MATHS HUB CONTRIBUTING IMPACT - OFSTED Evidenced in reports for teaching for mastery schools

We are incredibly pleased to be able to share some of the impact evidenced in recent Ofsted reports regarding schools that have worked with the Kent and Medway Maths Hub, which praise the hard work and dedication of our partner school teachers; we are proud to be a small, yet integral part of their progress in mathematics.

The following quotes from the reports illustrate how subject leaders have worked alongside Mastery specialists and the wider Maths Hub team to develop mathematics in their schools.
