval for an additional Employability Officer KR8, which will enable us to deploy a dedicated Officer for each Area
- Identify NEET referrals from TF cohort for new Jobcentre Plus NEET Worker

#### **Fair Access Team**

- The EHE officers will in future liaise more closely with Skills & Employability, schools and colleges to ensure they have information on Further education places available to the Yr 11 CYP on their caseloads.
- Links to College, Schools & Apprenticeship open days and job fairs will be published on the EHE webpage.

#### Skills and Employability

The Kent NEET strategy will be published to be operational from November .

The dates for the Participation and Progress meetings have been set. This is a forum for matching NEET young people with EET activities and is held in each district ( w/c Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> w/c Jan 26<sup>th</sup> w/c Mar 15<sup>th</sup> w/c Jun 14<sup>th</sup>.). The CEIAG briefing to be held in Maidstone is open to any professional involved with young people- 5<sup>th</sup> November Improving CEIAG, Improving outcomes( contact <u>Rajmund.Brent@kent.gov.uk</u>).

#### Virtual School Kent

Challenges with the UASC cohort and how this is recorded on IYSS is in discussion. Provisional meeting booked for the 9<sup>th</sup> October. Formal Post 16 training is booked to commence next week for Foster Carers to update them on the post 16 sector, along with sessions for Social Workers. Collaboration between the Skills and Employability team and VSK are now in place and links are being strengthened. Focus for the VSK Post 16 team is to reduce the NEETs and Not Knowns through chasing Social Workers to ensure they are aware of the options available. VSK are in the process of recruiting Year 11 Progression Adviser Support Officers to ensure that earlier support is identified for the new year 11 cohorts.
